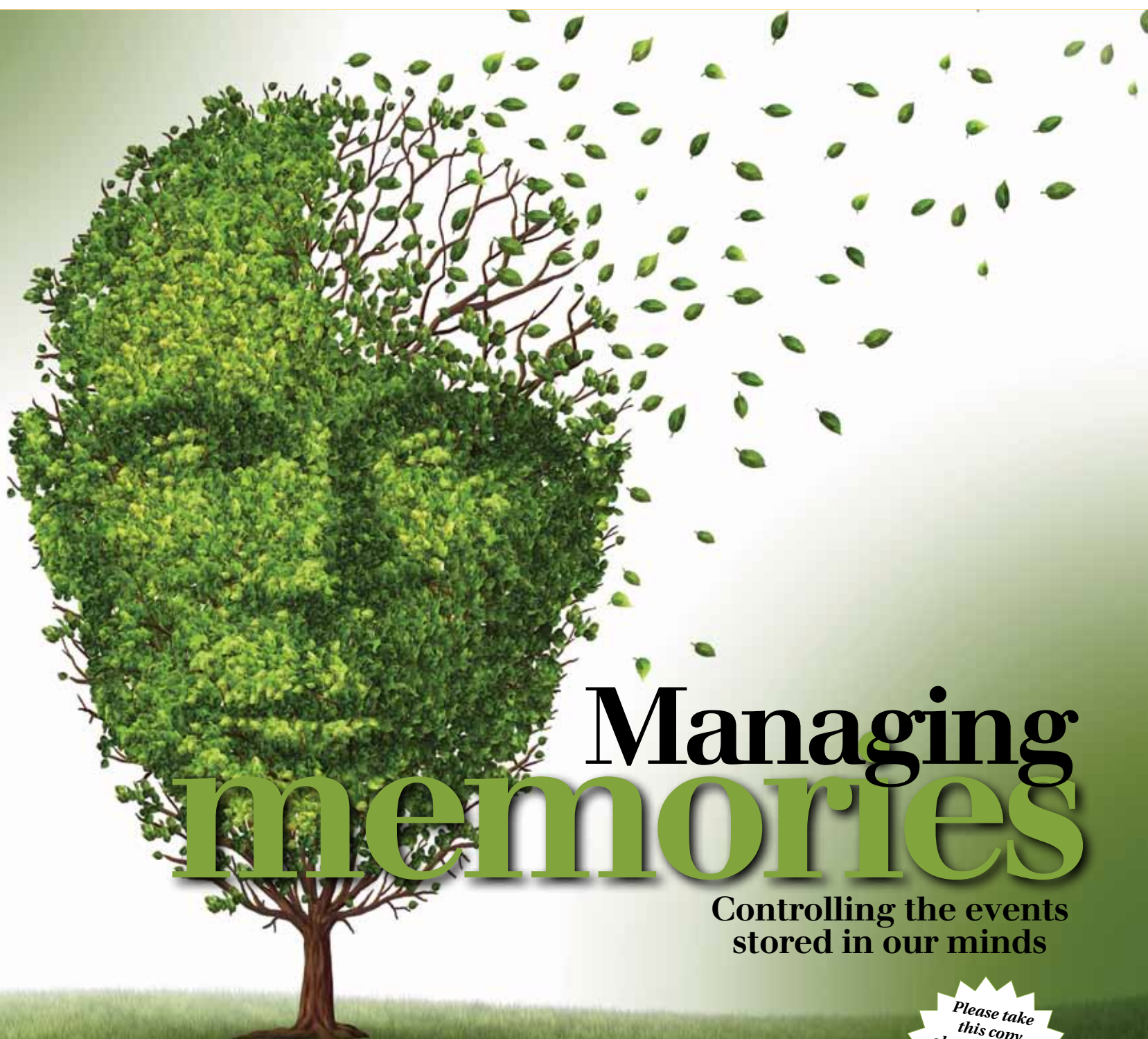

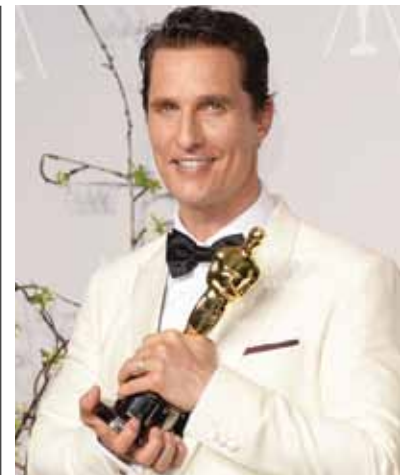

Lying in the foothills of the Atlas mountains and just a few hours from the Sahara desert, Marrakech is a city where European culture meets north African tradition and urban landscapes join with the wilderness.

Marrakech is the third biggest city in Morocco, after Casablanca and Rabat, and its name alone evokes images of a long history, seething souq alleyways and the smells of spice and incense.

To enter Marrakech is to enter a different world where time has stopped and the traditions of the past continue to be a way of life. From the donkey carts treading the winding lanes to the trained mon-

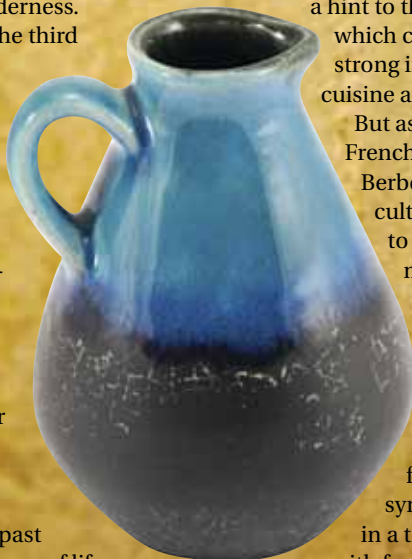
even the most experienced souq shopper by surprise.

Marrakech's medina is the perfect place from which to explore palaces, stay the night in a palatial riad guest-house, and sample a dish of piping-hot snails. The snails, of course, give

a hint to the French influence, which continues to live strong in the local dialect, cuisine and way of life.

But aside from all things French, the indigenous Berber and Moorish cultures come to the fore in many other areas.

The Koutoubia Mosque, Marrakech's most famous symbol, is built in a traditional style with four copper globes and is seen from across the city. Still an active place of wor-

The ramparts of Marrakesh, which were built by the Almoravids in the 12th century, stretch some 19 kilometres around the medina of the city. The walls are made of a distinct orange-red clay and chalk, giving the city its nickname as the 'red city', and stand up to almost six metres in height. They have 20 gates and 200 towers along them.

lack of arts and crafts throughout Marrakech, with a fascinating collection of kitsch crafts and decorative arts from Morocco and the Sahara available. Handicrafts are big business among artisans, so the quality is high with a very wide variety on offer.

The city can also make a good staging point for exploring the nearby snowcapped Atlas mountains, which guard Marrakech imposingly from the distance, or for going on a several-day trek through the Sahara, which takes in mountain-sized dunes and traditional Berber settlements.

Although there are no direct flights to Marrakech from

Dubai, Emirates has flights each day direct to Casablanca, from which the city is just a short hop. At just over four-and-a-half hours' flying time, it is ideal for a long weekend with the family. ●

FUN AT YOUR FINGERTIPS



As the automotive world charges headlong into new technologies designed to make driving both safer and easier, it's often easy to forget that for many people driving is also supposed to be fun.

But fear not driving fans, Dodge has the antidote to these humdrum safety boxes being churned out. The Challenger SRT is the polar opposite of almost everything else out there on the market.

Styled on the American muscle cars of old, the Challenger looks like it just stepped off the set of a *Mad Max* movie. It's actually quite scary to look at and other road users tend to move aside rather quickly when they see the big Challenger in their rear view mirror.

The interior is fairly basic but very comfortable. The front bucket seats are excellent and very supportive. Rear access is helped by folding seats that also slide forward. At the very back the boot is still sizeable, even with the addition of a very large spare tyre in the centre.

On the road the Challenger is probably the only retro-muscle car that actually feels like a proper old muscle car. It manages to mix the key ingredients of that era perfectly, with its soft suspension, on its toes stance,

huge tyres and massive 470 horsepower engine. When sat behind the wheel you could very well be racing for 'pinks' at the local drive-in back in 1960's America.

It's worth noting that this is not a clever car. For all Dodge's ravings, it's a huge engine bolted to a bouncy chassis. But who cares. It's probably the most fun you'll have behind the wheel of car this side of Dh800,000.

On full throttle it lifts up and simply throws itself at the horizon.

It really is very quick indeed. Acceleration is accompanied by a delicious roar from the twin exhaust pipes. In the corners, you'll need to be brave or have a lot of room to play with, as it wants to push wide, followed by a bout of oversteer, albeit gathered up by the electronics (which you can switch off). If you don't find yourself grinning you really are dead inside.

Shocking findings

How it might be possible to use electroconvulsive therapy to hide away unwanted memories.

What's more, the application of electroconvulsive therapy is now a long way from what we saw on film screens during the 1970s.

Whereas in the early days of the treatment, the patient's entire body would stiffen and convulse under the force of the electricity, a combination of muscle relaxants and general anaesthetic used today means that most of the body stays still with the patient remaining relatively comfortable throughout.

Steel pads are attached just above the patients' temples, while wires connected to a transmitter send electric pulses through the brain. The seizure these pulses induce can be

Electroconvulsive therapy was first introduced by Italian neuroscientists in 1938 and gained widespread popularity among psychiatrists as a form of treatment in the 1940s and 1950s. It is typically given two or three times per week until the patient is no longer depressed. Around 70 per cent of patients are women, possibly because they have twice the risk of depression than men.

BANISHING BAD MEMORIES FOR GOOD?



Electroconvulsive therapy, otherwise known as shock treatment, has developed a nasty reputation for itself over the years, not least after films like *One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest* showed horrific and brutal images of patients strapped down and forced to endure violent seizures—images that have swayed the opinions of generations.

But still a number of countries, including Britain and the Netherlands, use the treatment as a last resort on sufferers of severe depression. While many view it as a barbaric treatment, it still has its strong advocates, and one team of Dutch researchers believe they have learnt how to apply electroconvulsive therapy as a means to shut out bad memories.

"Memories are stored in connections between cells in your brain," said Martijn Kroes, of the Donders Institute for Brain, Cognition and

Behaviour at Radboud University Nijmegen, who led the study. "However, these connections take some time to become permanent."

"If you disturb [this] process, you lose the connection between cells altogether—and thus selected memories can in theory be made to disappear."

The new technique is now raising hopes that it could be used to treat post-traumatic stress disorder. While counselling and medication can help in some cases, for many it is often too difficult to forget grave traumas, so wiping out the memory altogether could be the key.

compared to what happens during an epileptic fit.

It has long been known that one of the side-effects of this kind of therapy is memory loss. According to the Royal College of Psychiatrists in London, such memory loss is usually temporary, although some patients can report severe and long-lasting memory losses afterwards.

To find out if it was possible to tune this general memory loss into a targeted treatment to drown out specific memories, Kroes turned to patients already undergoing electroconvulsive therapy for existing cases of deep depression, in order to conduct his research.

His team would show participants two sets of picture cards that depicted an emotional story. Once the patients returned after two weeks, they would be shown just one set of cards again in a bid to activate that particular memory for treatment.

A day later, the patients were asked to recall the most recent card they were shown, which they could not do. However, they were able to recall both cards from two weeks before.

This research therefore suggests that it is possible to remove specific memories by harnessing them immediately before having shock therapy. Much more work needs to be done on this treatment, but the researchers now believe they have a positive basis to build on. ●

What is post-traumatic stress disorder?

Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) is an anxiety disorder that usually develops after a person has experienced a deeply traumatic event in their life, such as a serious or life-changing injury, physical or emotional abuse, an unexpected loss, or after being involved in combat.

While it may come across to many as depression, the diagnosis for PTSD is usually given when a combination of the following symptoms are reported: recurring flashbacks, avoidance of memories of the event, extreme anxiety—particularly when thinking or talking about the traumatic event that took place—and a withdrawal from normal social behaviour.

Although PTSD can affect anyone of any age, the majority of those who suffer a traumatic event will, luckily, not fall victim to it. However, women are more likely to experience PTSD than men, and war veterans are commonly at risk of suffering with PTSD.

While some are comfortable with providing this information, others aren't, and almost nobody has any real clue about how developers and advertising networks use, profile, share, and then sell that location data.

It is very easy to beat the system though, and each operating system has settings to allow you to grant or rescind providing this information.

Following a study last year in which academic Janne Lindqvist looked at the number of apps that unexpectedly ask for location details, the Rutgers computer engineering professor has built an Android app that will reveal when other apps are secretly tracking your location.

"We discovered we could exploit the method *getLastKnownLocation* available in the Android Location API [application programming interface] for this purpose as an effective side channel," Lindqvist wrote in a summary of his research findings.

He hopes to have a fully workable app available soon, which he will distribute free of charge in the Google Play store in the hope it will change the face of developer behaviour.

"Eventually we would hope that the smartphone platforms would change for the better," he added.

In the meantime, more and more location sharing apps are appearing. One of the most recent, Connect, uses social media status updates to gauge where friends and followers are located, and beams its data directly to the iPhone.

So, before you next check in, it might be worth checking out how much you're actually revealing. ●

Your online check-ins could be leaving a trail of information.

App developers are hungry to know where you are in the world, but what can you do to stop them tracking your location?

Online privacy has become a big issue for switched-on people, although the complexity it presents to journeymen web and app users is often a turn-off for many.

Over the years, mega-sites and services like Facebook and Google have been rapped on the knuckles for failing to provide fitting and workable safeguards to protect their users' privacy.

And recently, with the rise of location-based services that integrate seamlessly with hardware innovations, such as Apple's M7 motion co-processor chip, there is a raft of always-on services that can monitor—and tell others—exactly where you are.

Some apps, like Google Maps, whose job it is to give you directions, absolutely need to know your location. But others still ask you for access to your GPS even when there is no obvious need. For example, does a free game or a recipes app need to know where you are? Probably not.

But advertisers see a user's location as one of the most valuable sources of data on your phone. As a result, many apps grab your location with the sole intention to pass on

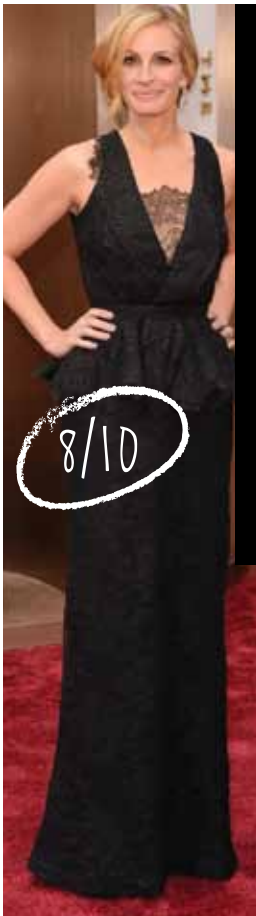

Liam Neeson returns with **Non-Stop**, a tense thriller set far up in the air.

Liam Neeson takes the lead role in *Non-Stop*, a suspense thriller played out at 40,000 feet above sea level.

During a transatlantic flight from New York City to London, US Air Marshal Bill Marks (Neeson) receives a series of cryptic text messages demanding that he instructs the airline to transfer \$150 million into an off-shore account. Until he secures the money, the messages say, one passenger on his flight will be killed every 20 minutes.

Non-Stop reunites Neeson with *Unknown* director Jaume Collet-Serra and producer Joel Silver, and co-stars Golden Globe Award winner Julianne Moore.

As an aside, it is interesting to note how Neeson has transformed into an action star so late in his acting life. Now 61, he got his award-winning performances out of the way earlier on

in his career in order to apparently dumb down and go for the punches with flicks like *Taken*, *Non-Stop* and *The Grey*.

At the same time, Mathew McConaughey took the inverse route from mindless entertainment—a transformation that became complete when he won an Academy Award at last week's Oscars.

And given that Collet-Serra has clung on to every cliché of the genre, Neeson's character is a flawed hero mourning the death of his daughter—how could any action film pretend to be good without a flawed hero? Oh, and he has a fear of flying.

Any one of a dozen passengers could be the killer, from frequent flyer Moore to a friendly stewardess played by Michelle Dockery of *Downton Abbey* fame.

But the plot twists when it is shown that the ransom is transferred to Marks' bank account, and the hunter now becomes the hunted.

Filled with grainy, warts-and-all closeups that fill the screen occasionally between slickly edited fight scenes, *Non-Stop* is every single thing it intends to be: the kind of mid-level, brainless entertainment that viewers might watch between trolley service and dozes on an international flight. If you want more from a movie, check out the Oscar winners; if you want murder with a Hitchcockian twist, *Non-Stop* should be just fine. ●

Saif's stages

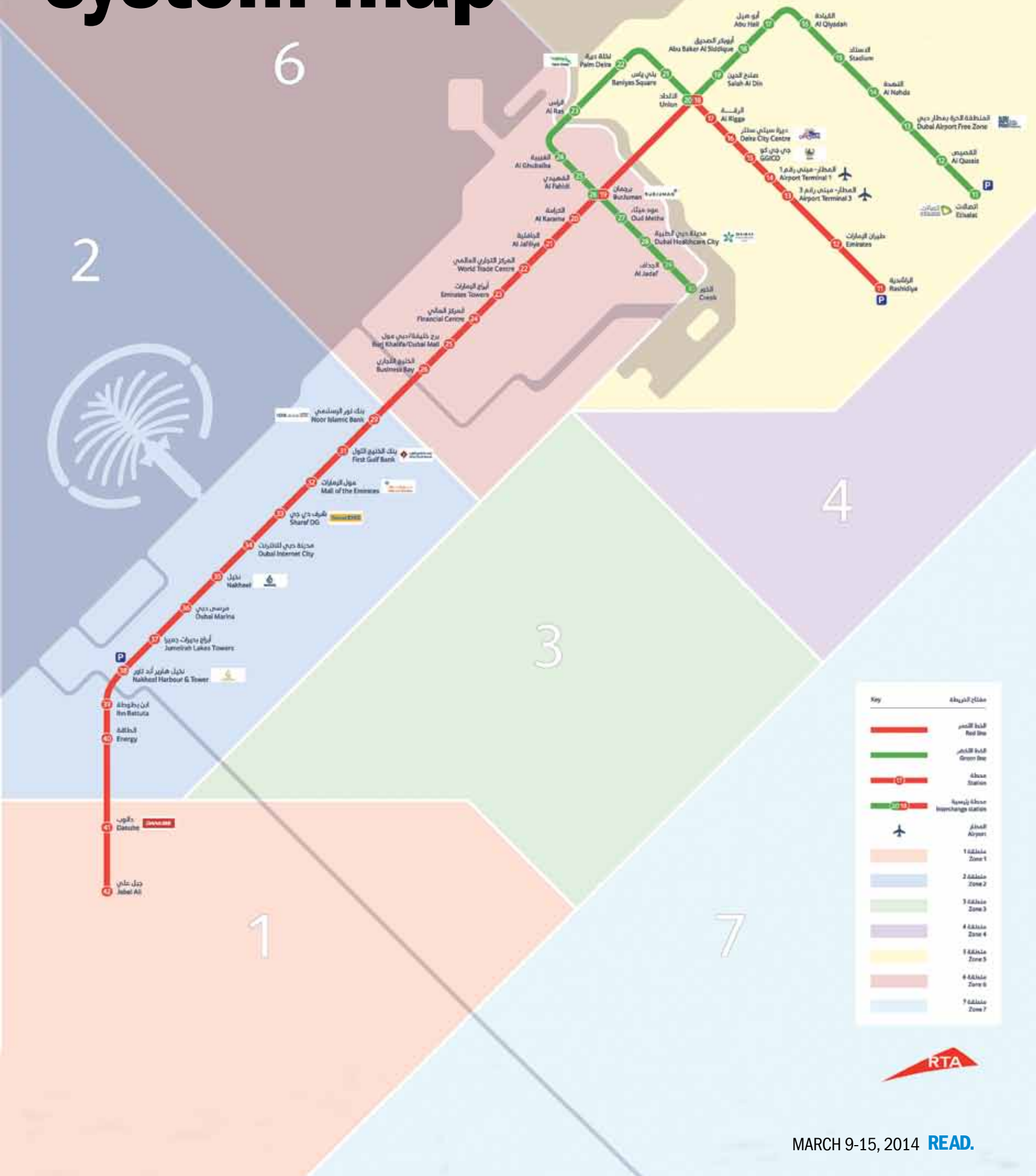

Vehicle mortgage service enhanced

Enhanced online vehicle mortgage service makes the process of settling vehicle debt easier for clients.

SERVICES

The Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), in cooperation with vehicle mortgagors, continues to enhance its online service to improve convenience to clients who have paid their vehicle mortgages, while reducing mortgage providers' business costs.

In this context, the RTA operates an online link with banks and other mortgage providers. When a vehicle mortgage is repaid, the mortgage provider automatically informs the RTA and releases the mortgage. Thus, clients now need not visit their

mortgage provider for a certificate to present to the RTA.

Ahmed Bahrozian, CEO of the RTA's Licensing Agency, said: "The Licensing Agency no longer needs paper certificates from clients to prove that a vehicle debt has been repaid. Banks and other mortgage providers provide this information online directly to the Licensing Agency. The Agency then informs the client by email and SMS that the vehicle mortgage has been released by their mortgage provider. So there is no need for clients to visit their mortgage provider or visit the RTA."

To ensure that clients receive the full benefits of this new service, the RTA made it mandatory for all mortgage providers to be online with the RTA by February 1, 2014. "This is a free service provided by the RTA to mortgage providers and clients," added Bahrozian.

He reaffirmed the RTA's commitment to provide the public with the world's best activities in line with Dubai Smart Government's initiatives and directives to put government services on par with that of five star hotels and make the services available around the clock.

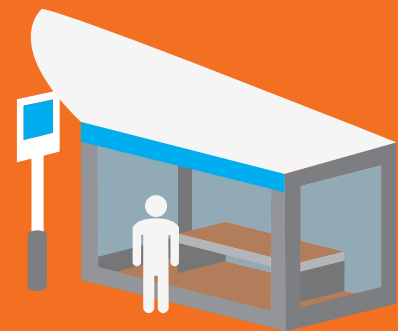

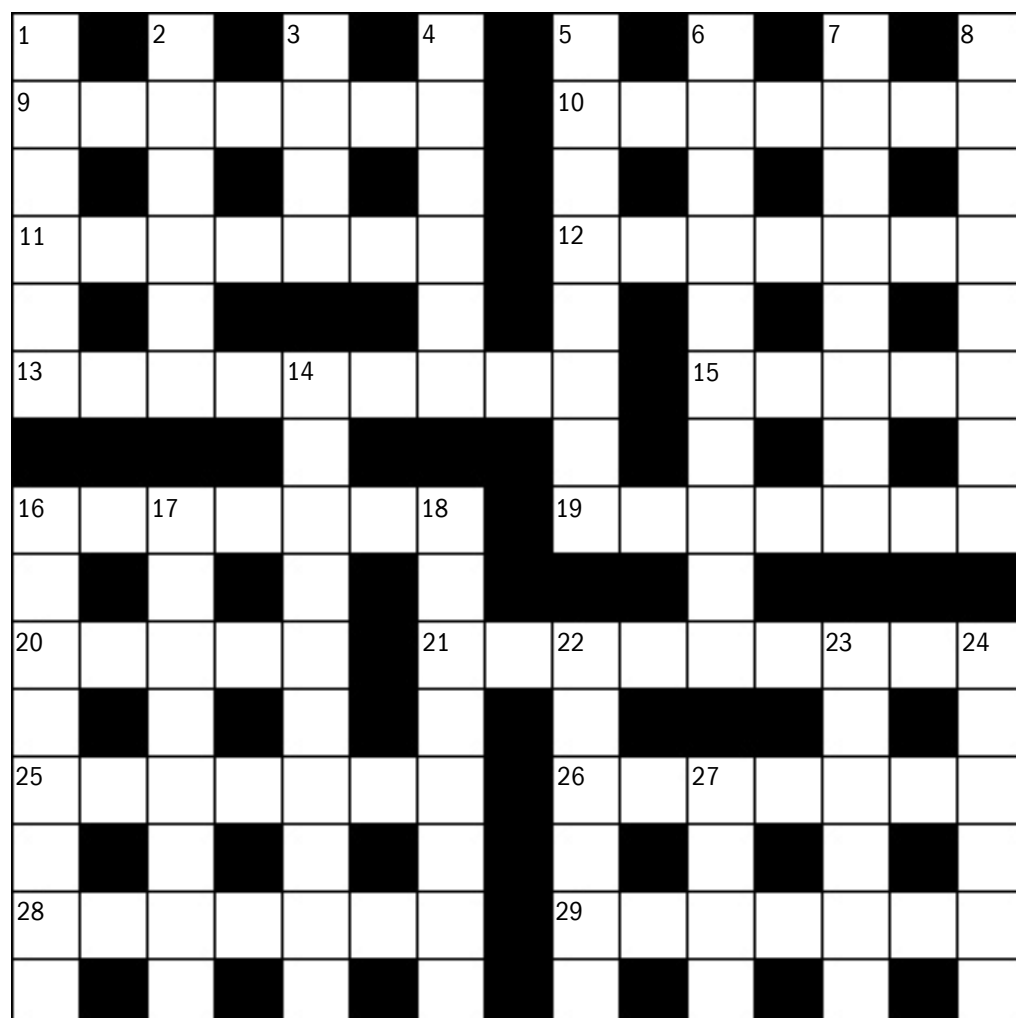

225g plain flour
2 tsp caster sugar
Pinch of salt
½ tsp baking powder
125ml milk
2 tbsp vegetable oil
1 tbsp butter, melted

mixture with the spoon, and then knead with your hands on a clean work surface for five minutes.

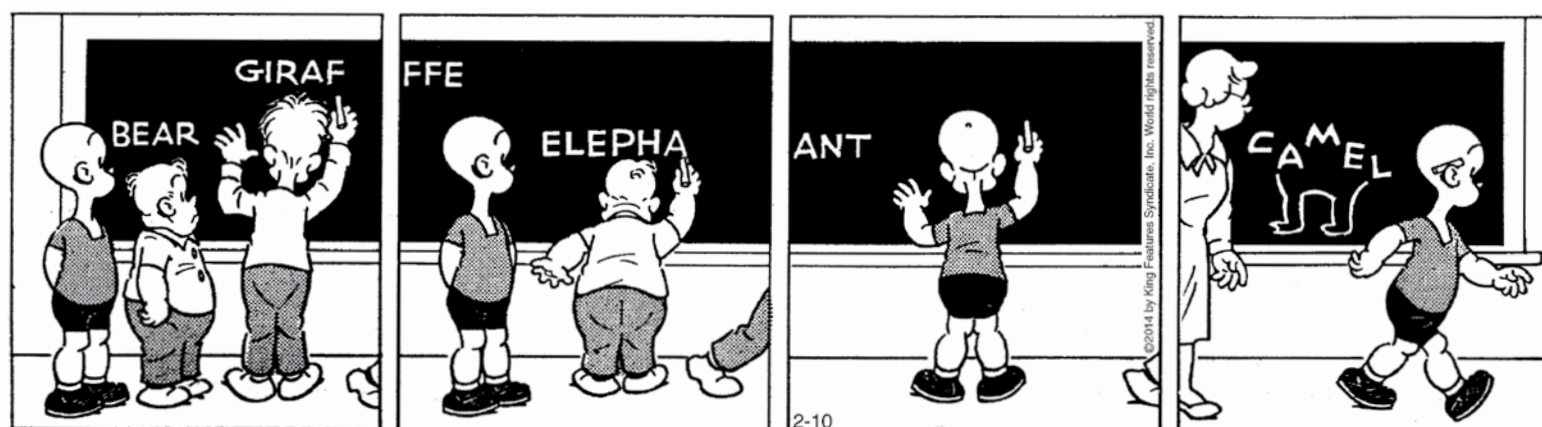
3. Place the ball of dough into a bowl, cover with a damp tea towel and leave in a warm place for 15 minutes to rise.

6. Once lightly browned, brush the bread with the melted butter and serve immediately as a perfect side dish to a homemade curry.

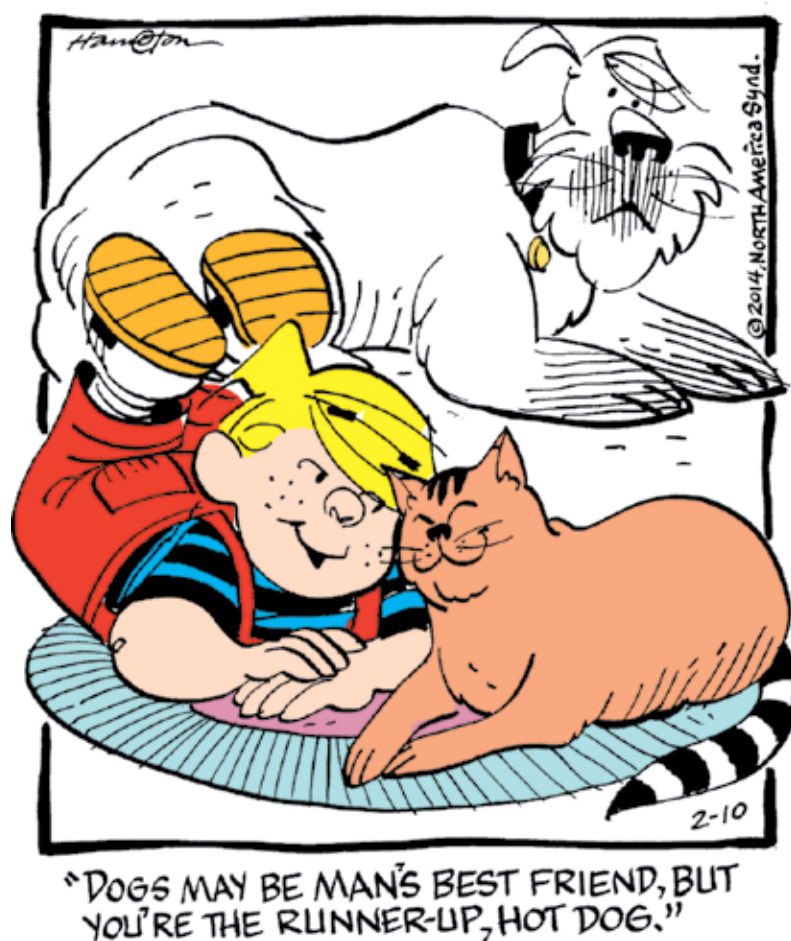
