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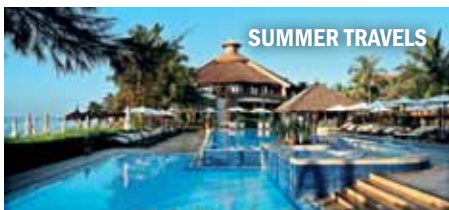

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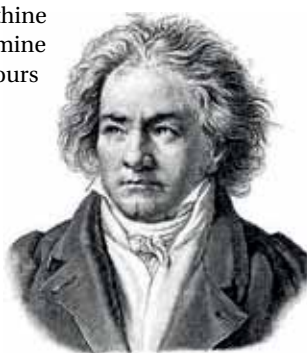
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Poem of the week

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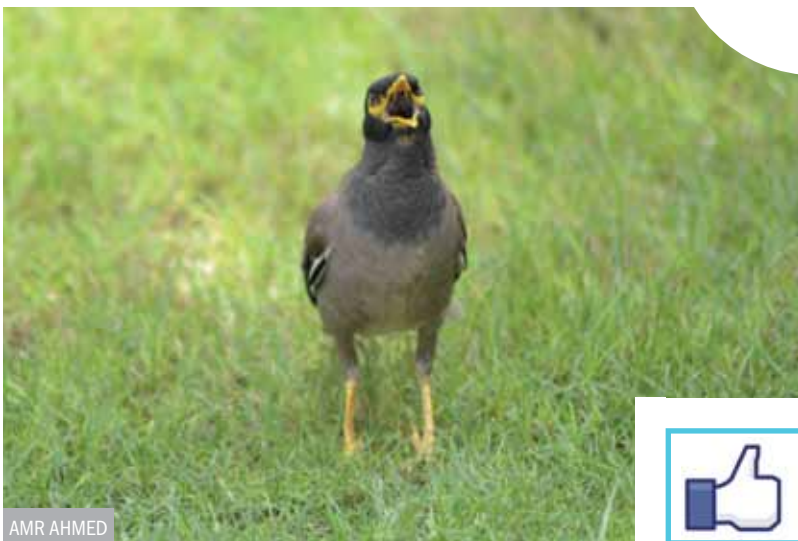

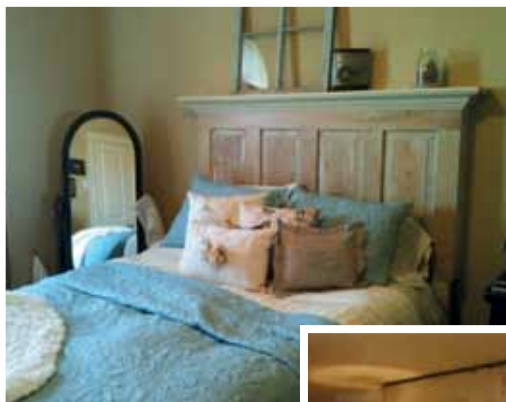

4. Hotel Mocking Bird Hill Jamaica \$195

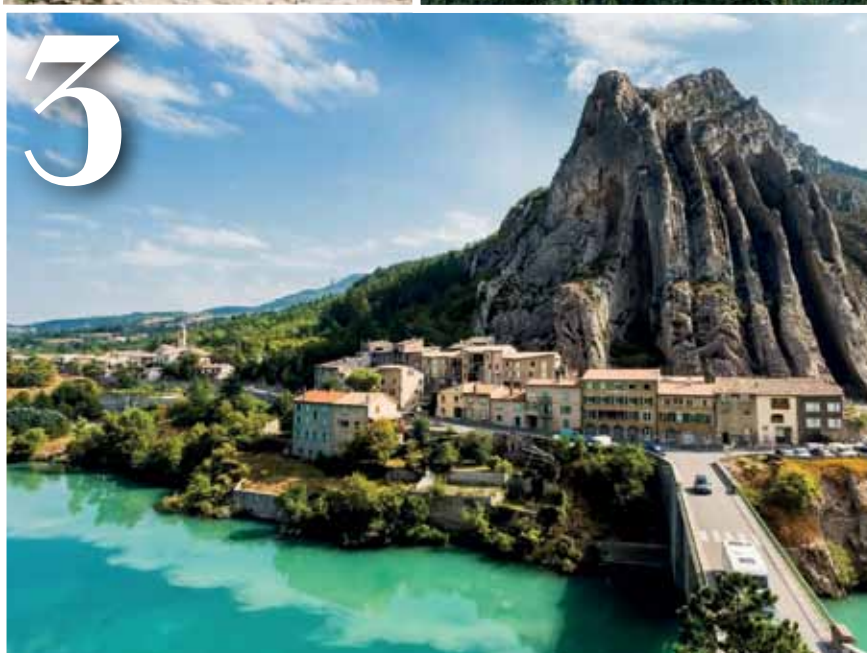

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#BringBackOurGirls

#BringBackOurGirls focuses world's eyes on Nigeria's mass kidnapping.

Six weeks after 257 girls were snatched from their school in Chibok, a fortnight after #BringBackOurGirls first appeared on Twitter, and a day after Barack Obama described the kidnapping as both heart-breaking and outrageous, the eyes of the world are finally and firmly fixed on events in the remote reaches of north-eastern Nigeria.

With stars including Cara Delevigne, Justin Timberlake and one of the latest Michelle Obama becoming the latest high profile name to tweet her support and in cities as far apart as Abuja, Washington, Los Angeles, Dublin and London, demonstrators have put on red T-shirts to draw attention to the girls' plight, demand their release, and to vent a deepening sense of anger.

Protests have been carried out in countries including the UK, the US, South Africa, Jamaica and Switzerland.

#BringBackOurGirls has exploded across social media, powered by a desire to reunite 279 kidnapped Nigerian girls with their parents as well as a strong sense of outrage. Facebook and Twitter are well adapted mediums for protest. If the girls had gone missing in a European country whether white or black, there would have been far more coverage, because such events in Europe are unheard of and therefore in industry terms, more newsworthy. Many of us have been on holiday to Europe and it is a sad fact of humanity that we care more about things we can imagine happening to us.

It's not just politicians and the media watching social media. Boko Haram might be militants, but that doesn't mean they aren't on Twitter. Terrorists want to spread terror and

are increasingly using social media due to the accessible, affordable platform it provides. Giving their acts of atrocity airtime may fuel their aims, but the widespread condemnation such campaigns bring may also serve as a foil. Either way, they are listening to what we say. Groups like Al Qaeda and Al Shabab use social media extensively: it's not beyond the realms of possibility to imagine them employing a social media editor in the future. If hashtag activism really spits in their custard, such an employee may tell his boss 'this #bringbackourgirls meme, well, it's going to make our lives hell and it's just not worth

it.' For all that is wrong with hashtag activism, it is only going to get more powerful in the future. It's not to be sniffed at

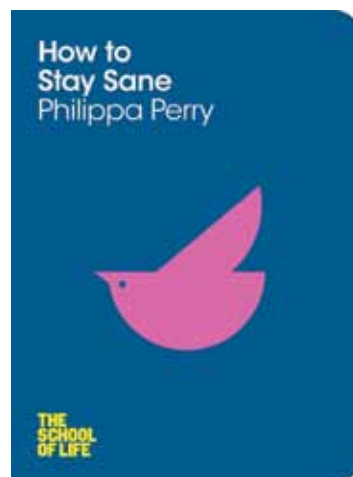

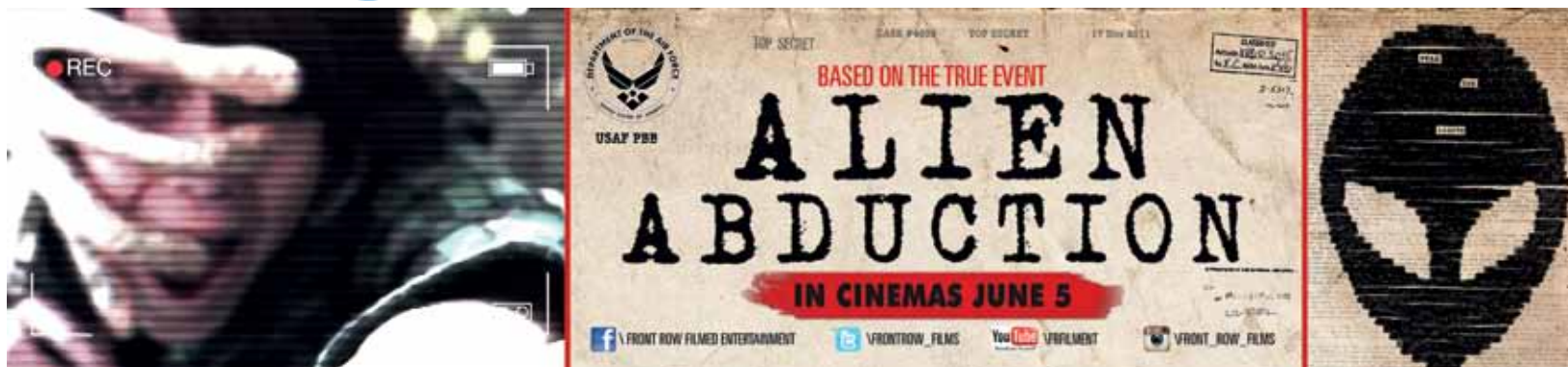

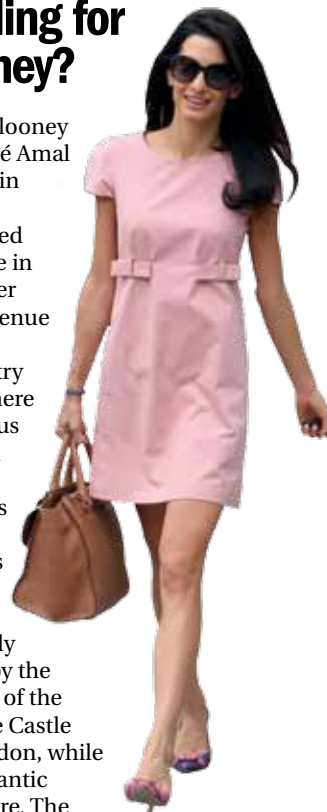
KimYe wedding woes

Kalki and Anurag still good friends

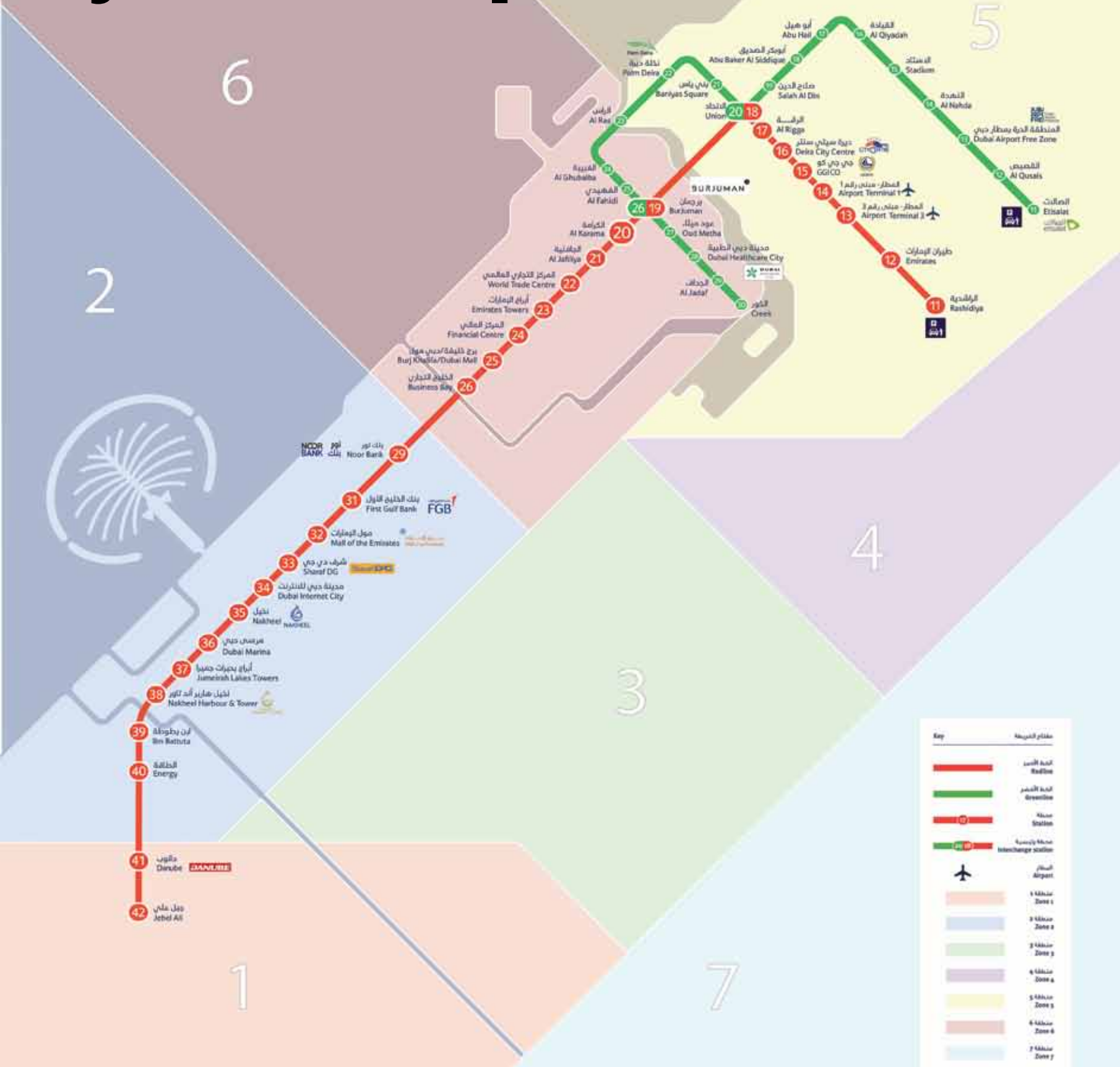

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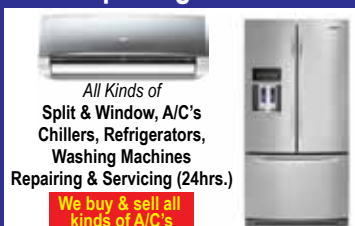

PASSENGERS ARE INCREASINGLY TAKING THE METRO

STATISTICS

The Roads & Transport Authority (RTA) has announced that Dubai Metro, comprising the Red and Green Lines, posted high ridership rates this April, clocking 13,879,636 passengers, which compares well with the ridership recorded during the same period last year, which amounted to 11,298,414 riders.

Abdullah Yousef Al Ali, Acting CEO of the RTA Rail Agency, said: "The number of metro riders in April reflects that Dubai Metro has become one of the prime transit means commanding the attention of Dubai residents, visitors and tourists, offering smooth

mobility and access to key parts of the city in a way that measures up to the needs and expectations of users. "This year has witnessed a remarkable growth in the number of metro riders compared to the previous year; which has always been the core of our plans tailored to delivering a whole host of initiatives and service improvements capable of enticing all community members to use the metro as a primary transit means characterised by security, luxury and safety."

Al Ali added: "The number of trips made by the metro on both the Red and Green Lines this April amounted to 18,354 trips (10,244 trips on the Red Line, and 8,110 trips on the

Green Line) which compares well with the number of trips made in the same month last year where the total number of trips was 16,534 trips (8,866 trips on the Red Line and 7,668 trips on the Green Line).

"The number of metro riders using the Red Line this April clocked 8,806,055 riders, reflecting an increase over the ridership reported during the same month last year which amounted to 7,347,979 riders. Likewise, the ridership of the Green Line this April reached 5,073,581 riders, reflecting an increase over statistics of ridership during the same month last year which was 3,950,435 riders."

"Deira City station on the Red Line topped the metro stations in terms of passengers this April, reporting 607,150 passengers followed by Union station clocking 578,918 passengers, and Burj Khalifa/Dubai Mall station was a close third reporting 577,249 passengers. Al Rigga station was fourth with 539,889 passengers using the station.

"Al Fahidi station on the Green Line came first this April, recording a ridership of 579,879 passengers, followed by Bani Yas station serving 539,278 passengers, and in the third place came Al Ghubaiba station recording 402,275 passengers, ahead of Oud Metha station ranking fourth with passengers' count reported as 385,725 passengers," said Al Ali.

Services set for move to smart channels

Implementation of services' shift from front-end centres in Dubai begins from June 1 this year and includes driver licences.

Beginning from June 1 this year, the Licensing Agency at the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), will begin diverting services relating to the renewal and issuance of driver licences, issuance of replacement/lost or damaged driver licences, and the issuance of experience certificates and to whom it may concern certificates from several front-end centres in Dubai to smart channels.

Ahmed Bahrozian, CEO of the RTA Licensing Agency, said: "Switching

the delivery of public services to innovative channels is an integral part of the RTA's business drive in keeping with its vision aimed at improving and providing customer service 24/7 under the overall vision of our wise government to transform Dubai into the smartest city worldwide within three years.

"From June 1, some services relating to the renewal of driver licences, issuance of replacement/lost or damaged driver licences, issuance of experience certificates as well as to whom it may concern certi-

icates will be shifted from the seven front-end centres in Dubai emirate to smart channels such as the RTA website (www.rta.ae), call centre (8008080), trusted agents (driving institutes), and eye-sight testing centres (Yateem Optician, Grand Optics, Magrabi Optical, Sharp Vision, Dubai, Emirates, and Barakat)," said Bahrozian.

Bahrozian stated the delivery of the services will be confined to four centres spread all over Dubai namely: Al Manara centre, Al Tawar centre, Tasjeel centre, and JBR centre, in or-

der to make the services available to those community segments who are not in a position to interact through other channels.

"The Licensing Agency will gradually embark on making other services available through smart channels in order to boost their use amongst the public to meet their ambitions, particularly as they combine accuracy and simplicity in processing transactions at world-class standards in order to maintain the pioneering stand of Dubai emirate in various fields," added Bahrozian.

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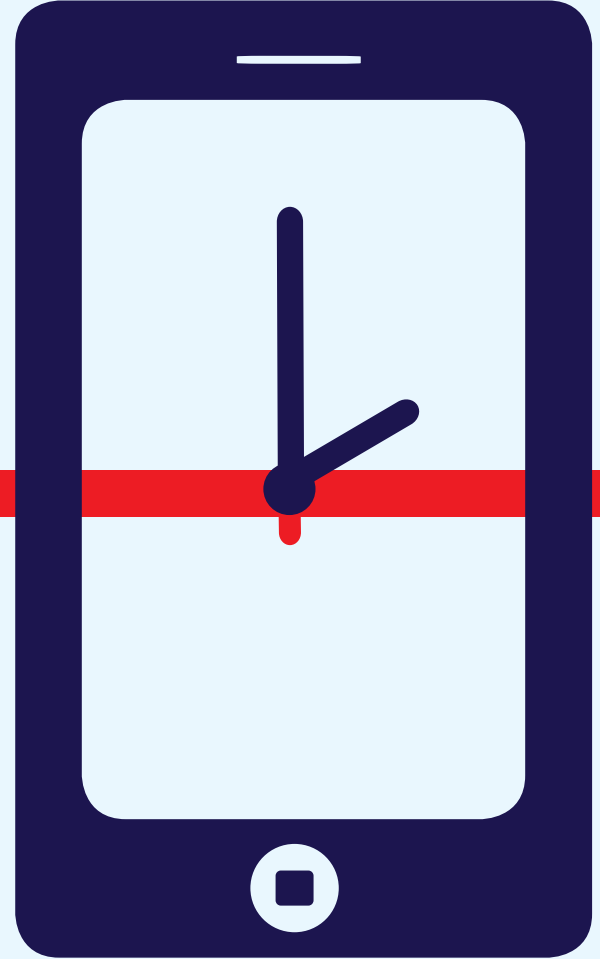
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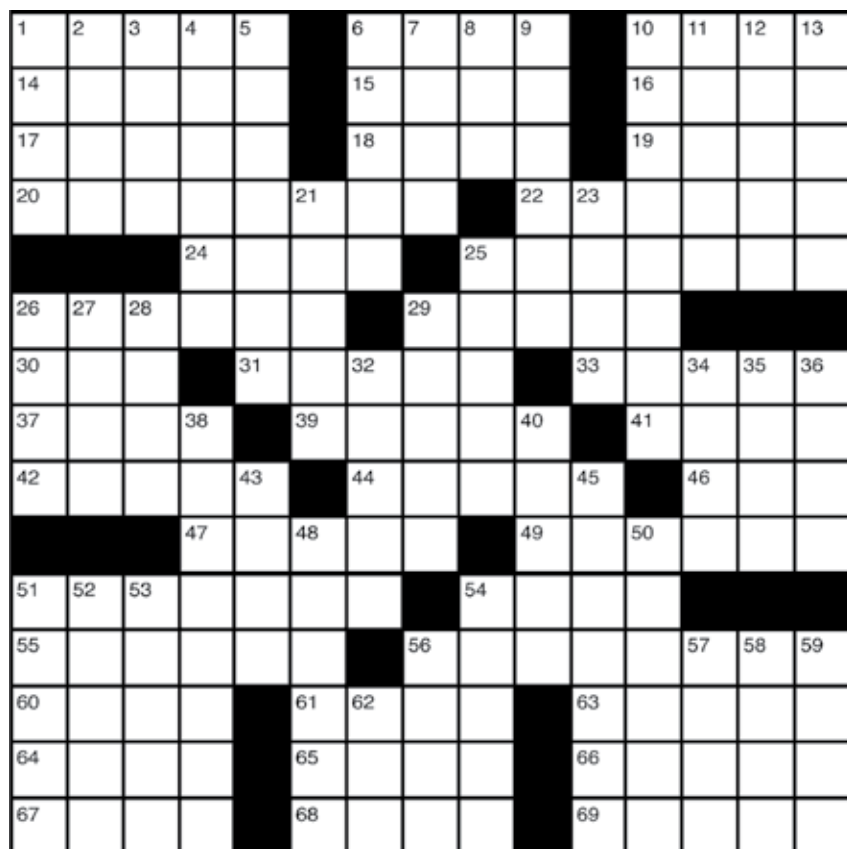

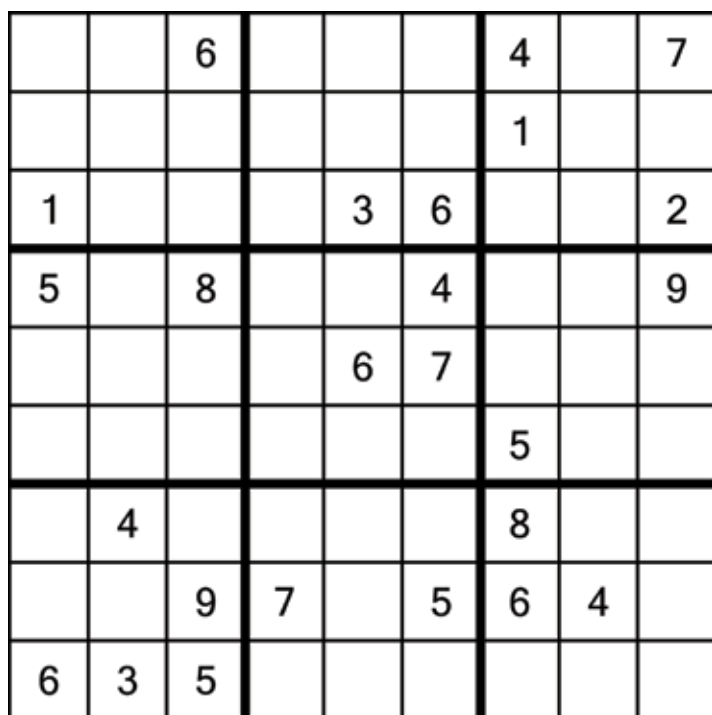

The new CV rules

Stop making your CV look old!



Employers today receive hundreds of applications for each vacancy. That's why you cannot make any mistakes when it comes to writing and formatting your CV. This doesn't mean that your CV is all that matters, but it is the first impression that will help you get your foot in the door. So if you haven't updated your CV in a while, you may be falling behind the competition. As the job market keeps changing, many job seekers believe that a CV has become an obsolete job search tool, but this is not the case. BE SPECIFIC

Many job seekers prefer to keep their CVs overly vague in hopes of expanding their career options. Instead, a CV should highlight specific details about your employment history while contextualising your achievements in numbers. Try to include quantifiable results such as sales numbers, growth rates, or even the number of new customers won. Keep in mind that having numbers in your CV is much more believable than fancy personal descriptions.

CHOOSE HARD COURSES OVER STRAIGHT A'S

Many job seekers to this day believe that having a high GPA would open all kinds of doors for them. But em-

ployers don't hire a straight-A student over someone with relevant work experience and a great track record. While having good grades might tip the scales in your favour in a competitive situation, but in most cases, grades aren't really that important to employers. In fact, getting a lower grade in a challenging course can be more impressive to employers than getting an A in an easy class.

THE ONE PAGE RULE

You may have heard that you should try to fit your CV on one page. This rule applies to recent graduates or entry-level candidates who can easily

fit all of their experience on one page without sacrifice. But for experienced and seasoned professionals, a two-page CV or even more is the most common format. You no longer have to spend countless hours trying to squeeze tens of experience years onto a single sheet. The 1-page CV no longer rules, as today's recruiters are more likely to be scrolling down on their screen than flipping to the next page.

INCLUDE RELEVANT KEYWORDS

Nowadays, CVs are filtered and scanned electronically as often as they're read by an actual person.

For example, Akhtaboot employer section is designed to scan CVs for certain keywords chosen by the employer. If your CV doesn't include the right keywords, there's a good chance that it won't land in the employer's hands. You can add keywords to your CV in two ways. The easier way is to simply include a 'Core Competencies' section that has a number of keywords that are relevant to your specialty. ITALIAN PIZZA

INGREDIENTS

Already prepared dough base
1 tbsp olive oil, plus extra for greasing
3 x 125g balls mozzarella, torn
fresh basil, to serve
For the tomato sauce
3 tbsp olive oil
1 onion, chopped
1 garlic clove, crushed
2 x 400g cans good-quality
Italian chopped tomatoes

METHOD

For the sauce, heat the oil in a pan over a moderate heat. Add the onion and cook for 3 mins, stirring constantly. Add the garlic, 1 tsp sea salt and 1 tsp ground black pepper and cook for 2 mins more. Add the tomatoes and bring to the boil, then reduce the heat and simmer for a good 20 mins, stirring occasionally.

On your already prepared dough base, spread over some of the tomato sauce (I like to apply it in the quantity that you would spread Marmite on toast, or the base will be soft and fall to bits), then the cheese and any toppings you desire. Cook for between 5-10 mins depending on your oven temp, until the base is crisp and the cheese melted. Scatter with basil.

SALMON TACOS

INGREDIENTS

1 tsp garlic salt
2 tbsp smoked paprika
good pinch of sugar
500g salmon fillets
200ml fat-free yogurt
1 tbsp chipotle paste or hot chilli sauce
juice 1 lime
To serve
8 small soft flour tortillas, warmed
¼ small green cabbage, finely shredded
small bunch coriander, picked into sprigs
few pickled jalapeno chillies, sliced
lime wedges, to serve
hot chilli sauce to serve, (optional)

METHOD

Rub the garlic salt, paprika, sugar and some seasoning into the flesh of the salmon fillet. Heat grill to high.

Mix the yogurt, chipotle paste or hot sauce and lime juice together in a bowl with some seasoning, and set aside. Place the salmon on a baking tray lined with foil and grill, skin-side down, for 7-8 mins until cooked through. Remove from the grill and carefully peel off and discard the skin.

Flake the salmon into large chunks and serve with the warmed tortillas, chipotle yogurt, shredded cabbage, coriander, jalapeños and lime wedges. Add a shake of hot sauce, if you like it spicy. Scatter with basil.

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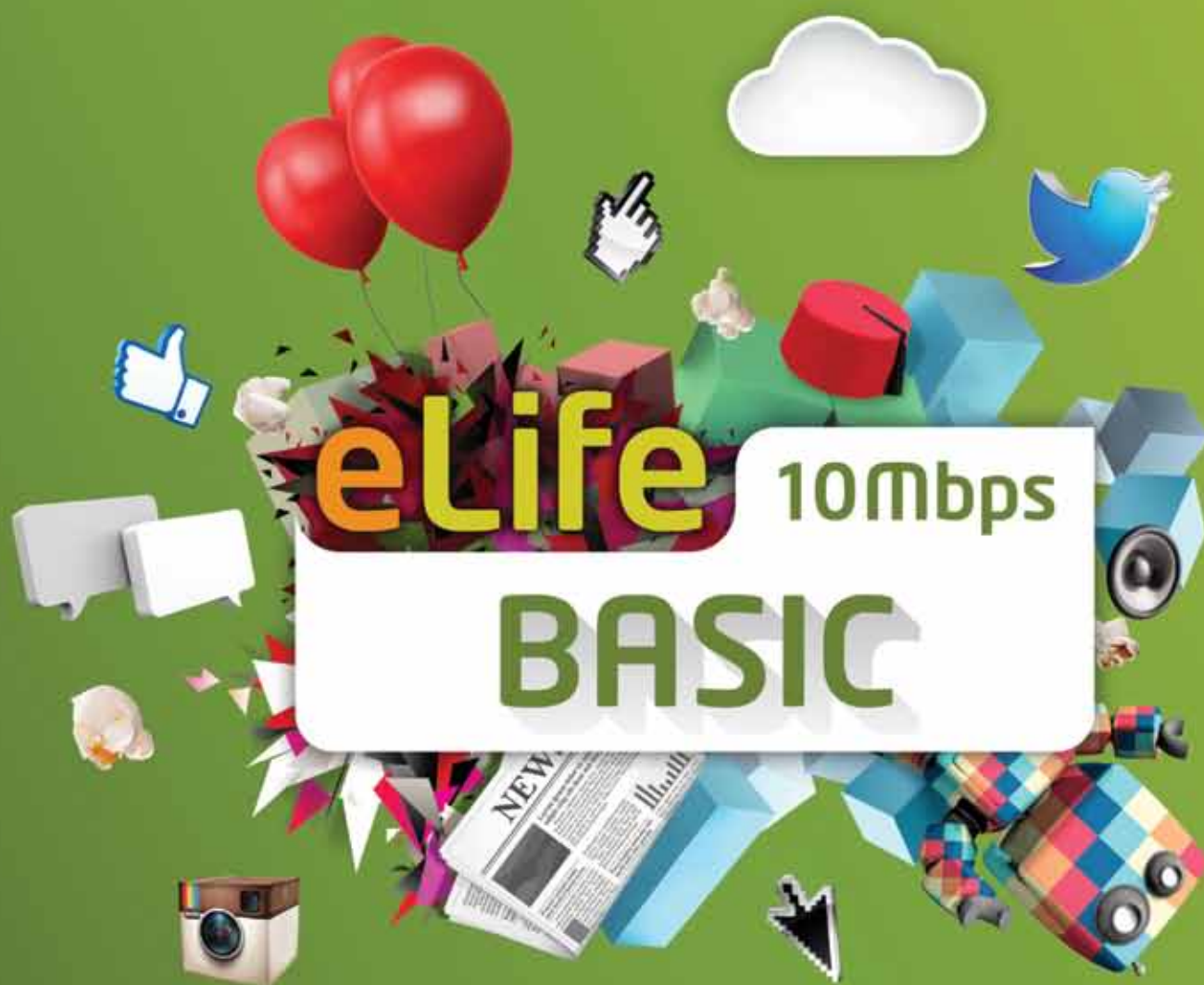
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
