 That when we live no more, we may live ever.

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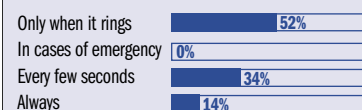

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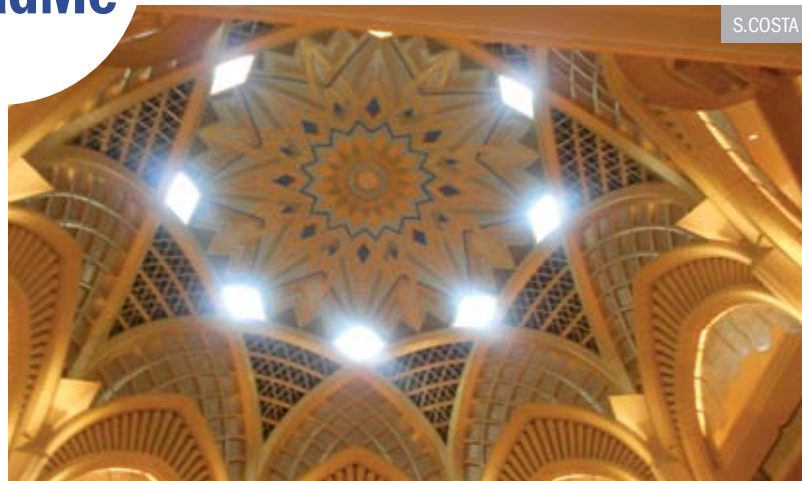

Family vacation rules

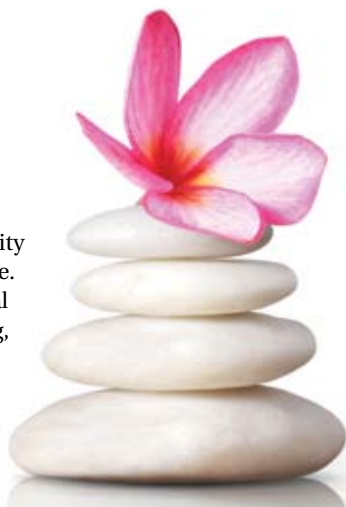


Sleep like a baby

Toyota's smart city



Japanese inventors are always to make a first. As for the Japanese car brands, they're always achieving great results through their innovations. Thinking about the future of automotive, Toyota has the answer and is offering it in France.

The Japanese car maker Toyota in cooperation with Ha:mo an innovative 100% electric car sharing company, and the French public transport regulatory body to implement the latest cutting edge tech in automotive: i-ROAD.



70 i-ROAD and COMS ultra-compact electric vehicles, and around 30 charging stations developed and managed by EDF's subsidiary Sodetrel, will be open for service for a period of three years thanks to a unique partnership between the City and the Metropolitan Area of Grenoble, French energy company EDF, Japanese car maker Toyota and Citélib, a local car-sharing operator.

This project aims to promote interconnectivity of public transport methods (trams, buses, trains) and a new type of personal mobility using small vehicles that don't take up as much space as a normal car. The main idea is to allow commuters to drive the first or last kilometers of their journey for increased flexibility and time-saving, thus contributing to reducing traffic congestion and improving air quality in city centers.

The car is a unique combination of sporty performance and the nobility of the manufacturer. It is the seventh generation of this model, which comes equipped with distinct technological characteristics, standard and sophisticated command system and dynamic performance enhancer. This is an easily distinguished model from among other cars.

The power of the small size

The sporty looks of the GTI require a powerful engine to fit the driver's needs. Four-cylinder TSI 2.0 liter turbocharged engine, direct injection, delivers 220 Hp between 4,500 and 6,200 rpm, and 350 Nm of torque between 1,500 and 4,400 cycles per minute. Six-speed transmission with front-wheel drive. Accelerates from 0 to 100 km/h in 6.5 seconds and reaches a top speed of 244 km/h. As for fuel consumption the vehicle approximately need 6.0 liters/100 km. The power of this car does not appear in the form at first glance, but you will think otherwise as soon as you ignite the engine.



Luster youth

The contemporary design with comfortable sporty seats has been designed to be compatible with the geometric shape of the human body. The simple cabin is equipped with everything a driver could need. The display is of moderation and luxury with leather-covered steering wheel and interior lights hidden. Despite the small size of the car, the cabin is spacious and fits all passengers comfortably. As for the dashboard it is very practical and also makes it easier for the driver to find what he needs. Add to all this, the screen with several functions, such as music and entertainment, maps, GPS systems, as well as cell phone networks.

Sportsmanship

The characteristics of the car and its lines will appeal to everyone. The front side is equipped with a grill giving it a sporty look. The GTI sign appears at the front and the back, and the sign Volkswagen appears at the rear of the vehicle and acts as a rear vision camera when needed. The side lines overlap and are consistent with wheel lines. The wheels and undercarriage solid lines brings characterize stability which increases the sportiness. This model has not given up on the basics of the old design, but is an enhanced and improved version.

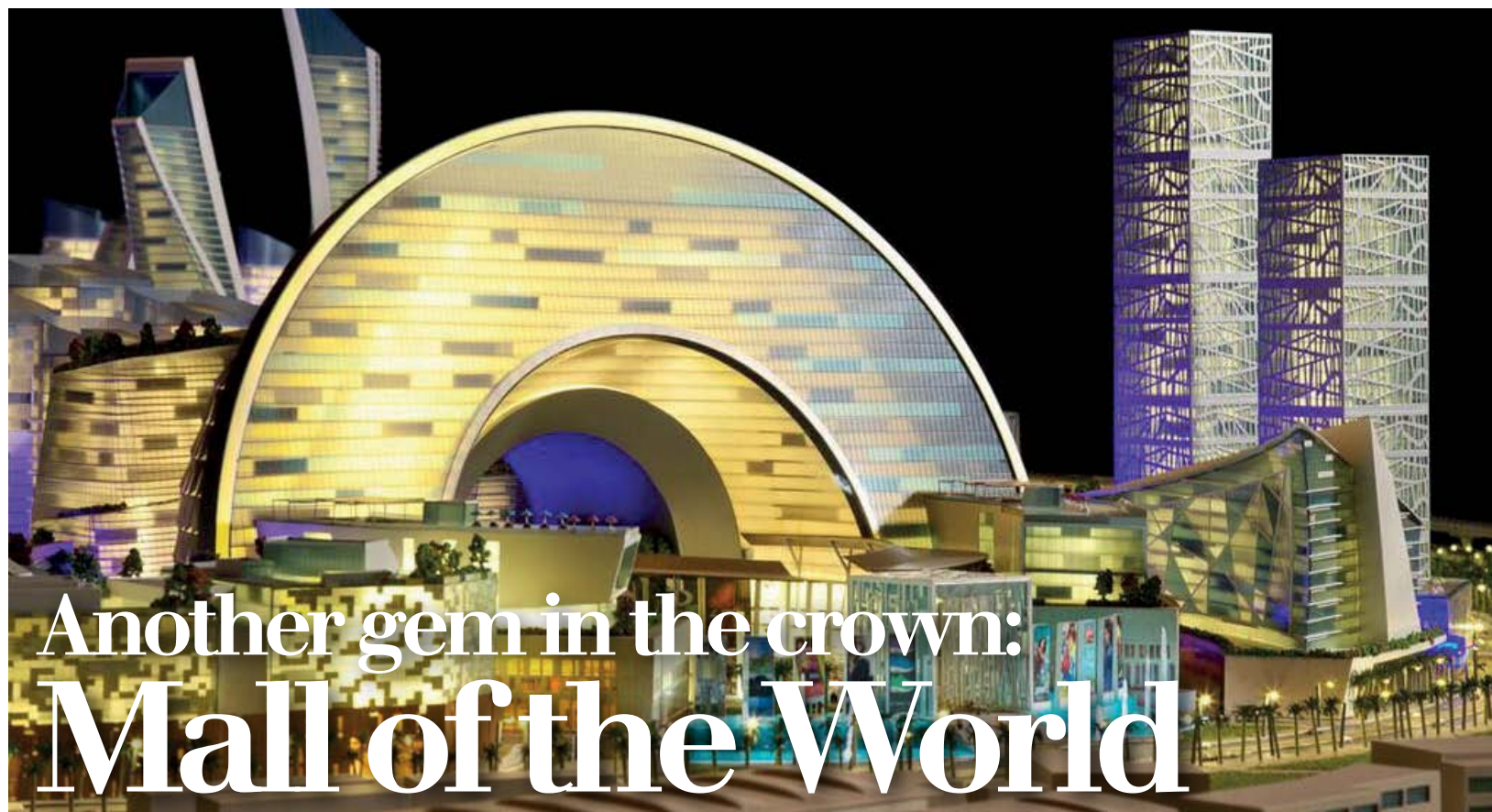

Front doors are Lamborghini look-alike, while the back doors are hanging from the ceiling. Hood and doors open to the sides. The car features orange headlights and black tail lights, with a fox exhaust system, and tires measuring 17 inches, and can enjoy hydraulic and neon lights.

Moving to the interior, the orange seats made of crocodile and ostrich skin, which covers the doors and dashboard as well. The sound system has 12 speakers, and 3 television screens, CD player, and modified lights here and there.

Another gem in the crown: Mall of the World

The recently launched **Mall of the World** plan boasts the **world's largest mall**, promising an unprecedented recreational **experience**.

Dubai has always had a penchant for breaking world records. Already boasting the world's tallest building, and the world's largest mall based on area, it is now set to build the world's biggest mall. The ambitious project was launched recently by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice-President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai. "This project complements our plans to transform Dubai into a cultural, tourist and economic hub for the 2 billion people living in the region around us; and we are determined to achieve our vision," he said in a statement.

The mall will help shape the future of the already sound leisure and hospitality industry in Dubai, especially in the run towards Expo 2020. The Mall of the World will occupy a staggering 8 million square feet on Sheikh Zayed Road, and will be the world's first temperature controlled pedestrian city. Aiming to be a year round recreational destination for a global audience, the mall will feature a glass dome that will be open during the winter months.

"Our ambitions are higher than



having seasonal tourism – tourism is key driver of our economy and we aim to make the UAE an attractive destination all-year long," Sheikh Mohammad said in the statement. "This is why we will start working on providing pleasant temperature-controlled environments during the summer months."

In addition to this, the mall will also feature the world's largest indoor theme park, and offer a retail street network stretching 7 kilometres. The complex will also feature 100 hotels and apartment buildings featuring 20,000 rooms. The

complex is expected to host 180 million visitors annually.

The mall will also feature a wellness district, offering medical tourism and wellbeing opportunities to visitors. Trams will also operate within the 7km temperature regulated area, offering transport convenience and practicality. The cultural district will house centres similar to New York's Broadway and London's West End. The Mall of the World promises a retail and leisure experience that has never been seen before.

The next race awaits at Hockenheim, Germany, where any mistake from Hamilton or Rosberg could be fateful. Hamilton had admitted that he could not afford to go through anymore errors if he wishes to claim the title. The 29-year-old is now also being seen as the Championship favourite after the British GP victory, leaving him only four points behind Mercedes teammate Nico Rosberg.



2014 FIFA World Cup FINALS

The 2014 FIFA World Cup has been bombarding us with surprises from the start, with strange results, critical injuries, and a large amount of goals; where 167 goals were scored after the end of the semi finals, leaving it possible to break the France 1998 World Cup record with 171 goals. 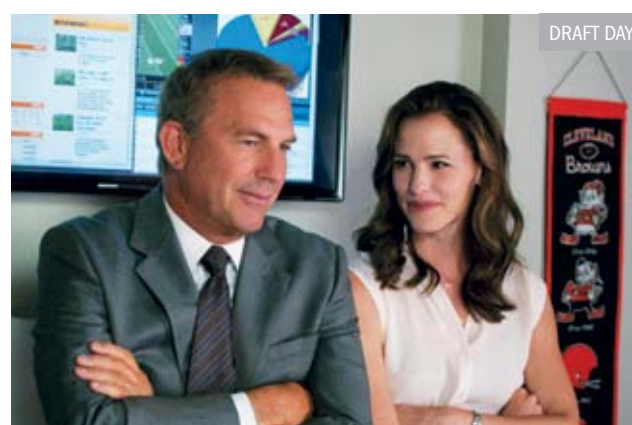

FAILING TO KEEP IN TOUCH

Few people take the time to follow-up after they have made initial contact with a prospect. This is not a smart thing to do as meeting someone is just the first step in networking. In order to create a lasting relationship and make sure people don't forget you, you need to follow up, every single time. Look for ways to keep the connection alive. Share useful articles with them, meet for lunch, and acknowledge

accomplishments. Don't connect only when you need a favour.

YOU'RE NOT SELECTIVE

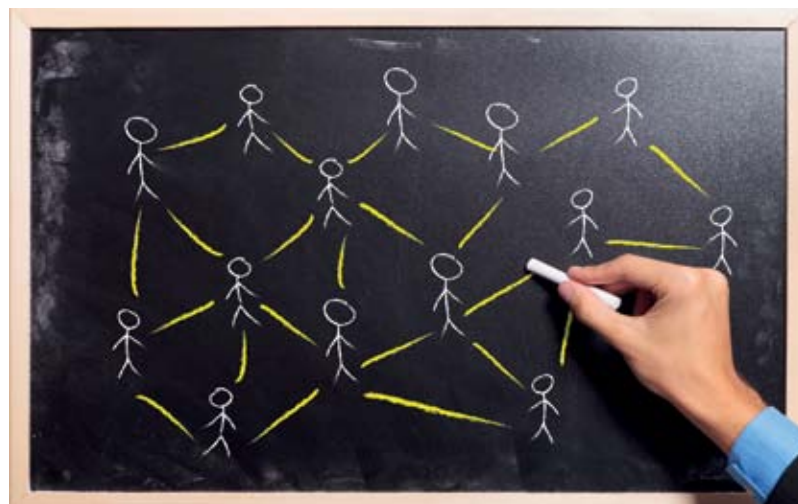
to invest some time in the process.

IGNORING YOUR NICHE

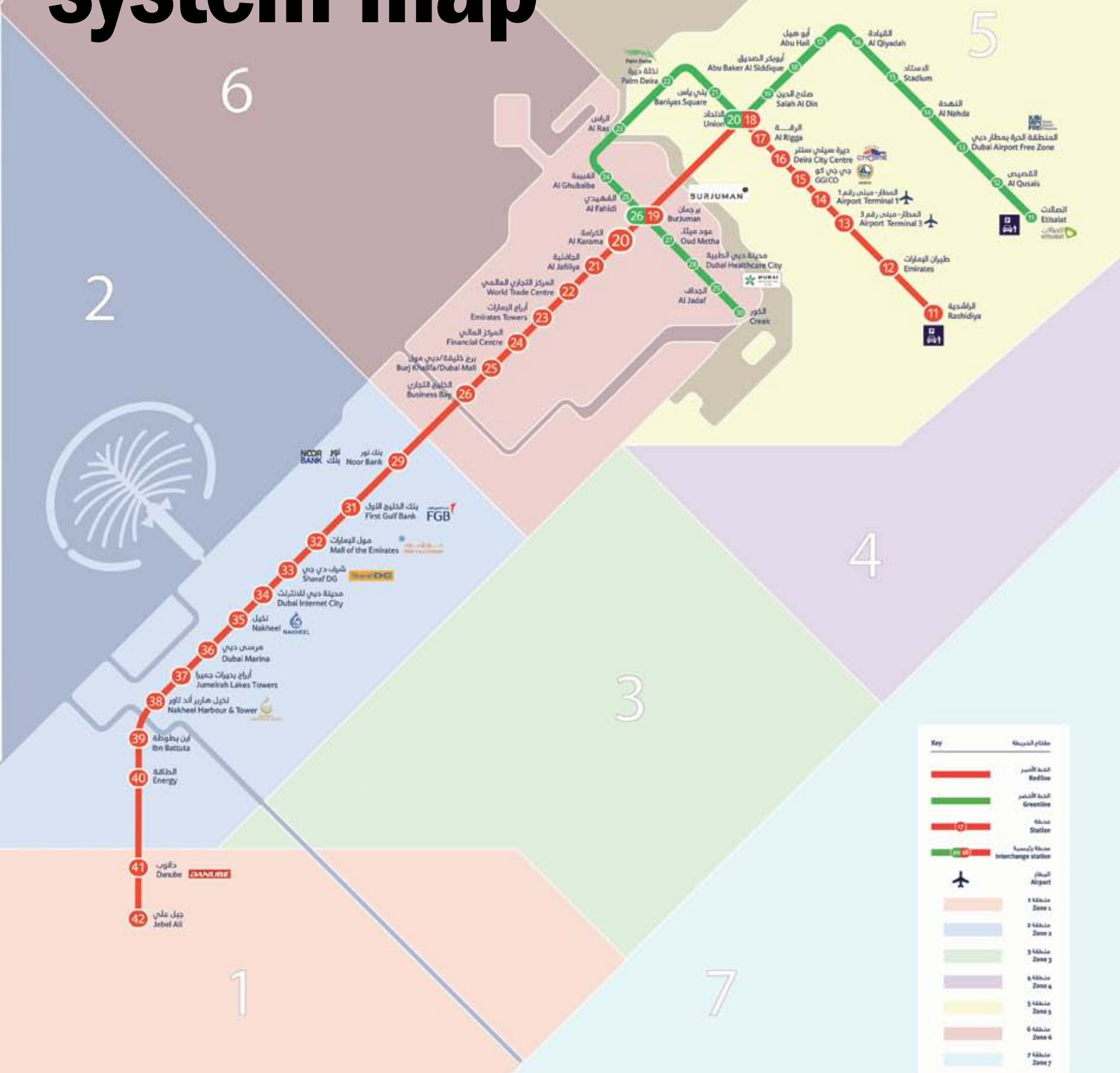
