Cook large portions of healthy meals (especially salads) and store the extra helpings for the remainder of the week. This way you save time, resources and have a healthy meal.



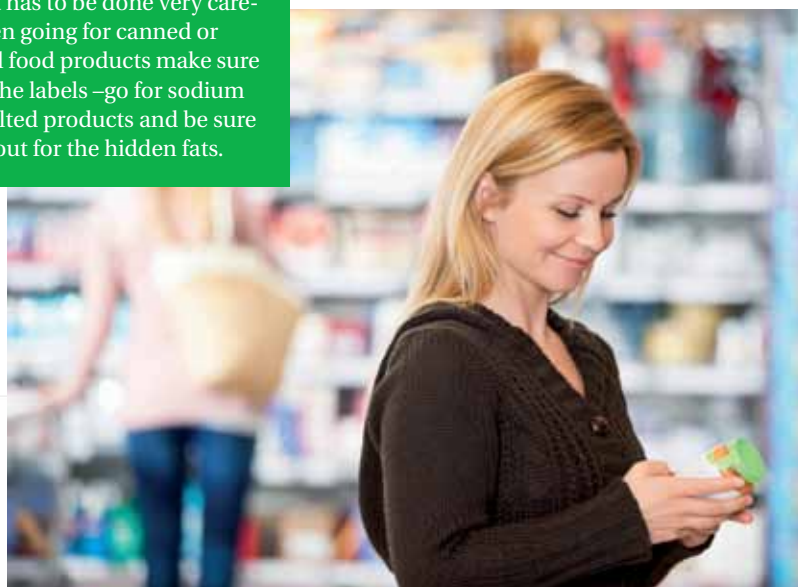
## Go for oats

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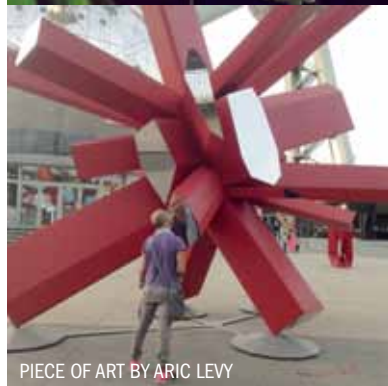

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# The unseen side of Brazil's world cup

The **FIFA World Cup** has been received with **rejoice** and **retribution** at the same time.

**W**hen Brazil was chosen to host the World Cup by FIFA in 2007, it seemed like

a brilliant idea as Brazil is famous for its love of football, and it may well be the most football fanatic country in the world. But little did anybody know that this would lead to the largest protests Brazil has seen in decades.

The Brazilian government has spent approximately \$15 billion on the 2014 FIFA World Cup,

making it the most expensive World Cup to ever take place; the government insists that all the spending is worth it, however some people of Brazil would disagree – these include skeptics who view the billions being spent on the football stadiums and the police as a waste, while Brazil's endemic poverty and social unrest are left ignored.

The rising social unrest has led to fierce anti-government protests since June of 2013, which supposedly kept increasing as the World Cup was nearing. The government has

defensively responded to



the matter by deploying hundreds of thousands of police and military in order to reduce clashes, however the conflict remains critical.

Many of the anti-World Cup protesters expressed their outrage over the World Cup by graffiti art which say 'Need food, not football'. Street artists have covered walls in Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo with pictures which blame FIFA and other authorities for ignoring the needs of the poor. They believe that the vast amounts of money spent on the World Cup should have been used to improve transportation, education, and healthcare, which is possibly a better cause for the country.

A recent study shows that 61% of Brazilian respondents think that hosting the World Cup is bad for the country because it takes money away from education facili-

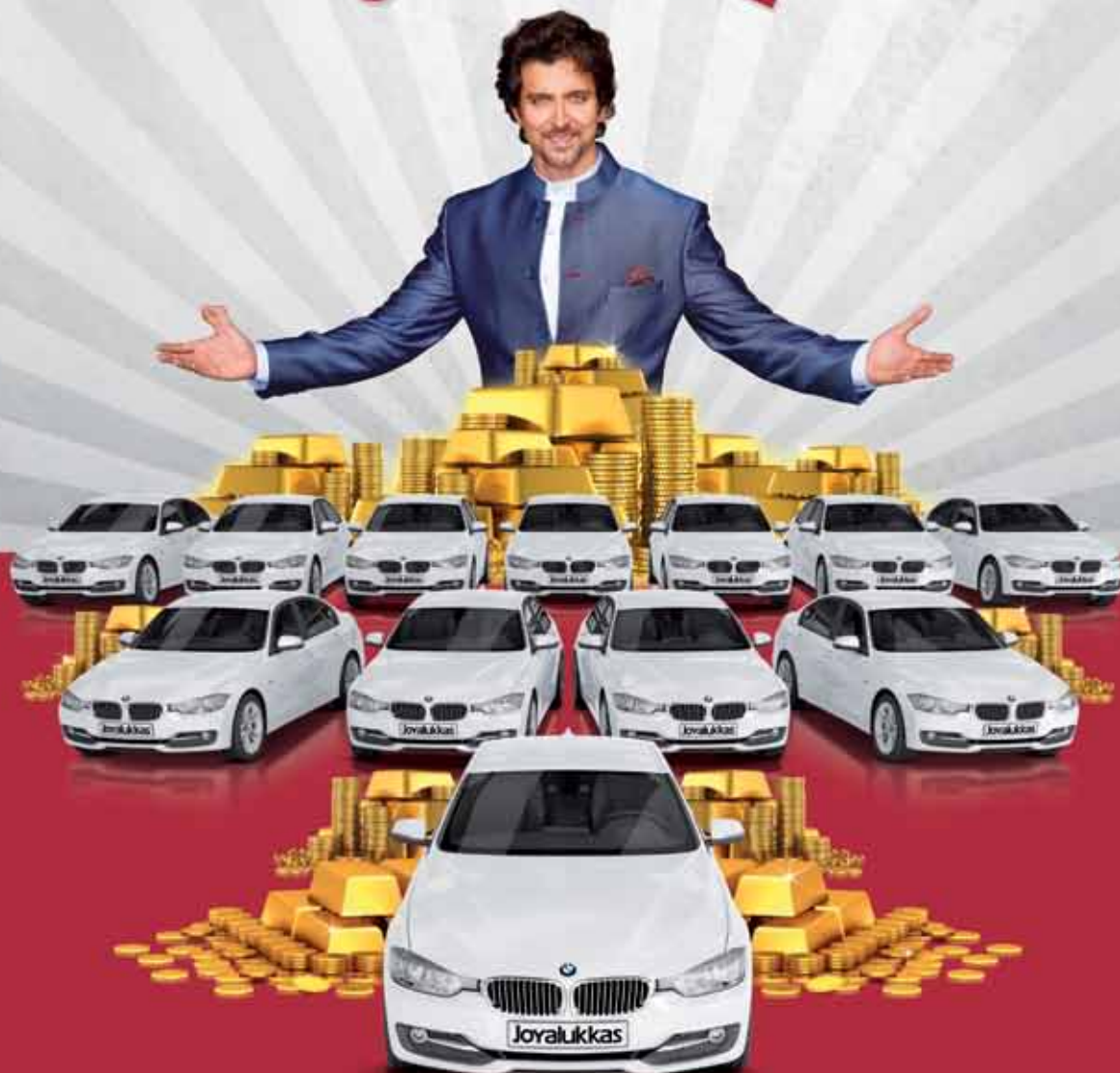
ties and public services, 39% claimed that it would reflect a bad image of the country around the world, while 35% thought it would help the country's international image and 23% said it would have no influence whatsoever.

It is said that if Brazil wins this year's World Cup, the people of Brazil will be jubilant, the curse of never winning a World Cup at home will end, but life eventually will go back to normal after that and sadly, the problems Brazil had leading up to the World Cup will still be there. In contrast, the protests could even get more heated up if Brazil is knocked out of the tournament early, as they are likely to face tough completion in the second phase.

Brazil is also hosting the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, however they are way behind on preparations, and that could lead to new frustrations, thus further strikes remain imminent.



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# SPORT SHORTS



**Basketball:** The San Antonio Spurs have clinched their fifth NBA championship after a splendid triumph over two-time defending champions Miami Heat with a score of 104-87. The Spurs impressively strived their way to this victory and claimed what they were looking for. The series was lead 4-1 by the Spurs leaving Miami Heat no chance whatsoever. Heat coach Erik Spoelstra said, "It's a big disappointment, feeling like this is an incredibly empty feeling."



**Golf:** Martin Kaymer looks forward to winning the Open Championship at Hoylake to complete a German Grand Slam after his exhilarating victory in the US Open, making him the first German player to triumph in an Open major championship. Kaymer has now clinched his second major title and seeks to win even more as the 29-year-old has stated, "To win the Masters is a huge thing and that's why I needed to adjust a few things in my swing to player better there."



**Boxing:** England's Tyson Fury has set down a future fight with Deontay Wilder if the American succeeds and claims a world title throughout the year. Fury is confident enough that he is unbeatable by anyone. Furthermore, the Englishman highly rejoices in meeting with Wilder and hopes to lure him to the home of his football team Manchester United. Fury has recently stated, "I want to fight Deontay Wilder for the world title at Old Trafford as it is the home of the team I cheer for."

## Lucky number seven



**Roger Federer** has clinched his seventh Gerry Weber Open title after achieving a great victory over Colombian Alejandro Falla with a score of 7-6 (7-2) 7-6 (7-3). The Swiss player has managed to make his way through to his ninth final in 12 years after he saw off Kei Nishikori at the German venue. Falla,

on the other hand, was searching for his first title on the ATP tour, after defeating Philipp Kohlschreiber in the semi-final. It was Federer's seventh win from seven meetings with Falla. "I've left a little bit of my heart here," Federer said after the match. "I'm very pleased now to go to Wimbledon." The seven-time Wimbledon

Champion succeeded to improve his record to 46-5 in 12 appearances at the tournament.

The 32-year-old added, "To win in a tiebreak is always a bit special; the euphoria, the emotions come out, I was able to deal with Falla's strengths in the final, and I'm very satisfied with the level I could reach."

## Michael Schumacher Awakens from Coma

**The Formula 1** legend has been in the hospital since December after a terrible ski crash which lead to severe head injuries. It was the helmet Schumacher was wearing which saved his life, which also supposedly split into two upon impact.

Fortunately, Schumacher's manager has announced that the German is no longer in a coma and has left the intensive care unit at Grenoble Hospital. He has been moved to an undisclosed location, possibly the University Hospital of Lausanne in Switzerland near his family home, where he will continue his long phase of rehabilitation which doctors have claimed that it "could take months if not years". The news of Schumacher leaving the facility was the first update on his condition since April when it was stated that he was

showing signs of awakening. News like this has brought happiness and optimism throughout the global sporting community, even in Brazil where the German's national football team won their first World Cup match.

No additional details about his current condition have been given as the German's manager has said, "For the future we ask for understanding that his future rehabilitation will take place away from the public eye."

## Dotting dad Akshay Kumar

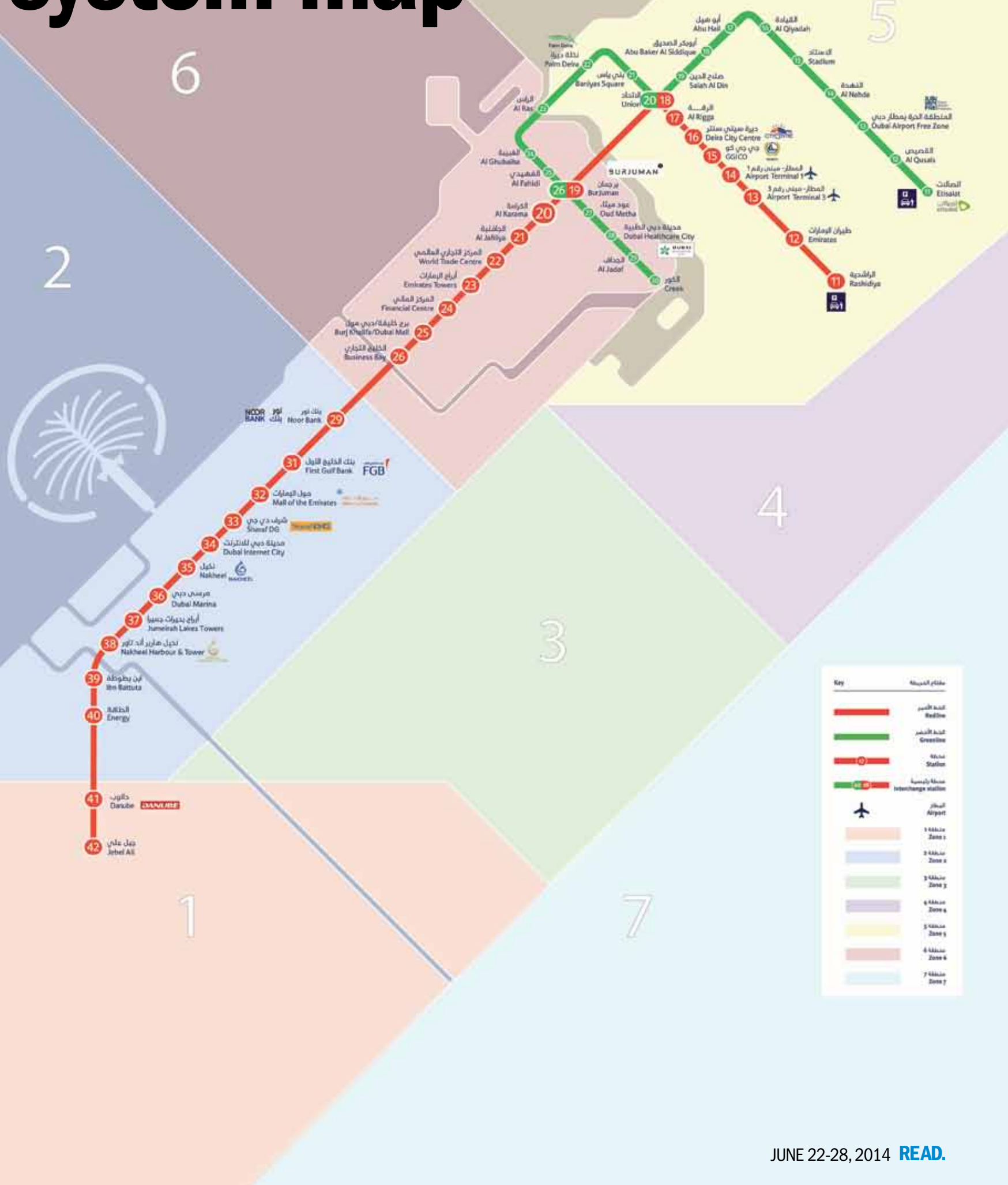

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# One visit only for vehicle licensing

RTA issues new PIN-enabled service that does away with repeat personal visits to customer service centres.

## SERVICES

**The Vehicles** Licensing Department at the Licensing Agency of the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) is set to launch a new service 'The Personal Appearance Service' which requires RTA customers to visit customer service centres once only to register their personal details in full. As part of the new initiative a short text message is sent to a customer's mobile phones conveying a personal identification number (PIN) enabling the customer to dispatch a person on his or her behalf to process various transactions related to vehicles licensing. Mohammed Abdul Karim Nimaat, Director of Vehicles Licensing, RTA Licensing Agency, said: "The new service is considered the first of its kind across the region enabling the processing of business processes and transactions in a smooth manner without obliging the concerned individual to attend in person. This process will be applied after completing registration of custom-

ers' details in full at the customer service centres, and sending an SMS to the concerned customer conveying a PIN through which the customer can delegate anyone deemed appropriate to process his or her transaction. After the transaction is complete, the used PIN will be abolished and a new PIN will be issued for another transaction in order to ensure higher degree of security. Transactions can relate to all matters of relevance to vehicles licensing such as vehicle registration, vehicle export, vehicle transfer, vehicle transport, and selling vehicle number plate among others." The launch of the new initiative conforms to the electronic drive of the RTA; which is an integral part of the vision of the supreme leadership of the UAE; which places much emphasis on switching all electronic transactions and services to a smart mode, and benefiting from the self-operated channels highlighted by the mobile phone which make it easy for customers to process their

transactions in a smooth and hassle-free manner. The new service is being offered in response to the wish of customers and their continual feedback regarding easing the burden of attending personally at service centres to process transactions, particularly women and seniors. "The one-time attendance service at service centres has other benefits, including exempting the concerned customers from going through the

previous procedure i.e. the preparation of a power of attorney from the notary public authorising another person to undertake the tasks and perform various transactions. Such an exercise used to take a long time and the Vehicles Licensing Department therefore opted to embark on the electronic drive to keep pace with the new technologies which can also boost customers' satisfaction rating," said Nimaat.

# Move on recurrent accident spots

RTA's Licensing Agency develops electronic mechanism to identify, analyse and fix recurrent accident spots.

## DEVELOPMENTS

**The Licensing** Agency, Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), has developed a new mechanism for identifying, analysing and coping with recurrent accident spots in Dubai with a view to stepping up the efficiency and effectiveness of the present mechanism of dealing with these spots via an electronic programme which is currently being configured to meet the RTA's world-class standards. The new system contributes to providing specialists with the required data, information and tools necessary for taking appropriate decisions in dealing with traffic safety issues. These tools include managing the sites witnessing recurrent accidents, analysing and saving time and cost, and avoiding ineffective and unproven solutions. Engineer Maitha Bin Udai, CEO of the RTA Licensing Agency, said: "The

RTA is continuously aspiring to take a leading position in its business domain, particularly in matters related to traffic safety in Dubai. The Traffic and Roads Agency is taking a host of precautionary and technical measures as well as preventive engineering procedures based on technical reports and numerical statistics in monitoring and tracking the sites of recurrent traffic accidents in order to take remedial actions and ensure their number will not rise in the forthcoming years. This can be done through auditing traffic safety procedures adopted in new road projects during the design and construction phases as well as after project completion. "The new mechanism classifies recurrent accident sites through identifying specific areas in accordance with the requisites of the study underway; which provides information about areas that have the high-

est frequency of causalities, and the number of traffic accidents recorded over three successive years in order to study and assess these data by specialist engineers of the agency during their site visits where they can identify the required engineering procedures capable of coping with the site based on technical standards and globally accepted scientific approaches. Such measures will be applied to the database and statistics of traffic accidents and then entered into the GIS of the RTA," she noted. A study was conducted on the practices of 15 advanced countries in the field of identifying and treating areas witnessing recurrent accidents. The study was based on certain standards including the high reputation, availability of programmes and recommendations encapsulated in a programme for treating recurrent accident spots, and the similarity with the road systems and networks in Dubai while taking into consideration the points of strength in the practices of certain countries.

"The project comprises three phases, two of which have been completed. The first one included studying the present mechanism in handling these spots, and the other included studying the best global practices in this field in preparation for the third phase which includes preparation of a comprehensive system customised for Dubai in a form of an electronic programme that contributes to identifying the best decision-making mechanism in developing up remedies for the recurrent accident spots in Dubai along with the procedures required for addressing them. "A simple comparison of the present databases and the phases of analysing and handling accidents with the databases over the past five years clearly reveals that the process and databases of the Traffic and Roads Agency are of top quality and are the best across the region as they conform to the highest international standards, which underscores the paramount importance attached by the RTA to the traffic safety issue," added Udai.

## Foie Gras

### Ingredients:

1kg fresh duck liver  
10gm salt  
Black pepper per your liking

### Procedure:

1. Clean the fresh duck liver by removing the nerves.
2. Add the salt on top of the duck liver and add some black pepper.
3. Keep in the fridge for 3 hours.
4. Roll the entire preparation in the cling film and cook it in an oven steamer for 1.5 hours at 66C.
5. Keep in the fridge for 24 hours

### Passion/coffee jelly preparation:

### Ingredients:

40gm water  
10gm sugar  
5pcs roasted coffee seeds  
1.5gm vegetable gelatin  
50gm passion fruit purée  
10gm fresh passion fruit



### Procedure:

1. Boil the passion fruit purée.
2. Infuse the coffee seeds until getting the desired flavour and then strain.
3. Mix together the sugar and the water to obtain a syrup.
4. Mix the passion fruit purée and the syrup.
5. Add the gelatin and the fresh passion fruit together.
6. Once ready, dispose in a plate (5mm high) and reserve in the fridge until it becomes solid.

### Plating:

### Ingredients:

100gm stuffed hazelnut dates  
200gm fresh almonds  
50gm cooked white beans

### Procedure

1. Slice your foie gras ballotine into 4 pieces of 1cm large and dispose on the jelly plate.
2. Garnish it with few stuffed dates, fresh almonds and white beans.

## Blue lobster

### Ingredients:

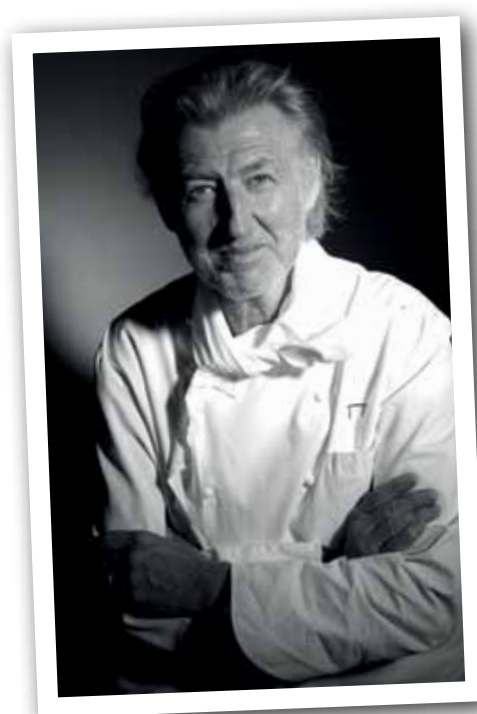
4 pcs 250gm to 300gm blue lobster from Brittany  
60gm Galia melon  
20gm turnip in brunoise  
1 pc avocado cut in dices  
16 dices aloe vera  
½ squeezed lime juice  
4 salad leaves

Espelette pepper per your liking  
Salt per your liking

### Procedure:

1. Cook the lobster in advance in a full pot of hot salty water.
2. Remove the shells and reserve in the fridge.
3. Mix all the vegetables together with the Santa Tea olive oil, lime juice, salt and Espelette pepper.

### Plating:

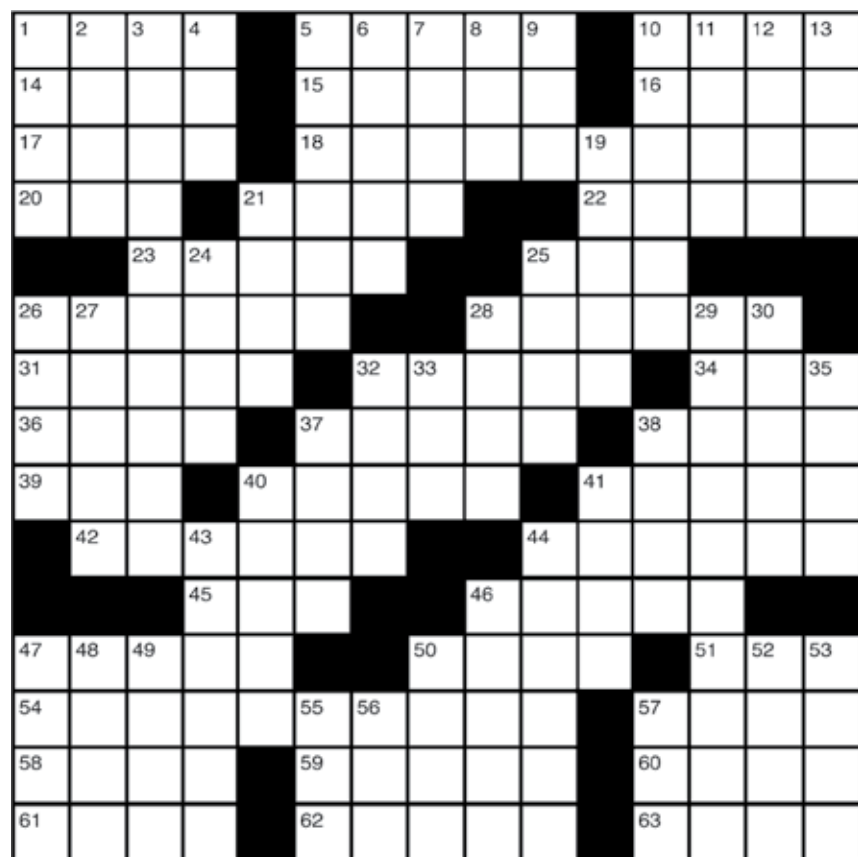
1. Put your mix of vegetables in the middle of a plate.

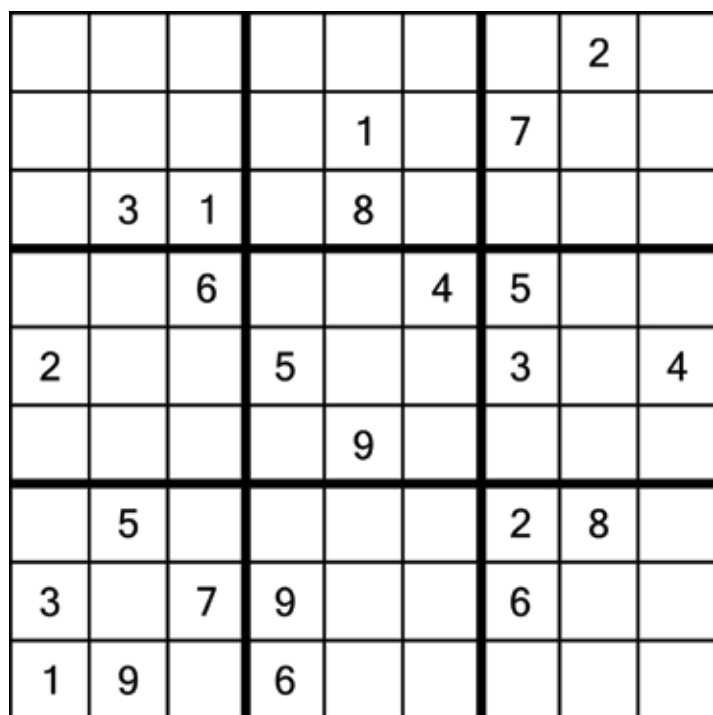
