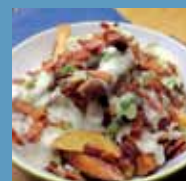

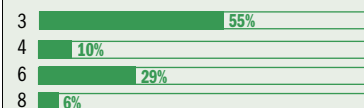

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How to **maintain** positive **wellbeing**

A few tips on how to take care of yourself and look after your wellbeing.



Get the right balance

It is important that we do things in moderation and aim to incorporate a balance of activities within our busy schedules. This can be difficult when we are highly stressed and feel that there just aren't enough hours in the day, we probably need to ask ourselves how necessary is it that a particular activity needs to be carried out that day. To help with this, you could

try ranking your scheduled activities out of 10 as to how important or necessary they are to be carried out at that specific time; could it be that we are just placing too much pressure on ourselves? We want to aim to incorporate a balance of routine, necessary and pleasurable activities each day. Imagine yourself as a three legged stool, the minute we lose the balance in our activities we then pose the risk of falling over, possibly becoming overwhelmed or dissatisfied.



Sleep well

It is a common misconception that we need eight hours sleep per night in order to function the next day. Although sleep is essential, the average number of hours we need per night varies dramatically from person to person. Although sleep is an automatic process we can develop unhelpful behaviours which can interfere with that process resulting in poor, broken and non restorative sleep. The smallest changes can dramatically improve the depth and quality of our sleep. For example, refrain from looking at the clock when waking as this will stimulate arousal and you could potentially find it difficult to drift back off. Others include avoiding caffeine four hours before bed, keeping the bedroom for sleep only and avoiding heavy meals and exercise prior to bed time. Often it is difficult to switch off our racing mind from thoughts and worries, in order to combat this only go to bed when feeling sleepy and have a go at some relaxation or distraction techniques.



Face Your Fears

Avoidance is the key maintaining factor in common mood disorders such as anxiety, depression and specific phobias.

When feeling low we might want to withdraw from those around us, this might take the form of avoiding calls or making up excuses not to attend social events. Although initially

we might feel relieved this is only short-term, and is soon replaced with feelings such as guilt or depression. In addition to this, reducing our levels of activity due to a lack of motivation will exacerbate the physical symptoms of low mood such as fatigue and lethargy, which begs the question; if you cancel arrangements with a friend because you're feeling tired are you really tired, or is it just the viscous cycle of avoidance feeding your increasing levels of fatigue?

When feeling anxious or afraid we might avoid a particular object or activity. However, in doing so we fail to learn that we can cope when confronted with a perceived threat. The more we avoid the more exaggerate our fears become which strengthens our perceived inability to cope. Once again, although avoidance offers short-term relief, it is in fact one key component that maintains the problem.

In order to overcome avoidance we need to gradually expose ourselves by facing our fears; the crucial word being 'gradually'.

Rio de Janeiro

There is no destination on earth more animated and exciting than Rio de Janeiro. Located in southeastern Brazil, Rio de Janeiro is the most visited city of South America due to its famous mountains, landmarks, beaches and Carnival festival. Bu Qtair is a **quaint little hut** doesn't look like much but there **fishy delights** are enough to keep you heading back **again and again.**



When I heard about Bu Qtair, all I heard was that it was a tiny hut, unlike nothing you would see in Dubai; on arrival I realised people weren't lying. The restaurant is literally a tiny hut; I probably would have passed it, if it wasn't for the queues of people outside. A popular hangout for fish lovers and known by most locals, as an expat I wouldn't have known about this place unless someone told me, it's not the kind of place you just stumble upon. Bu Qtair is only open on an evening 6pm til 11.30pm I would say try get there before 6pm though as I learned when I arrived it's a very popular spot and you can end up waiting for 30-40 minutes, the seating area outside is very basic, no

fancy thrills just plastic dining tables and multi-coloured plastic tools. The menu is unwritten, and is flexible depending upon the catch of the day which is limited to mostly Sheri, Hamour, Pomfret, Snapper and Shrimps. In colder months, King Fish is sometimes included in the menu. While in the initial days, he would be buying in from the local fishermen who would anchor their fishing boats by his shack, now he resorts to a regular supply from bigger fish markets. Once my food arrived I wasn't disappointed, apart from been a tad squeamish that my fish still had its head attached the flavours were beautiful, the fish was no doubt fresh and the spices subtle. The staff were very nice and we left smiling and with a full tummy, would recommend to anyone looking for something a little more authentic.

Melissah is from Melbourne in Australia and has been living in Dubai for the past 8 years, this is where she started her jewellery brand and started taking them to stalls all around Dubai. Melissah is one of Dubai's young rising talents; make sure you check her out @byladymauve

WHAT OR WHO INSPIRED YOU TO START CREATING JEWELLERY

I grew up attending dancing throughout my youth. The love for creating jewellery started at a young age. I used to use all my left over dancing costume materials, to make unique pieces of jewellery, which nobody else had. Having creative parents was also inspirational growing up, so being creative is in my genes.

TELL US A BIT MORE ABOUT THE DESIGNS YOU HAVE AND THE MATERIALS YOU USE

Lady Mauve jewellery is very bright and colourful statement jewellery, made for anybody, who loves to stand out from the crowd. I have been drawn to using crystals, for their rawness and beauty. It makes

every piece unique and different.

WHAT'S THE LATEST EDITION TO THE LADYMAUVE COLLECTION?

Lately I have started adding graffiti inspired mirrors, which have been a massive hit.

IF ANYONE, WHO WOULD YOU LOVE TO COLLABORATE WITH?

Lady Pink NYC she's the first graffiti artist, who I dedicated my label to. Check her out, her works amazing, and can give any guy a run for his money, she has been in the game since the late 70's.

WHO'S YOUR FAVOURITE JEWELLERY DESIGNER?

I love Von Treskow, Mimco, Najo, and McQueen to name just a few.

DO YOU HAVE ANY PLANS TO OPEN UP A SHOP?

That would be the dream, but even if I had a shop, I would always attend the markets. I love the vibe at markets, and would find it hard to give them up. I love meeting new people every weekend that you wouldn't necessarily meet if I was just inside a shop all day.

WHAT TECHNIQUES DO YOU EMPLOY AND HOW LONG DOES IT USUALLY TAKE TO MAKE YOUR PIECES

Each piece is different. Some pieces

can take days, while others can take 30 mins.

Depending if I have a design in my mind or not. Usually I place all the components in front of me to create a piece. I rarely draw a creation. I find it easier to create jewellery, when all the colours and beads are right there in front of me. Most of the techniques used, are with all types of pliers and cutters.

WHICH IS YOUR FAVORITE PIECE AND IS THERE A STORY BEHIND IT

All the pieces I create have a special meaning, as I hand make most of them. At the beginning it was hard to let them go. Most of my colour patterns are influenced by graffiti. My husband is a graffiti artist, and is a huge inspiration to me.

WHAT CHALLENGES DID YOU FACE WHEN STARTING YOUR LABEL?

There are a lot of challenges when you start a label. I showcase at a lot of pop up stores and markets so it's really about putting the hard work in and not giving up it's almost been four years now I've been doing it and only now I've gotten noticed.

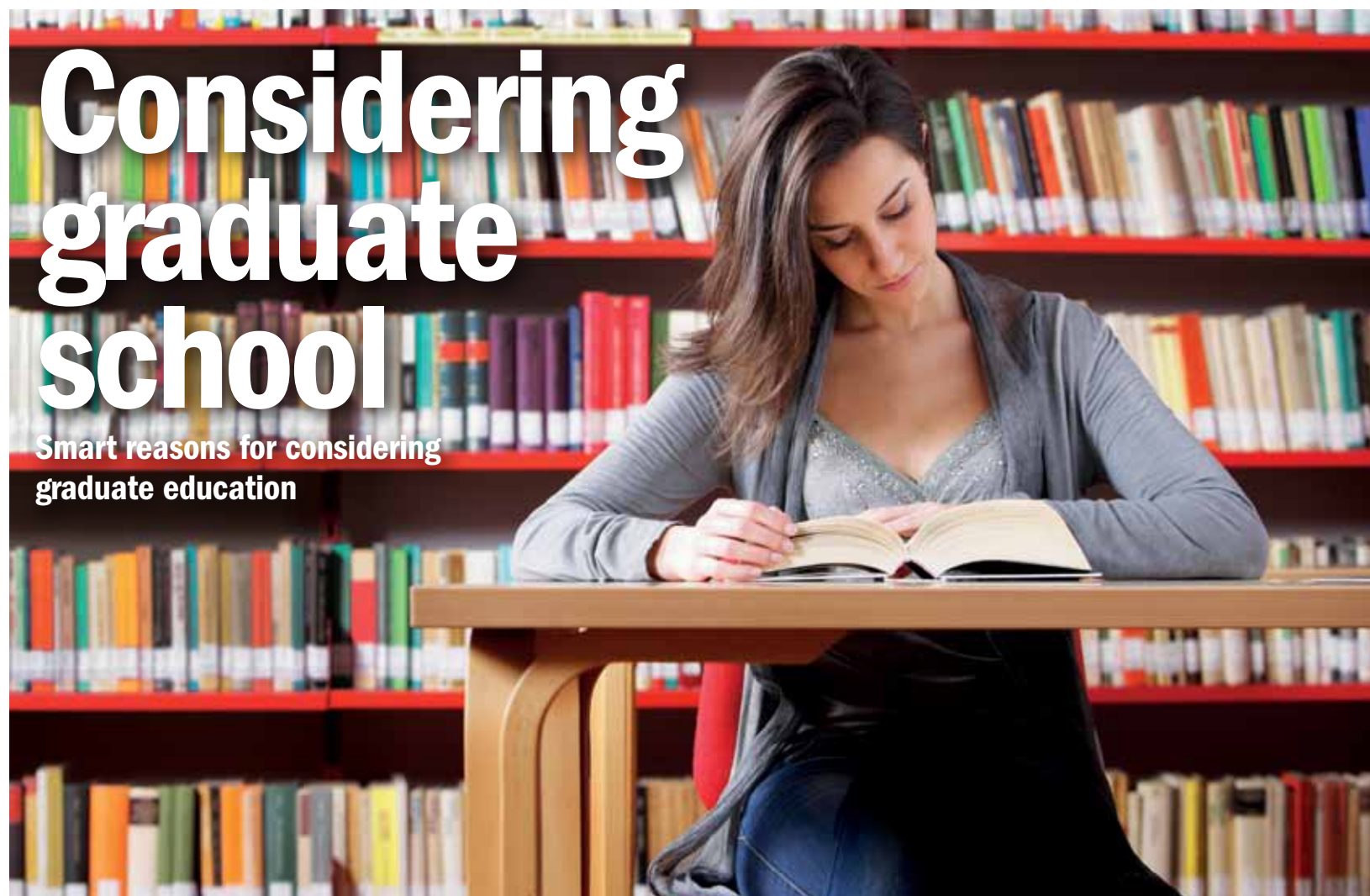
ANY ADVICE FOR ANYONE WHO WANTS TO START THEIR OWN LABEL?

I find that in design things don't happen overnight and if you keep pushing and you believe in yourself your label will get recognised, and if you have an idea and you want to do something, it's just never giving up and just believing in yourself, it's very important. 2014 FIFA World Cup

It has been a long and devastating wait for the World Cup to finally come to a start, it is every four years where fans across the entire world wait for this spectacular and unforgettable moment. The 2014 FIFA World Cup will be the 20th World Cup to ever take place. Hosted by South Africa in 2010, the World Cup will now take place in a country which is the home of "The Samba", many know it for the Picanha, Romario, and the Ambassador of the World Cup "Pele", and it is home to many lovers of football. A total of 32 national teams that managed to advance to the World Cup will participate in the tournament and ready to take on one another, whereas 64 matches are to be played in twelve cities across the country of Brazil. The venues are spread over the main regions of Brazil with the opening game taking place in São Paulo and the Finals in Rio de Janeiro.

Goal Line Technology

For the first time at a World Cup, the matches will use goal-line technology, which is a method used to determine whether the ball has completely crossed the line or not, this type of technology will assist the referee in awarding the goal or not and to support them with their decisions. The clamor for this technology reached its peak at the last 2010 FIFA World Cup in South Africa as England's Frank Lampard was disallowed a clear goal against the Germans, however the officials failed to see that the ball had crossed well over the line.

The legend that is Pelé

Read put together recent interviews of Brazilian player **Pelé** about the game, **racism** in football and his favourite **player**.



VICTORIOUS BRAZILIAN PLAYERS CHEER AROUND PELÉ DURING THE WORLD CUP 1970 IN MEXICO

I remember no one really knew about Brazil in 1958 when I went to Europe. When I arrived at the training camp in Switzerland where the World Cup was being held, the Brazilian flag had a circle instead of the diamond. From then on, I have had just one wish for the World Cup: to use it to help my people, my country," Brazilian football legend Pelé was recently quoted as saying in an interview.

As the countdown to the World Cup 2014 has begun, the Brazilian player has been named its ambassador, for he had played a major role in bringing the trophy home three times: 1958, 1962 and 1970. Famous for scoring a staggering 1281 goals in 1363 games, Pelé is hailed as a football hero worldwide. "I don't want to give the impression that I am the World Cup. The most important thing is the image of my country and its influence throughout the world," Pelé said recently.

"I like Messi. He's a top player. Football lovers would say 'he is the man of the moment.'"

With mammoth sponsorships and billions of dollars injected into the sport, for Pelé, the game is beyond the money, "The true question is not about money, but who is the best player in the world," remarked Pelé.

The dynamics of the game might have changed from yesteryears for

Pelé, but the players remain the same, and about his favourite player, the legend said, "I like Messi. He's a top player. Football lovers would say 'he is the man of the moment.' Some will say Beethoven didn't know how to play the piano, others will say Michelangelo didn't know how to paint, and Pelé didn't know how to play football. But we all received a gift from God." "When Messi has scored

1283 goals as I have and wins three World Cups, we'll talk about it again. We don't need to compare people. Football changes, records are made to be broken, but it will be difficult to beat mine. People ask me all the time 'When will the next Pelé be born?' Never! My mother and father have closed the factory," Pelé said.

With numerous racism rows on the pitch, the game has seen its share of

controversy. "Racism doesn't exist in Brazil. It is absurd to say that there is racism in football. Football is multi-coloured," he said. About reacting to racism on the field, he exclaimed, "I took my revenge by scoring two extra goals for every insult. Players apologised after the incident."

And when asked about how he wants the world to remember him, Pelé said, "You know, Pelé is the most famous name in the world. I can go anywhere; if I'm looking for a job, I will find one. More seriously, after my death, I would like people to remember that I was a good person who always wanted to unite people and draw communities together. And for them to remember me as... a good player."

Al Tayer meets Algerian minister

Extending cooperation and exchanging expertise in designing, constructing and operating mass transit means on agenda.

MEETINGS

Mattar Al Tayer, Chairman of the Board and Executive Director of the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), recently received **Ammar Ghol**, Minister of Transport in the Peoples' Democratic Republic of Algeria, in the presence of **Humaid Shobaira**, Algerian Ambassador to the UAE, and **Sultan Bin Sulayem**, Chairman of Dubai Ports World. At the start of the meeting, Al Tayer welcomed the Algerian minister and praised the historical relationships between the UAE and the Republic of Algeria. The meeting discussed means of boosting cooperation and exchanging expertise in designing, constructing and operating mass transit means.

Al Tayer gave a brief account of the RTA's model of migrating towards mass transit systems, rendering it the ideal choice for the mobility of people in Dubai with the aim of raising the percentage of mass transit users from 6 per cent in 2006 to 20 per cent by 2020, noting that last year public transport ridership clocked 13 per cent.

Al Tayer also touched on the key projects undertaken by the RTA in the course of reaching its goals highlighted by the Dubai Metro project, the provision of a modern fleet of public buses at world-class stand-

ards, and revamping the marine transit network and taxis; which lift about 1.2 million riders per day. The meeting also discussed the Dubai Tram project, which is considered the third tram worldwide fed by ground electric cables with no catenary cables involved. It is also the world's first tram that uses platform screen doors technology synchronised with the opening and shutting mechanism of tram doors. He added that the project would serve a vital area with high population density and a popular destination for visitors of the facilities in

place, particularly in Dubai Marina and Jumeirah Beach Residence. The meeting also reviewed the standards approved by the RTA in setting out the path of public transport means (rail and other transit networks), and identifying the suitable transit means for every locality. Al Tayer explained that charting out the path of rail tracks depends on the general layout of the city, and the economic and urban centres, whereas specifying the type of the suitable transit means depends on the size and number of population of the locality.

The Algerian minister commended the methodology approved by the RTA in sorting out traffic bottlenecks and achieving the switch of population to the use of public transport in Dubai. He also hailed the Dubai Metro project with its spectacular design, high-quality finishing, and superb passenger service. The Algerian minister sought to boost the partnership relationships between the two parties, sharing expertise, and benefiting from the practices and experiences of each other in the field of public transport and rail systems.

unity and passion, just what the game of football stands for.

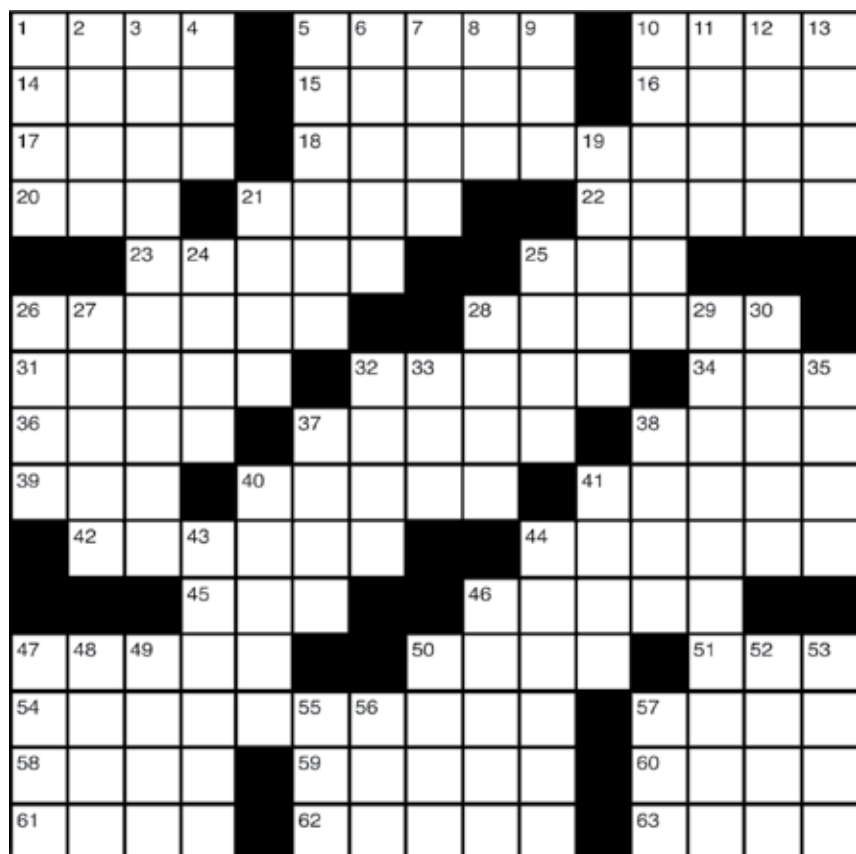

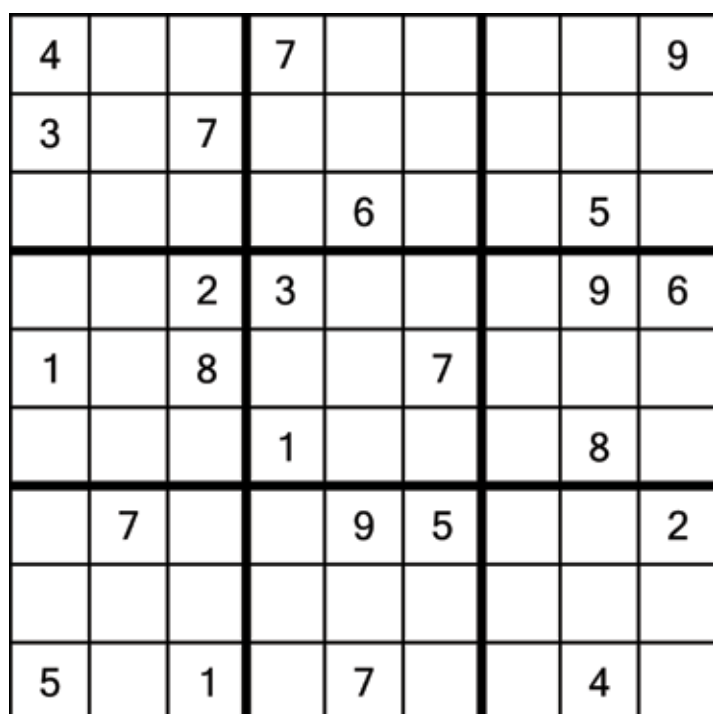

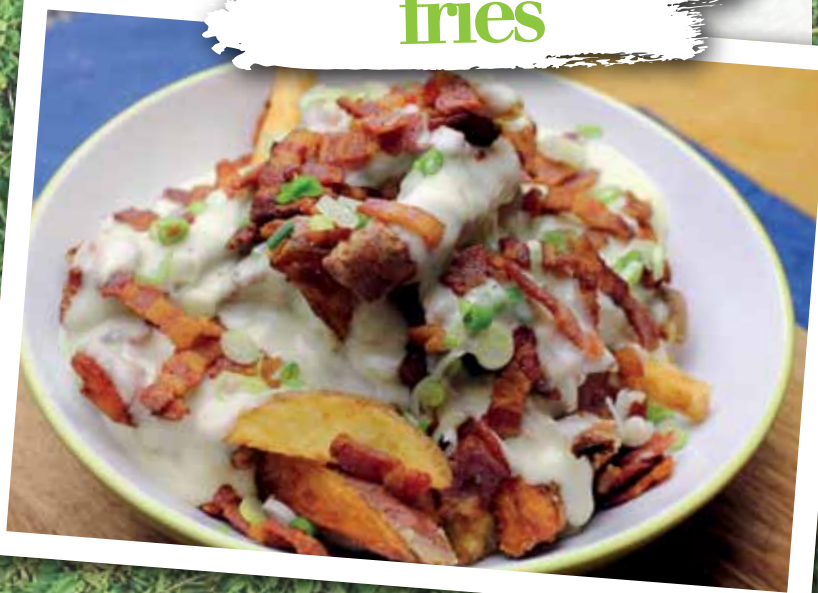

CRACK both eggs into cream

SLICE banana and scatter on top of bacon
TOP with second slice of bread and cut in half

HEAT oven to 200C
SLICE beef bacon into bits

WHISK over heat for 5 mins
THROW fries in oven for 5-10 minutes
POUR 250ml milk into saucepan
WHISK milk mix until it thickens then remove from heat
REMOVE crisp bacon from heat
GRATE cheese and chop spring onions
PLACE with cooked bacon
STIR into cheese sauce, saving a handful of bacon bits for later
THROW hot fries into bowl
DRIZZLE cheese sauce over fries
SPRINKLE with leftover bacon bits

REMOVE skin
SEPARATE rings carefully and set aside
