Go organic, choose wisely

People were eating **organic** way before it was seen as 'cool' the term came after the farms used a new, synthetic pesticides and chemical that minimized weeds, insects, and rodent damage. I want to know how you can tell the difference and look at the facts.

ORGANIC FOOD

Have you ever tried a pair of shoes that walk alone?

Aren't we all sick of checking the map on our phones every time we try reaching a new place we've never been? As technology is supposed to be making our lives easier, there should always be someone smart enough to create something new and impress us all. Dhairva Dand has done just that, Dhairva has created something magical that suites all walking lovers, wearable technology that vibrates to guide us to where we want to go.

The first wearable technology we saw this year was the Samsung hand gear. This exceeds all our expectancies. The insoles are made out of flexible silicone, and boast a couple of different chips onboard. There's a microcontroller to keep tabs on what's going on, a capacitive pad to monitor your walk, three vibrating "vibrotactile ticklers" and a Bluetooth chip for communication with your smartphone.

Resolving negative attitude at work

Pessimism from one employee can have adverse effects on the morale of an entire team.



Negative attitude at work from one employee can have a tremendous effect on the optimism and motivation of an entire team. While it's very common for employees to make negative comments occasionally, a bad attitude that never seems to subside is a cause for concern. Addressing the issue early on helps ensure that the employee with the negative attitude doesn't affect the rest of your employees. Sometimes managers do not understand the amount of stress that can result from having such

employees within their company. It may be even hard to accept that an employee who's doing a good job is affecting the productivity of others. But ignoring or tolerating this issue can quickly result in frustration among the rest of your employees. Akhtaboot is here to help you deal with negative employees.

DRILL DOWN TO THE ROOT OF THE PROBLEM

Once you identify an attitude problem, sit down with the employee

to discuss the behaviour and try to determine whether they have a reason for their negative behaviour. Try to highlight instances of him making negative comments or acting in a rude manner. Make sure that you avoid making comments about the employee as a person, but instead, talk about the action. Offer to discuss the concerns that led to the negative comments and work on a solution together. If the employee offers nothing but vague complaints, ask for specific examples in which they felt that you

or the company did not provide support for their role. This conversation

is good for everyone and will help you discover hidden problems that can be easily corrected promptly.

VOICE YOUR EXPECTATIONS

Be clear about the behaviour you want changed, and not the attitude. Accept the fact that you may not be able to turn the employee into a perfect person, even if you are a great leader. However, you need to create an action plan, while keeping track of the employee's progress. Once you see improvement in a certain aspect,

focus on another area. Once you start to see development, acknowledge the employee's efforts.

CREATE A TEAM BUILDING WORKSHOP

In many cases, attitude problems arise as a result of personality conflicts that build up over time. Each employee has a different character and values, and frequently, different personality styles clash with others. By conducting a team building workshop, you can create a safe place

for coworkers to understand and appreciate each other through a new angle. This workshop along with personality type tests such as the MBTI can be a powerful tool in reducing conflict and opening communication channels between coworkers.

WHEN NONE OF YOUR EFFORTS WORK

As a leader you need to demonstrate yourself the attitude you'd like to see others display, and demand similar behaviour from your team. If you do so, the odds will go way up that that's

what you'll get. This doesn't guarantee that you'll succeed at changing negative attitudes. There are no guarantees! Your informal efforts might actually fail and you will have to move to official corrective actions such as terminating the employee. Terminating the employee can turn out to be the best solution. Keep in mind that: It's not the people you fire who make your life miserable; it's the people you don't.

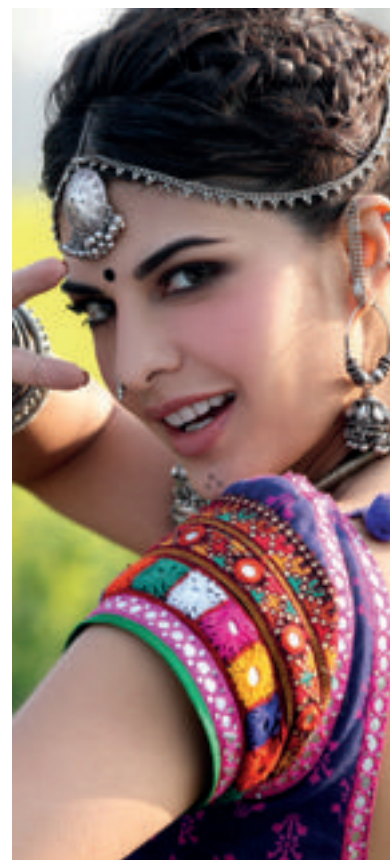

Bindi

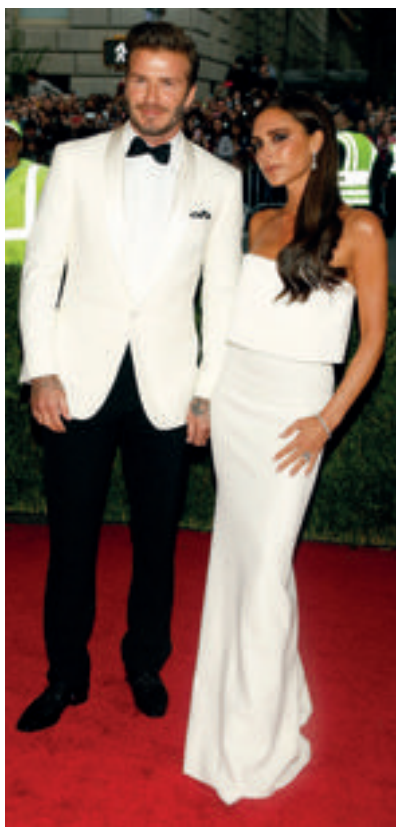

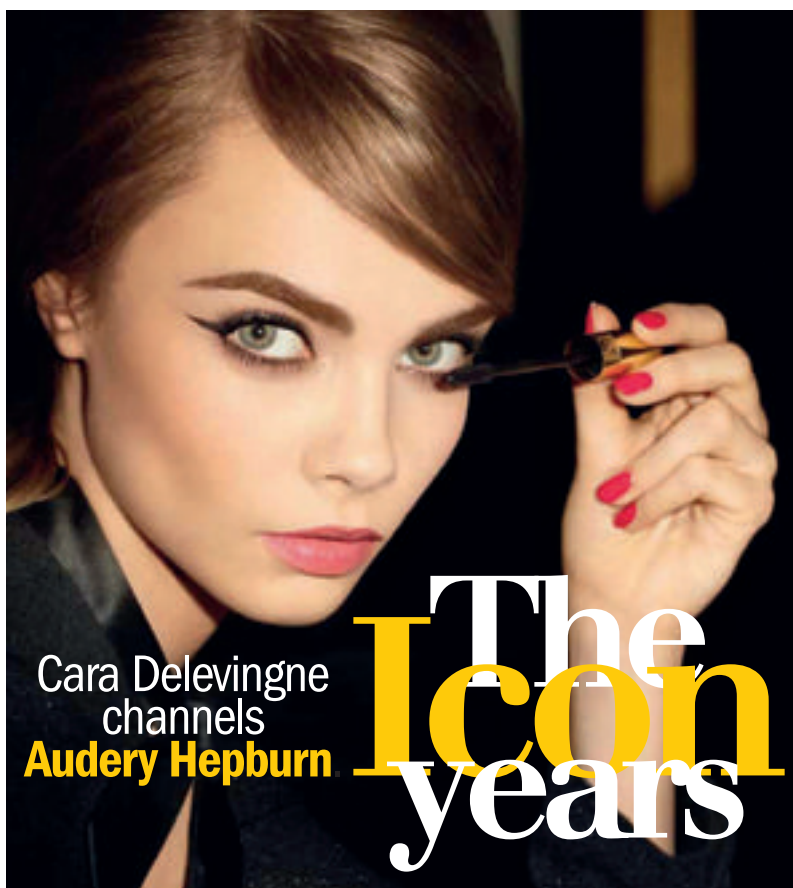
James: Beyond Fashion', we were looking forward to some top high society frocks and tails.

While he's away, she builds up her relationship with her great grandmother played by Sylvia Syms, who had also been separated from her beau in the past because of war. "I worked years ago with a beautiful girl who became very famous," the 80-year-old actress said. "This child here has the same quality which is known as not acting for the camera. She is real and an absolute joy to work with. I was told I was going to work with a model and I had never heard of her but I literally fell in love with her on the first day. The other girl I loved was Audrey Hepburn." And the feeling

of admiration is reciprocated, because Cara showed equal admiration for the veteran artist by posting a picture on Instagram saying, "Thank you skyarts and everyone involved in making *Timeless*. I am so lucky to have worked with this woman and be able to call her my

friend; she has taught me so much! #SylviaSyms #legend #thankyou [sic]."

Audrey Hepburn, British actress and humanitarian came to be synonymous with a form of elegance. Even in her early films, her height, her skinniness and her wistfulness combined to get her noticed. In the unhelpful role of Chiquita in *The Lavender Hill Mob*, she attracts the attention both of Alec Guinness and of the camera: a woman visually striking and possessed of a certain quality of unhappiness.

Being slight and vulnerable, Hepburn could have made a career as one of cinema's perpetual victims, a leading lady for Alfred Hitchcock, maybe. But she was too thoughtful, and too smart in her choice of roles, to let that happen.

As leading roles in Hollywood pictures followed, and Hepburn was romantically linked to various leading lights: the usual story. Where she differed in her trajectory from the starlets who had gone before, perhaps, was in her conscious decision to become a fashionista. The designer Hubert de Givenchy became a close friend and advised her on her wardrobe. Eventually the pair became business partners.

The association of actors or singers with a brand seems old-hat now: the kind of product placement that Lady Gaga might parody or Bono personify. If you want someone to blame for those glossy ads of Mr and Mrs Bono getting out of their safari plane with their designer luggage, the blame must ultimately fall on the fair shoulders of La Hepburn and Givenchy, who called her his muse.

How did brownmonkeys start?
The Brownmonkeys started in 2007. It was a union of like minded

individuals who have an alternative approach on art and design. The collective was officially formed and launched on a self-curated exhibit called the Brown Project held in Five Green, Dubai. A group exhibit mainly showcasing a mix of pop-surrealism, street and urban art.

Where did it originate? (because I know that most of them are Filipinos)

It was originated in Dubai through casual gatherings and discussions. That time, everyone felt a need to explore new ideas and defining their status as visual artists.

Are there artists besides Filipinos?

Not at the moment but we are constantly open for new collaborations and project experimentation no matter where you are or where you are from.

How many artists are a part of Brownmonkeys?

Currently we are six individuals in the collective; namely Victoria Viray-Ganzon, Mark Ganzon, Cholo Juan, Joseph Manata, Rafael Valencia and Rollan Rodriguez.

How long have they been together?

The collective is at constant change. People come and go. For seven strong years, we might be the oldest existing artist collective here in the UAE.

How did they come to the name 'Brownmonkeys'?

The name Brownmonkeys is about the importance of your colour and your attitude. It was symbol of oppression but interpreted to be a symbol of power to anyone who recognises it.

What type of arts do they do (since I know they also do moldings, not just paintings?)

Styles vary from different cases and skills depending on the task at hand. Most of us are designers and art directors by profession, so we present varied skill set. But we have always been a fan and an advocated of pop-surrealism, street/urban and lowbrow art.

What attracts you to pop surrealism and the art you guys focus on?

We wanted to combine different

types of medium such as comics, film and music. We think pop surrealism/urban art is one of the most eloquent ways to express our art.

Do you have a studio, where can we go see your artwork?

We don't have a shared studio yet. Currently, we are all working at our own separate environment. Hopefully in the near future we can acquire our own working space.

We are a closed group but we are always open and on a look out for new collaborations so I would say for that person to contact us on our Facebook or Website.

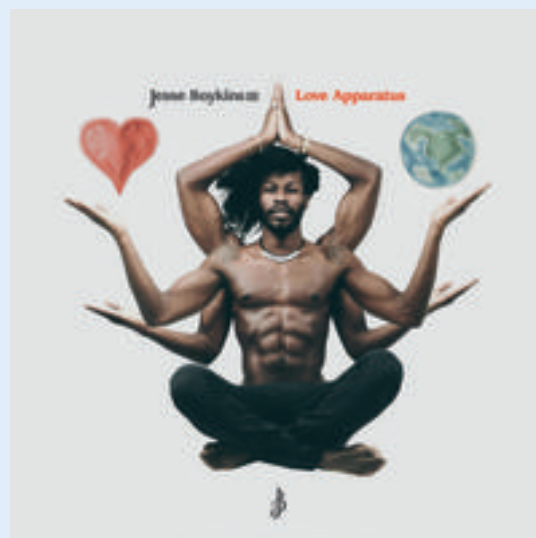

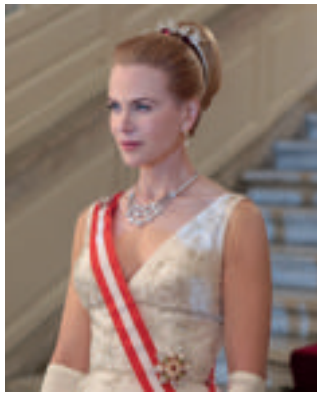

Rajinikanth's Twitter debut

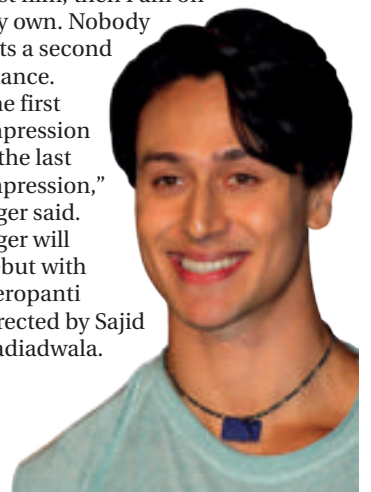

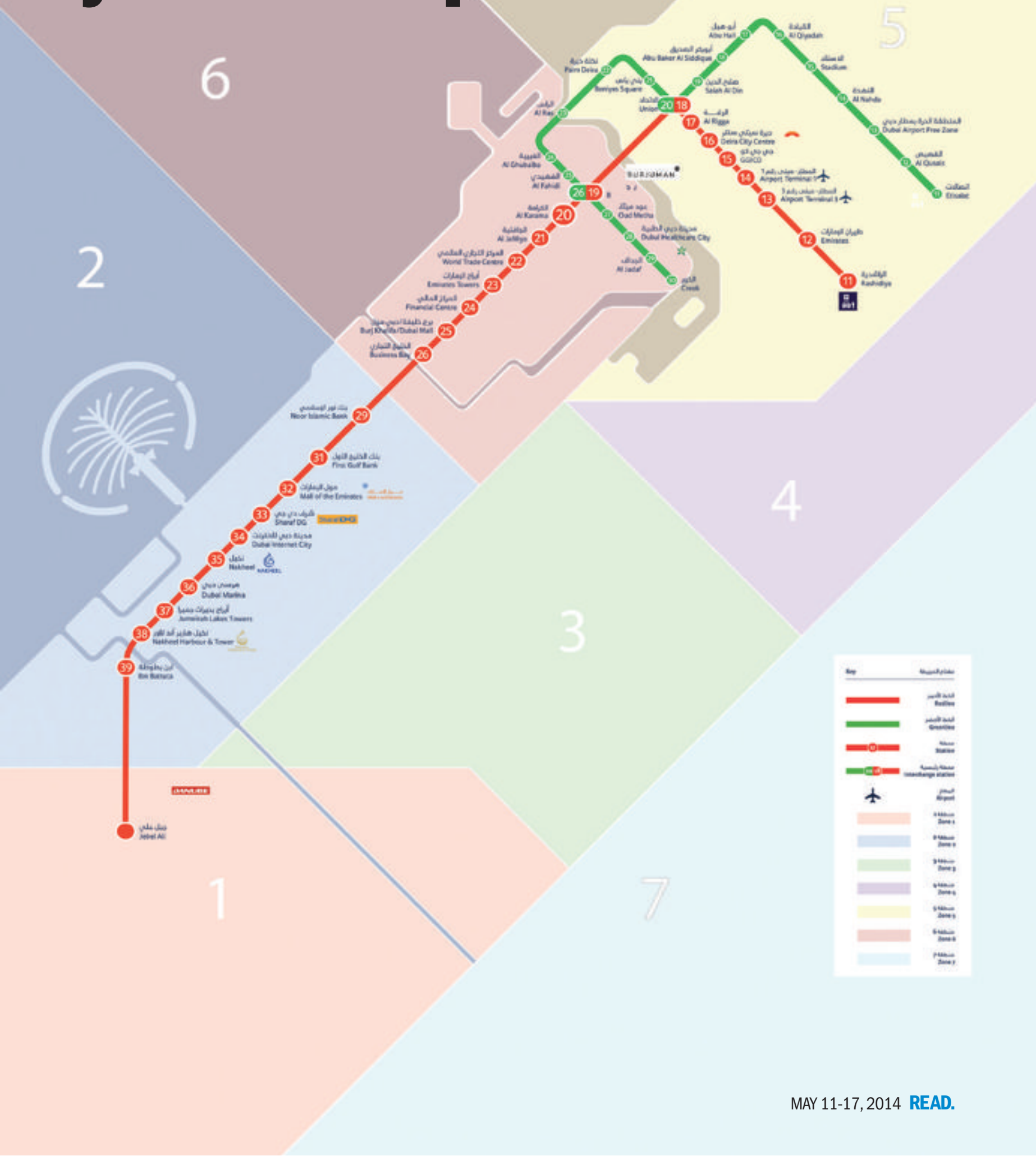
Will never use my father's name to get a film

Dubai Metro system map



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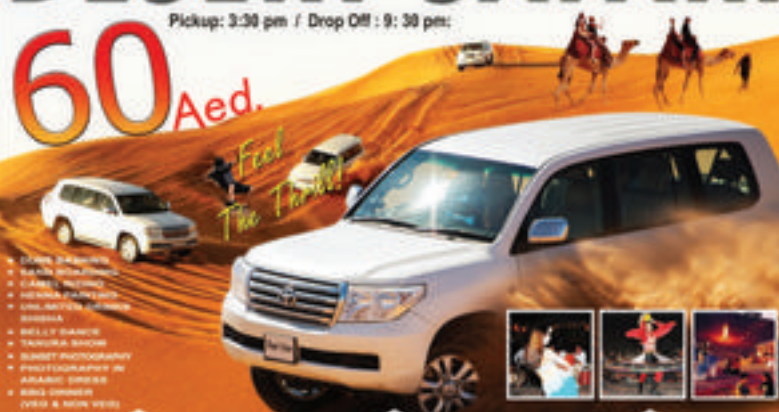

Street lights to go off partially

RTA commences power-saving initiative to reduce carbon emission as well as curb power wastage.

INITIATIVES

The Roads & Transport Authority (RTA), has started implementing a power saving policy involving street-lights, including partially switching off some street lights in collector and internal roads in residential communities witnessing thin traffic movement at night. The initiative is also intended to achieve environmental benefits by reducing carbon emission to the atmosphere, and achieving material benefits as the reduction of power consumption reduces power wastage.

In this context, Engineer Maitha Bin Udai, CEO of RTA Traffic & Roads Agency, said: "The power saving initiative involves switching off street lights of 44 per cent of total street lighting poles in residential communities in a process that will be implemented alternately and varies from one community to another depending on several factors including the neighbourhood area and the number of lighting poles in place." The RTA has set a number of criteria and conditions governing the implementation of the power saving initiative following an intensive

study addressing all details in terms of providing safety for drivers and residential districts starting from 10pm, while giving due consideration to avoiding switching off lights at intersections and road curves in order to maintain traffic safety.

"The power saving plan in the lighting systems of residential communities in Dubai has been subjected to a thorough study and will be implemented in a way that ensures the smooth flow of traffic as well as the safety and security of users of roads," added Maitha.

Awareness campaigns are being launched to educate residents about the initiative and the benefits resulting from power-saving despite public complaints at the start of the implementation of the initiative. These campaigns stress the importance of conserving various resources of the UAE, including electricity, to support the government's efforts towards reducing consumption in keeping with the strategic plans for achieving environmental sustainability and increasing the benefits from existing resources by undertaking new projects and initiatives built on safety and conserving the environment.



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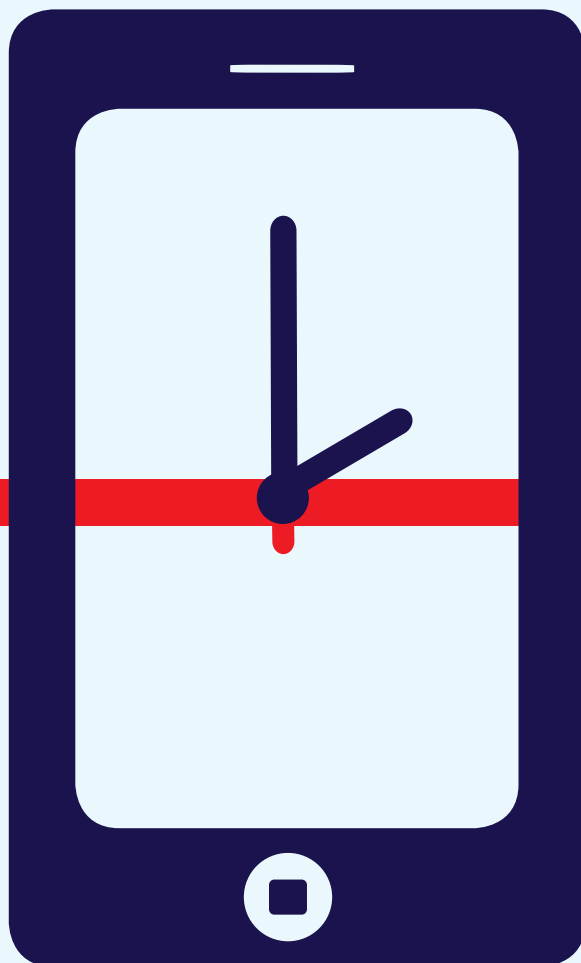

Here's our selection of some healthy recipes for a healthier and fitter you this summer.

Mediterranean Fish & Couscous

Oven cook or barbecue fish in foil to keep it beautifully moist.

Prep Time: 10 mins

Cook time: 20 mins

Ingredients

2 x 125g sustainable white fish fillets (we used Pollock)
2 lemons, zest and juice 1, the other cut into wedges
1 red chilli, half sliced, half finely chopped
small bunch basil, shredded
200g cherry tomatoes
100g couscous
2 tbsp balsamic vinegar
½ cucumber, diced
2 tbsp pitted black olives, halved

Serves
2

Method

1. Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Take one small sheet of foil, about A4 size, and put one fish fillet on top. Season the fish, then drizzle with half



of the lemon juice and zest, half the sliced chillies and half of the basil.

2. Halve 4 of the tomatoes and put these around the fish. Place another sheet of foil on top and fold the edges together to seal. Repeat with the other piece of fish and transfer to a baking sheet. Cook for 15-18 mins until the bag has puffed up (or cook on the barbecue).

3. While the fish is cooking pour 100ml of boiling water over the couscous, cover, then leave to swell for 5 mins. Chop the rest of the tomatoes and mix with the couscous, balsamic, cucumber, the remaining basil, lemon juice and zest and olives. Season and serve alongside the fish with the lemon wedges on the side for squeezing over.

Italian Tuna Balls

A super healthy twist on a family favourite that can be served with spaghetti or squashed flat and cooked as burgers.

Prep Time: 15 mins

Cook Time: 20 mins

Serves
4

Ingredients

2 160g cans of tuna in sunflower or olive oil, drained (reserve a little oil)
small handful of pine nuts
freshly grated zest 1 lemon
small handful parsley leaves, roughly chopped
50g fresh breadcrumbs
1 egg, beaten
400g spaghetti
500g jar pasta sauce

Method

1. Flake the tuna into a bowl, then tip in the pine nuts, lemon zest, parsley,

breadcrumbs and egg. Season and mix together with your hands until completely combined. Roll the mix into 12 walnut-size balls. Put a large pan of salted water on to boil, then cook the spaghetti according to pack instructions.

2. Heat a little of the tuna oil in a large non-stick frying pan, then fry the tuna balls for 5 mins, turning every minute or so until completely golden. Drain on kitchen paper. Heat the tomato sauce, then toss together with the pasta and tuna balls.
