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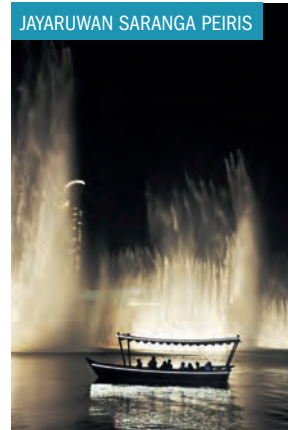

Be more ENERGY efficient

You do not have to **spend a lot of money** while building a house that is **eco-friendly** to **reduce** your **carbon footprint**. It is really the **small** everyday things we do that make a whole lot of **difference** – and when you **calculate**, save you a lot of money you give away in **bills**. With these simple steps, make your **life easier and greener**, and **save** a few bucks while doing it.



Save

Saving water and both electricity are the best ways your energy consumption and bills are kept in check. This is also the simplest way to make a green transition. As a rule, do not keep water running when brushing, washing or bathing. You can save gallons of water this way. Use the water-saving option when flushing if you can make do with less water. Set the water usage on your washing machine, and use it only when you have a full load. This saves water and electricity both.



Unplug

Do you know how much power do appliances on standby consume? Studies show that 10% of your household electricity bill is accredited to them. You might not have them on, but with the switch still on, the “idle” electricity is being consumed. 99% of the total energy consumed by microwaves is during idle mode, because they spend most of the time idle. By simply unplugging and switching off, you can save energy consumption.



Replace

So you don't like the harsh fluorescent lights and prefer warm bulbs – that is costing you a heavy price. Most of the energy they consume – literally in electricity metres – is dissipated as heat, which warms your house as well. Replacing them with energy savers can save from 25% to 80% of the total energy consumed. You can opt for the warm yellow ones if you don't like the white ones. Also, they last a long time and do not pop like the bulbs.



Adjust

Simple adjusting can go a long way. Adjust the thermostat of your air-conditioner to a medium temperature, and not make your home a freezer unit. This will also cause your air-conditioning unit to last a longer time without servicing. Also adjust the temperature on your water heater to medium heat, and switch it on only when required. Refrigerators again can be set on medium temperature so that they trip often. And most importantly, switch air-conditioning and eheating off when you're not home.

Papaya

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How to cope with depression from disease

Illness often comes with deeply felt stress; fibromyalgia sufferers?



A lot of people feel severe body pains, sleep disturbances, joint stiffness, fatigue and a number of other stress related problems, but can never pinpoint them to get a proper diagnosis for them. They are often refuted as being more psychological and imaginary than being diagnosed. Only the sufferers will understand what this is about: you are not alone. Fibromyalgia syndrome is a complex, chronic condition of widespread muscular pain and fatigue. It often includes sleep disturbances, impaired memory and concentration, depression and other debilitating symptoms. The syndrome is one of the most common chronic pain disorders, affecting nearly one in every 60 Americans. Fibromyalgia sufferers might try every cure from traditional Western medicine to alcohol consumption and various holistic treatments, but it doesn't. It can be any stress, trauma, unknown problems or any stressor that causes it. you might not even know what's causing it. After having coped with the syndrome, now a retired schoolteacher from Florida shares tips of curing it. Janet Komanchuk overcame the illness, without any prescription medication on her own and she has the following tips:

Trust in yourself.

"At times, the pain was so intense that I was certain my flesh was tearing away from my bones," says Komanchuk, who was just like the more than 100 million Americans who suffer from chronic pain, which costs nearly \$600 billion annually in medical treatments and lost productivity, according to the Institute of Medicine. Despite her unmistakable pain, the critical doubt from others as to what she was experiencing was disheartening, at times causing her to doubt herself. "Trust in yourself, for you know what you're feeling," she says. "Don't fall victim to the judgment and criticism of others who doubt your illness and the limitations it places on you or your activities."

Don't quit!

Despite the immense scope of chronic pain, very little is spent on research to find better ways to manage pain. Komanchuk was faced with the prospect of spending the rest of her life in a nursing home. "Yes, the pain was excruciating, debilitating and fatiguing, yet I still felt as though my life had the potential for vitality," she says. "The idea of going to a nursing home – reasonable for some – felt like a kind of death to me." Convinced that there was hope for her in overcoming fibromyalgia, she persisted in her search for wellness answers.



Seriously consider alternatives.

She was able to achieve what she thought was impossible – not just temporary relief, but permanent, lasting mind-body-spirit wellness. She had been to orthopedic surgeons, neurologists, rheumatologists, psychologists, underwent MRIs and took all manner of medications for her unbearable pain. In a narrow sense, it would seem as though she exhausted her options – until she looked beyond traditional Western medicine. Alternative treatment guided her to recognise the layers of stress throughout her life that she believes were a primary driver of her chronic pain. "Every day, I am filled with gratitude for the fact that I am free of the torment from fibromyalgia that had plagued me throughout my life," she says. "I just wish I could give others a piece of the relief that I've found. All I can say is keep your eyes open, keep the hope alive and don't give up!"

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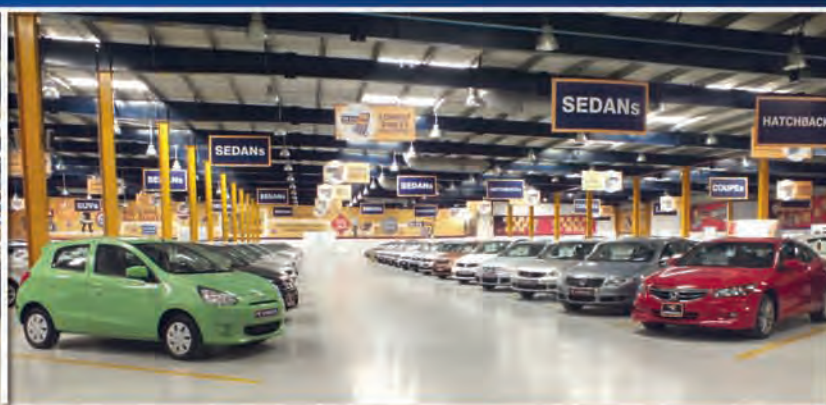
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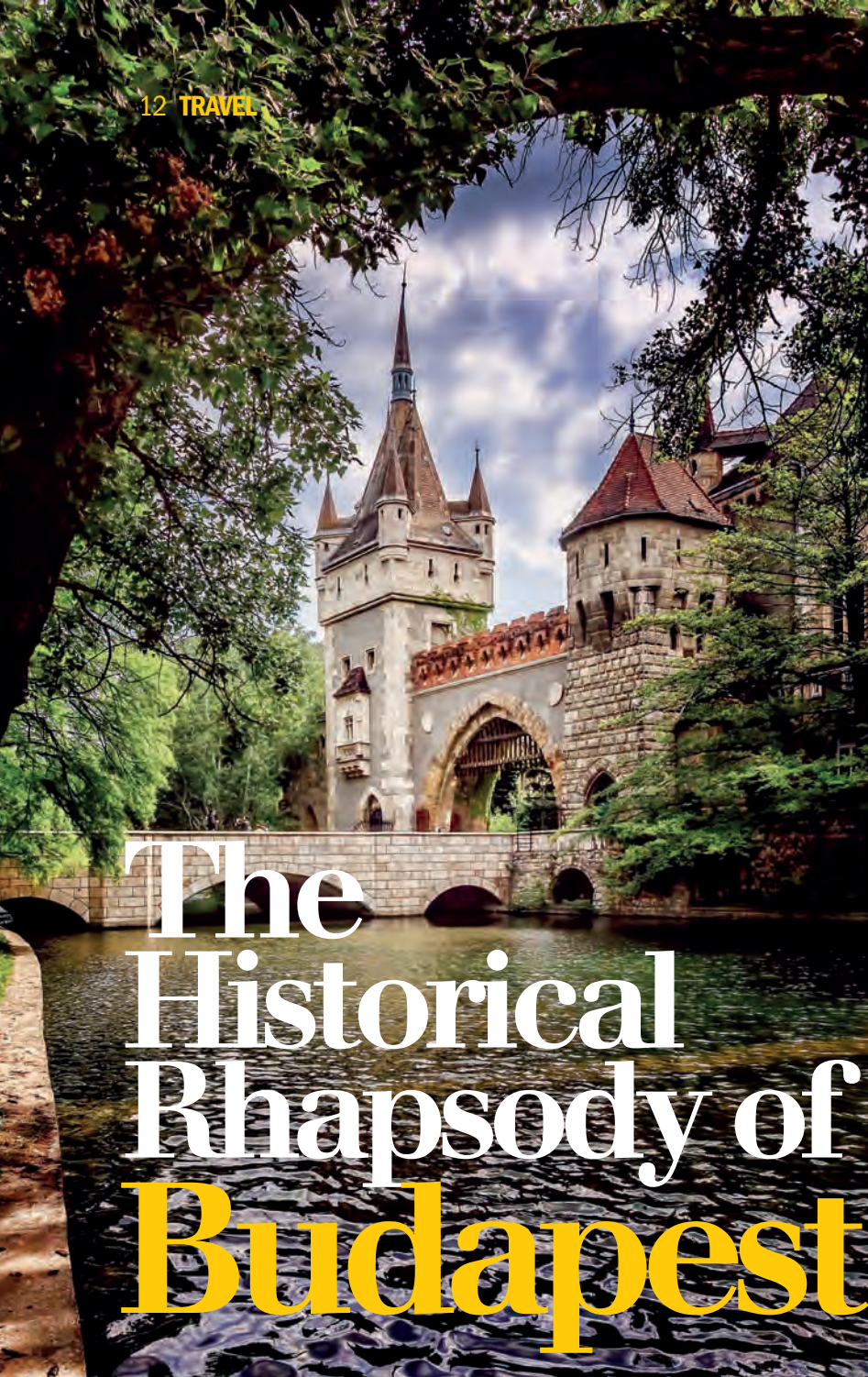
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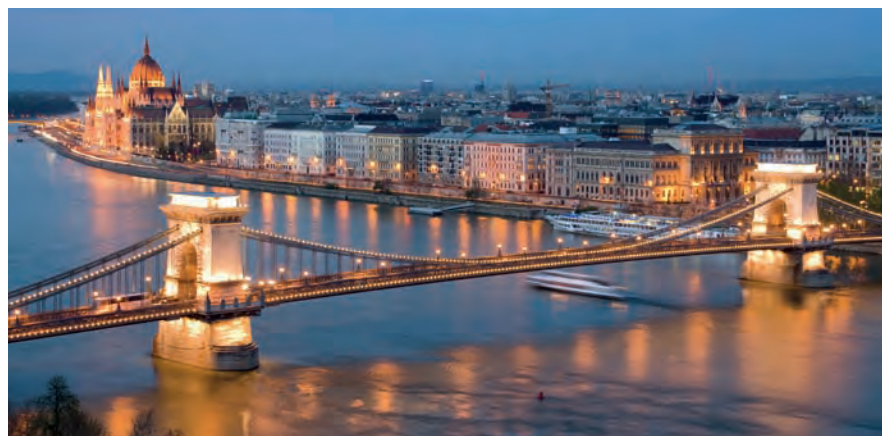


The Historical Rhapsody of Budapest

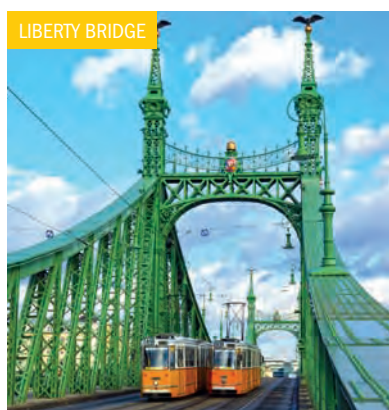

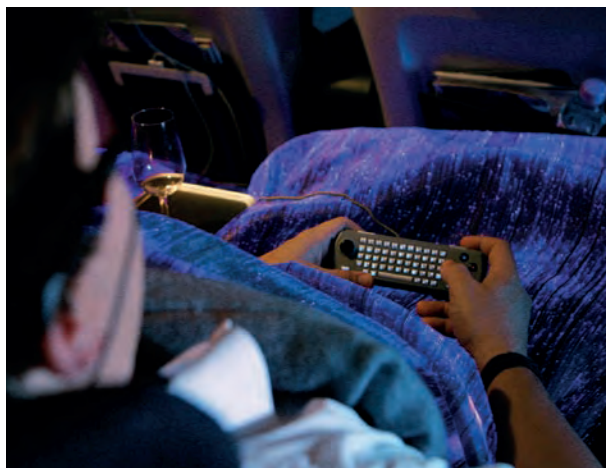
Mobile payment reader

In conversation with Akshay Kumar

Bollywood superstar Akshay Kumar talks exclusively to Read. About his newly released movie *Entertainment*, and what it was like to work opposite a four-legged co-star.

Your previous movies are much more serious than *Entertainment*. Do you think your fans will enjoy it?

To be honest, I'll do whatever my fans want me to! Even though they praised me a lot for *Holiday*, they said they can't wait for *Entertainment* to release. I think the key to happy fans is giving them a little bit of everything, which I am trying to do at the moment. If my fans are satisfied with me – that is all I need because I would not be where I am today without them.

Some people might say that actors are supposed to be trendsetters. Do you agree?

Not at all. In my opinion the real trendsetters are the viewers. We (actors) might think that something could work but if the audience says no – that is the end of it. All we can do then is just try and adapt.

Did you ever see yourself acting with a dog?

Not really but that's the beauty of acting! You can never predict who your new co-stars will be, two-legged or four. It's fantastic to be given the opportunity to transition from character to character and to be able to mix it up. He's definitely one of my favourite co-stars.

***Entertainment* is not the first movie where you're working with a debutant director. Do you enjoy it?**

Absolutely! Because they are still new at their job they love to experiment and improvise – and I love that too! Especially if you're working on a comedy you need to have someone who is open to suggestions, witty and not afraid to take risks.

Is it true that you lip-synced to a female voice for one of the *Entertainment* songs?

Yes, it is true – I just could not resist it. From my point of view, if you are making an out-and-out comedy why stop at anything? You can only succeed if you take risks.

You have also launched quite a few newcomers. Why is this?

I believe in giving people opportunities. I think everyone deserves a chance to be noticed and appreciated. Also it is my way of giving back to the industry.

It took a little while before the



industry and the audiences started taking you seriously as a star. How would you describe your journey?

My journey has been both difficult and fantastic at the same time, but I guess that's part of life. It may have taken time for people to accept that I was more than just a struggling actor. I was also very determined to succeed and you can never achieve success without working towards it and adopting a diligent, positive and honest approach to this. I was Akshay Kumar, born with nothing but good parents and God's hand on my shoulder!

Did you enjoy working with Tamannaah?

Tamannaah is a great actress. She's a talented, full of energy and a

thorough professional. She's got a great attitude, and extremely charming, so glad she has decided to join Bollywood!!!

Tell us a bit more about *Entertainment*?

I play a character that will be seen competing with a dog to inherit his father's fortune. On knowing that his father has left his property to his faithful pet, *Entertainment*, my character obviously tries to get rid of the dog, but a sudden turn of events changes the course of the story.

Did you have to prepare for your first meeting with Junior?

I had to rehearse a lot before I was even introduced to Junior. I must say I have never improvised as much as I did in this film! Junior was

absolutely unpredictable – one could never know what he is about to do, you just had to follow his emotions. Everything I knew about acting had to be thrown out of the window; we just had to do whatever made Junior happy and comfortable.

Did you enjoy working with Junior?

It was an absolute pleasure! I have never done anything like this in my life. I really hope that this movie will not only change Junior's life but all other dogs' lives too. If this film can make a positive change, then I will be over the moon.

What's your favourite scene from the movie?

I don't have a favourite scene. When you are shooting with a dog all the scenes are funny in their own way.

Tell us your story...

This open-ended question immediately puts the candidate in the corner because there is no one right answer to it. But there is an answer. This question is an invitation to open up and see where it goes without worrying about saying the right things. If the candidate plays along and shows his human side, it can reveal a lot about his character, creativity, and likability. Since personal characteristics are usually not part of the job description, the deciding factor may actually be "likability". You want your candidates to open up about what they didn't like about their previous job. It might be hard to get an honest answer to the question at first, but you need to be persistent and try to ask the question in different ways. The answer will be worth the effort.

Who is your role model, and why?

The question can reveal a lot about the candidate's career ambitions and job preferences. It also shows what values and behaviours the candidate aspires to. For many people, their role model is a personal acquaintance such as a parent or a close friend. It can also be a previous manager or coworker who displayed the qualities they would like to emulate. A role model could also be a high profile figure in the industry who is well-known for their integrity, discipline and business savvy.

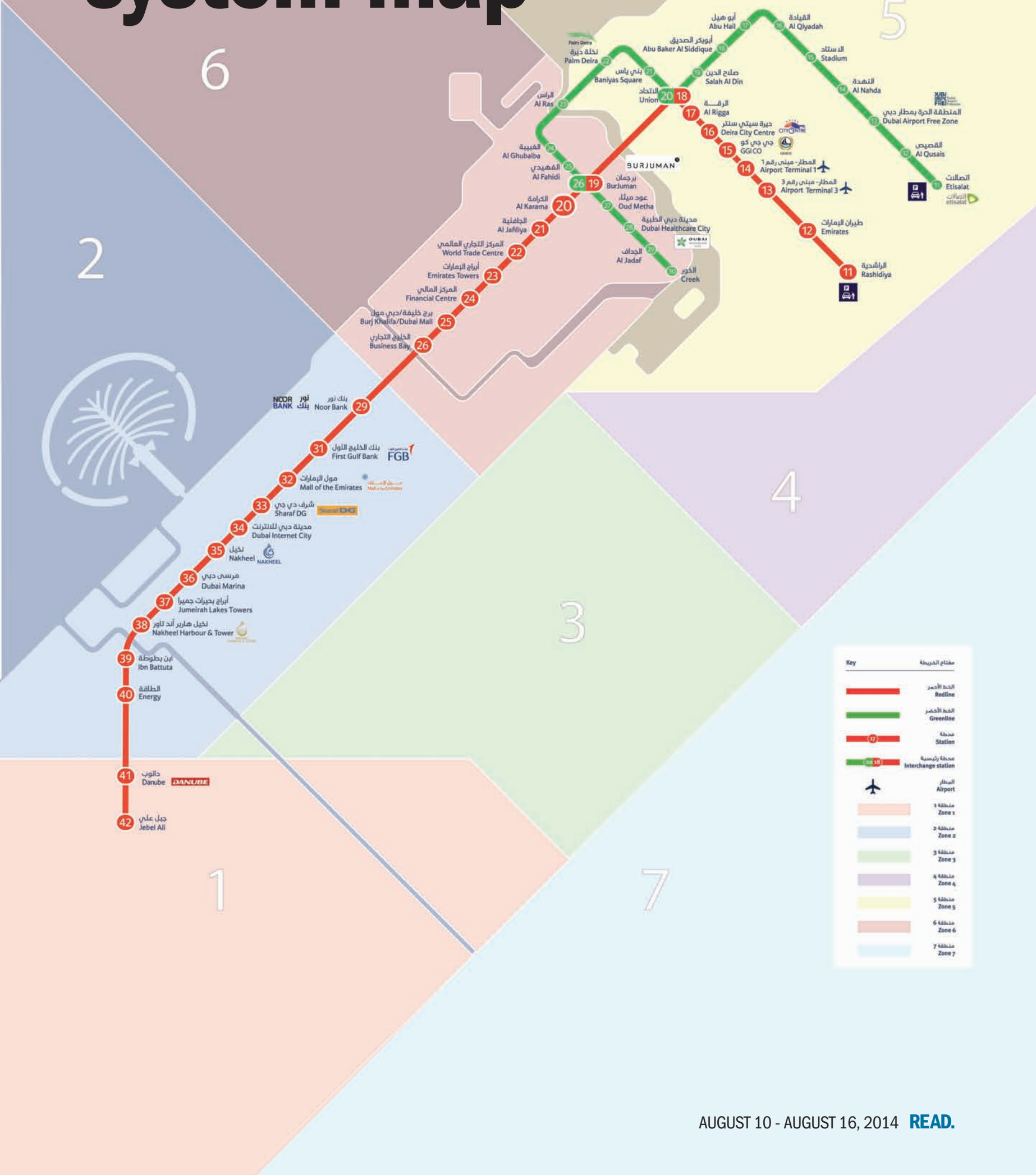
Do you have any questions?

1. Heat oven to 400 degrees F.
2. Fit piecrust into a 9 inch pie dish. Place fruit in pie crust and spread evenly.
3. Combine half and half, egg, sugar, flour, cinnamon and salt in a small bowl and mix until well blended. Pour over fruit.
4. Bake for approximately 50 minutes or until centre is set. Cool completely before serving.



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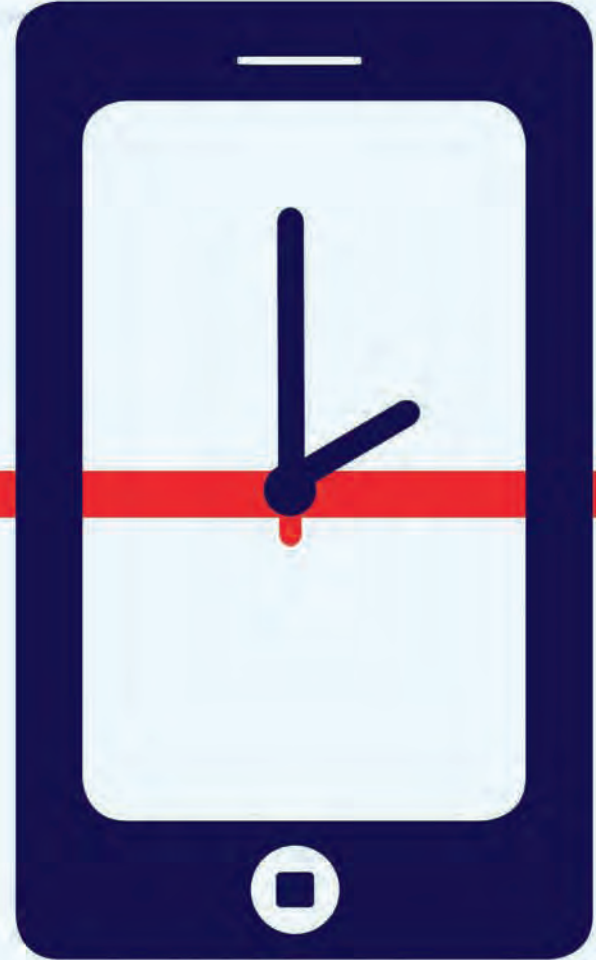
