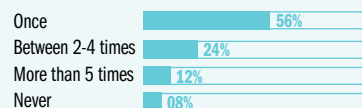

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# Food storage made simple

**P**art of treating your precious ingredients perfectly is also understanding the best places to store them, and exactly how to store them – for how long, the optimum temperature and humidity conditions. Here we will bust several storage myths and provide general tips and tricks on how to make your refrigerator more spacious and kitchen more useful and convenient.

## Methods:

### Divide

Divide between items in different places like keeping all fresh meat, fish, and poultry in its store wrapping.

### Separate

Keep fruits and vegetables separate and store like with like, and avoid storing in bags in dry environment so that you allow air to circulate.

### Choose places

You can store several shelled raw products like eggs in for three to five weeks. Avoid longer spans in order to avoid food poisoning.

### Original containers

Leave cottage cheese, yogurt, sour cream, milk, and cream in the containers they come in. But if you transfer it to a bowl or pitcher, don't put it back to the original containers again.

## Tips:



# 1

Don't wash vegetables and fruits before refrigerating them. The moisture may cause them to rot and mould very quickly



# 2

The temperature of your refrigerator should be 40 °F or below and the freezer at 0 °F or below.



# 3

Store leftovers into small, flat containers so that they cool faster.



# 4

Keep peeled garlic and onions in a cool, dry place for quick usage, but not for longer than two weeks.

# 5



To avoid fast retrogradation in bread, just keep it at room temperature for two days. After that, wrap it tightly in a Ziploc bag and store in the freezer.



# 6

Best storage place for dairy products are the upper shelves of the refrigerator because the temperature there is slightly higher, so they'll last longer.

# 7

Cover the herbs loosely with a plastic bag, and they'll stay fresh for at least a week, oil-based herbs like thyme and rosemary can be wrapped in a damp paper towel and layered into plastic bags.

# Is your body image rubbing off onto your kids?



**O**n a diet, you can't eat." That is what one 5-year-old girl had to say in a study on young children's body images. This and other research has shown that daughters are more likely to have ideas about dieting when their mothers diet. Children can easily pick up on comments and negative attitudes about dieting and health. It's harmless enough, right? as young girls in particular entering their teens, having ideas about dieting can lead to problems. Many things can spark weight concerns for girls and impact their eating habits such as;

- Having mothers concerned about their own weight
- Having mothers who are overly concerned about their daughters' weight and looks
- Natural weight gain and other body changes during puberty
- Struggles with self-esteem
- Media images showing the ideal female body as thin

Many teenage girls with an average weight think they are overweight

or are not satisfied with their bodies. For some, extreme efforts to lose weight can lead to eating disorders such as anorexia or bulimia. For others, the pressure to be thin can actually lead to binge eating disorder: overeating that is followed by extreme guilt.

Although not as common, boys are also at risk of developing unhealthy eating habits and eating disorders. Body image becomes an important issue for teenage boys as they struggle with body changes and pay more attention to media images of the "ideal" muscular male.

To help your children as growing up is a difficult time already, try paying attention more to what you say. If you are always complaining about your weight this will rub off onto your children and can lead them to thinking these are important concerns for them also. Instead, try teaching them healthy eating habits and to steer clear of fad diets and unhealthy restricted diet plans.

Parents are role models and should try to follow the healthy eating and physical activity patterns that you would like your children to follow, for your health and theirs.

At night you can take a leisurely stroll down the beach and you can even get a body massage right there; a full body massage will cost you around Php350 which is equivalent to around Dhs30. You also don't have to look too far for nightlife as the coast is packed with resto bars that can serve you and entertain you with their fire-dancers. Once you experience Puerto Galera you won't want to want to go back. It's the place for your perfect little tropical holiday.

## Fly direct to the Philippines

There's definitely no excuse for you to visit the Philippines because Emirates Airlines, Philippine Airlines, and Cebu Pacific Air have direct flights to Manila daily!

**I**f you're planning to visit the Philippines and are on a tight budget then Puerto Galera is the perfect place for you. Just a few hours away from the city, this island is well known for its Diving Spots and clear waters. If you're more of the 'Beach Bum' then you'd want to stay at 'White Beach' but if you're a 'Dive Bum' then you'd want to stay at 'Sabang'.

I'd suggest you not give into the hagglers as it will just eat up your budget. Go backpacking, it's more fun and cheaper. I'd suggest that if you're going during the peak season (Nov-May) make sure you book your accommodation early and online, as they tend to fill up very quickly. I'd suggest the 'White Beach Resort' or 'VM/WB Resort'.

Since it's an island the beaches and towns are a little far off from each other so you'd need transportation. If possible the best way to get around this is by renting out a motorbike.

Don't be afraid to barter! We rented our motorbike from Php800 until Php500, that's a real save, a Dhs40 rental for the whole day, imagine that. The roads are safe and clear and the fresh air is just amazing and a plus if you're riding a motorbike is that you can stop at designated areas

### Summer cycling helmet



**Who said** we have to give up our cycling practice when summer heat starts? It doesn't always mean waiting for the sun to fade and ride in the shade! Have you ever considered new ways to keep you cool while riding your bike?



Here comes a helmet working like magic for you: keeps you cool. How? Despite its lightweight, stylish and practical design, this helmet is invented vent-filled to keep your head cool at a low cost as well.



This helmet by "Giro" is designed in a very special way to aerate. Aero mesh panels on the sides are house of a dedicated eyewear dock for hiding your shades on your head. It has a total of 19 vents equally distributed over the surface, and it also has internal channeling funnel air.

Furthermore, the helmet is to be available starting December, and offered in more than seven colors with highlight yellow and black spots as limited edition launch colors.

## Moto 360

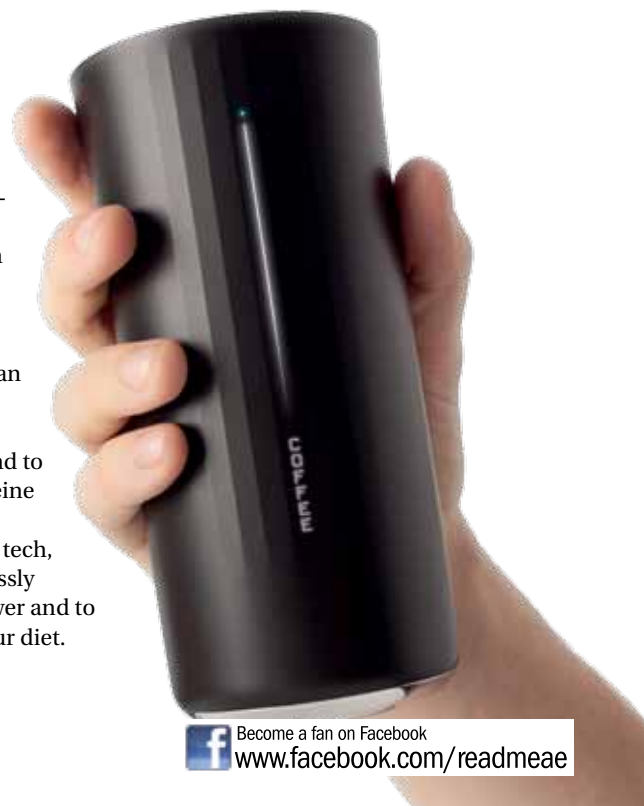
"Vessyl" is the new cup or a drinking receptacle with an electronic display that can detect what's inside and track your consumption in real time.

Another link from the **past** to the **present**, classic cars have always been a **style**.



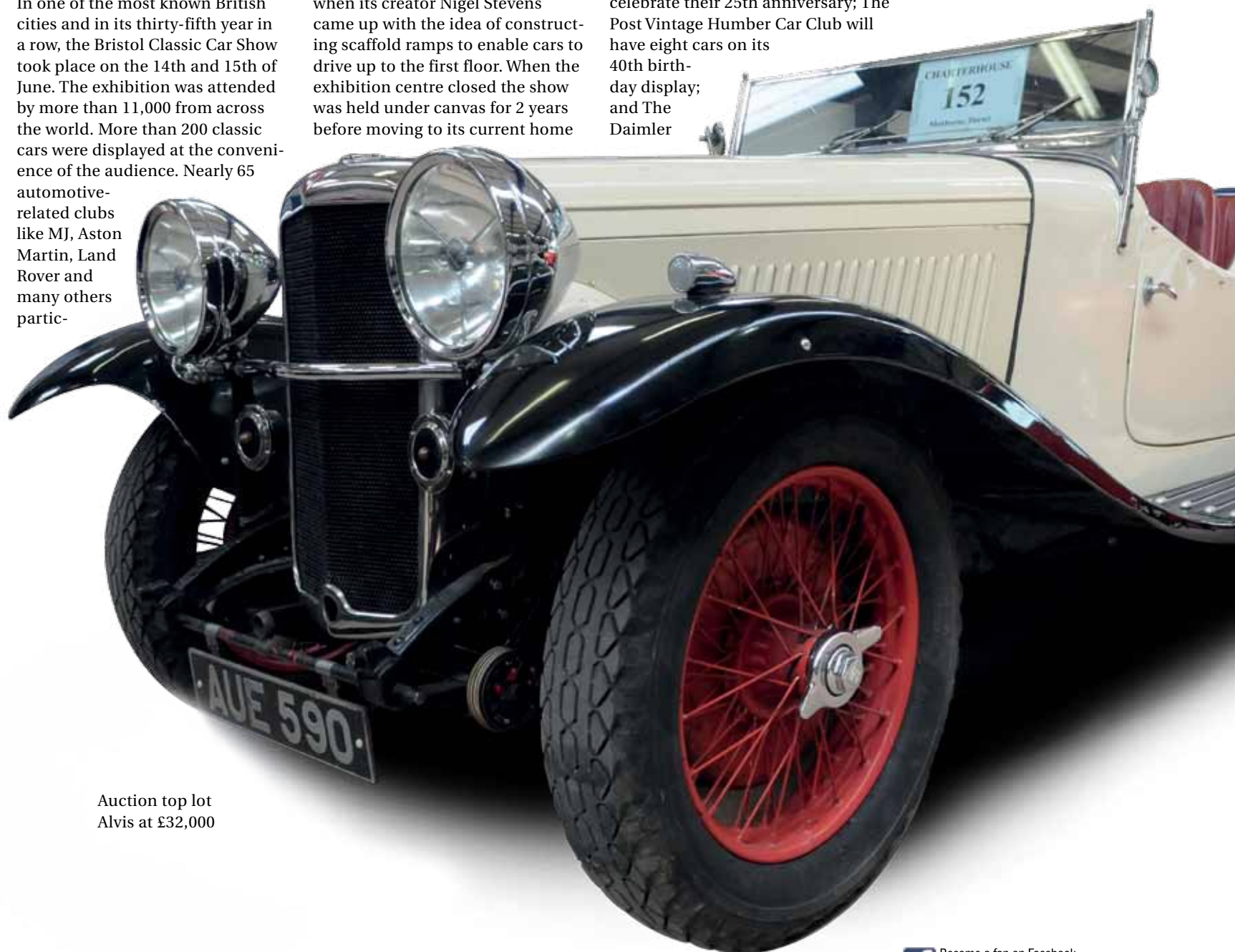

**Basketball:** Dwyane Wade could possibly end association with Miami Heat after the Miami star confirmed he is set to opt out of his contract to become a free agent. Wade took this decision just days after fellow LeBron James had opted out as well, forcing him to forgo the remaining \$41.8million left on his deal, however the 32-year-old is free to sign with any club.



**Golf:** England's Justin Rose has successfully defeated Shawn Stefani after edging him out in a play-off to win the Quicken Loans National at Congressional, making it Rose's sixth triumph on the PGA Tour. This was Rose's first victory since winning his first major title last year, the US Open. The Englishman conceded that the course had played much harder this time as he stated "I think Congressional wanted its reputation back, it tested all of us getting to four under par to win this tournament."



**Cricket:** India are to face England in a 5-test series starting from the 9th of July. The tour will involve five Test matches, five one-day internationals and one Twenty20 international. This is the first time India plays a five-Test series since 2002. A tremendous challenge lies ahead of the Indian team; however skipper Mehendra Singh Dhoni trusts his side enough to claim victory over Leicestershire.

## Remains of Wimbledon



**It appears** that not only the FIFA World Cup has caught us by surprise, but also Wimbledon 2014 has shocked us with a few outcomes in the previous matches.

The two-time champion Rafael Nadal has shockingly exited the tournament after losing to Australian teenager Nick Kyrgios who is ranked 144 in the world.

Eugenie Bouchard is confident enough claiming that she can win the grand slam title at 20 years old,

while England's Andy Murray was very much trying his best to claim the title.
