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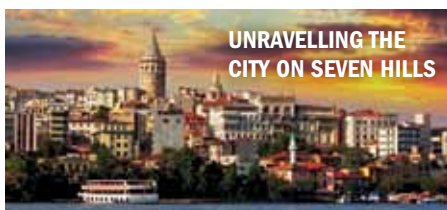

Cable free battery charger



With all the new applications and fast internet connection on our smart phones, its battery drains as fast as a lightning bolt. So what is one to do we do if the phone's battery is dead while out? The best solution is the new portable phone chargers getting trendy these days. But is just any charger good to carry?

bKey is the new wireless portable charger that looks exactly like a key. Why? Because it's made to be put in our keychain, pocket, or bag, so we always keep it handy. It has a USB connection for charging the bKey itself, and either a micro-USB or lightning adapter (depending on the version you go for) at the other end to recharge your phone. Moreover, this device is as easy to use as any other, just plug it to your laptop or wall adapter to charge it, and then use the other end on your phone. 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New Epson projectors

Model 1 is very sharp, clear, and best suited to use in commercial projections, as well as it has communication options (calls) along with speakers. Whereas model 2 can be controlled using 2 special pens, as well as a writing board, and it also helps connect inter-office meetings. Model 3 can be used through touch or through normal body gestures and moves.

Movable security camera

The only known way of keeping an eye on what's happening at home in your absence is using electrically powered security cameras all around to record every single action. They need space to put all the machines needed to save all the footage. That was until we discovered Blink!

Blink is the new security camera that you can move anywhere, and keep an eye on it. It takes the shape of a small square, and runs on batteries that last for a year without changing. Most importantly, it doesn't need to be plugged anywhere, therefore giving you freedom to place it wherever you want.

Furthermore, each Blink camera has a motion sensor and a temperature sensor, and connects to your home wi-fi network. But you don't have to set up multiple cameras one by one. Instead, the Blink system also comes with a "sync module" that plugs into the wall. When you fire up the Smartphone app (for Android or iOS), you're communicating with the sync module, which then in turn sets up the network of cameras. And to minimise the chore of keeping that many Blink cameras charged, the system keeps the cameras at zero power when they aren't being used.

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All for a better cause

The ALS Ice Bucket Challenge has now reached the Middle East with a splash.

The ALS Association has managed to raise over \$50 million as the donations for ALS charities have increased dramatically from 1 million new donors. It has struck the social media universe making millions of people around the world pour a bucket of ice water over their heads and challenging others to do the same, or simply just donate money to the ALS Association, all in an effort to raise money for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) research and awareness. By the looks of it, every celebrity has been doing it, from athletes, to actors, to pop stars, along with millions of ordinary people across social media.

Let's dig deeper and get a closer look at what ALS actually is. Many people have participated in the ALS Ice Bucket Challenge despite knowing the true misery of this disease. Often referred to as "Lou Gehrig's Disease", ALS is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that affects nerve cells in the brain and the spinal cord that causes difficulty in speaking, swallowing, breathing, and ultimately leads to paralysis; which is similar to the feeling when freezing water is poured on you. Before the ice bucket challenge went viral, many people were not aware of this disease. The average life expectancy for patients diagnosed





with ALS is three to five years. That's why the ice bucket challenge is very important.

Many people including celebrities like Oprah Winfrey, Bill Gates, Cristiano Ronaldo, and former President George W. Bush have posted videos of themselves getting buckets of ice water dumped over their heads and then nominated others. On the other hand, some celebrities just opted to donate money to the ALS foundation. It is

an act which has spread worldwide incredibly fast, and has now reached the Middle East. Here, a group of volunteers teamed up with their friends at Yas Waterworld to make the UAE's biggest ice bucket challenge, which actually seemed like something really fun to do.

While many have been supporting the ALS foundation, many have also expressed criticism saying it is a waste of water, publicity stunt, or "slactivism" (participating

in something without actually having to do anything). However, supporters of this challenge believe it has brought hundreds of thousands to join the fight against ALS. It is effective cause marketing. President and chief executive officer of the ALS Association, Barbara J. Newhouse said in a statement: "The ALS Association is extremely grateful for the generosity of these donors, and for the actions of several people initiated and spread this incredible

viral effort." The cause of ALS is not yet known, and scientists do not know why this crippling disease strikes some people and not others. However, owing to the ice bucket challenge, recent awareness and interest has been raised and millions of dollars have been raised to fund efforts to eradicate ALS. With all this money, scientists can now acknowledge further information about ALS and perhaps figure out its causes or discover more effective treatments.

Boxing:

Scott Quigg will face Stephane Jamoye as he defends his WBA super bantamweight title at the Phones 4u Arena in Manchester. Quigg was first supposed to challenge Paulus Ambunda, however he was forced to withdraw due to a hamstring injury. His replacement Jamoye could no doubt be dangerous opponent as the fight takes place on September 13.



Cricket:

James Taylor has led Nottinghamshire to victory beating Derbyshire by 85 runs at Trent Bridge to reach the semi finals of the Royal London One-Day Cup. "It was an outstanding and thorough performance the whole way through, we did exceptionally well with the bat and then with the ball we were outstanding," said Taylor. The hosts are the first team to book their place in the semi finals of this season.



Rugby:

Argentina will play without the injured Pablo Matera during their next games against New Zealand and Australia. The 21-year-old dislocated his shoulder during the 33-31 loss to South Africa and has therefore been ruled out for the upcoming two Rugby Championship matches. Leonardo Senatore could be a replacement for the blindside flanker.



Patience is key



Dutch coach Louis van Gaal has insisted on his fans to be patient with Manchester United following their humiliating 4-0 defeat against MK Dons in the Capital One Cup. The Red devils pulled off a great performance at the pre-season in the United States, however things have turned out quite differently with the start of the Premier League. Van Gaal wants United fans to stick by his team and his philosophy as he claims "They have to believe in our philosophy, we are building up a team and you cannot make that happen in one month, not in one year."

The Red Devils could possibly find themselves boosted off with positive energy following the signing of Argentina's Angel Di Maria for a British record fee, however Van Gaal is not expecting him to turn the tables instantly.

Early ending



Jamaican world record holder Usain Bolt has ended his 2014 season quite early as he did not run in the final Diamond League event. The decision was taken by Bolt's coach Glen Mills. Bolt has only ran three races this season and has won gold with Jamaica's 4x100m relay team during the Commonwealth Games.

"Usain's body has delivered tremendous performances throughout the years, but it's a body, not a machine," said Diamond League Final meet director Patrick Magyar. It seems that Bolt and his coach think that more rest is needed.

Bolt ran his first 100m race of this year during an exhibition which took place in the Copacabana beach in Rio de Janeiro.

Problematic duo



The aftermath of the explosive Belgian Grand Prix has brought war upon Mercedes, and could possibly persuade Lewis Hamilton to leave the team. While Daniel Ricciardo sees only good things ahead, Mercedes faces trouble after Nico Rosberg has crashed into Mercedes team-mate Lewis Hamilton. Hamilton has allegedly claimed that Rosberg admitted crashing on purpose; however Rosberg says that his side of the story is completely different. The state of war between the German and Englishman could cause Hamilton to leave Mercedes within 15 months. The 2008 world champion's contract with Mercedes expires at the end of next season; however he might have to reconsider his choice as Rosberg will stay with Mercedes for the upcoming three years.

Not good enough

Graeme Swann has claimed that England have "no chance" of winning next year's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. The ex-England spinner believes that the team is not good enough, and that a change in personnel is needed to win the global 50-over tournament.

"We won't win this World Cup," said Swann. "In four years' time, we might have a chance if we get in all the exciting players who have none of the baggage of the old-style brand we play." Swann would like to see Cook, Ian Bell, and Gary Ballance replaced by Hampshire's James Vince, Surrey's Jason Roy, and James Taylor of Nottingham as he believes that these are players qualified to win the World Cup.

You hold back on sharing your ideas

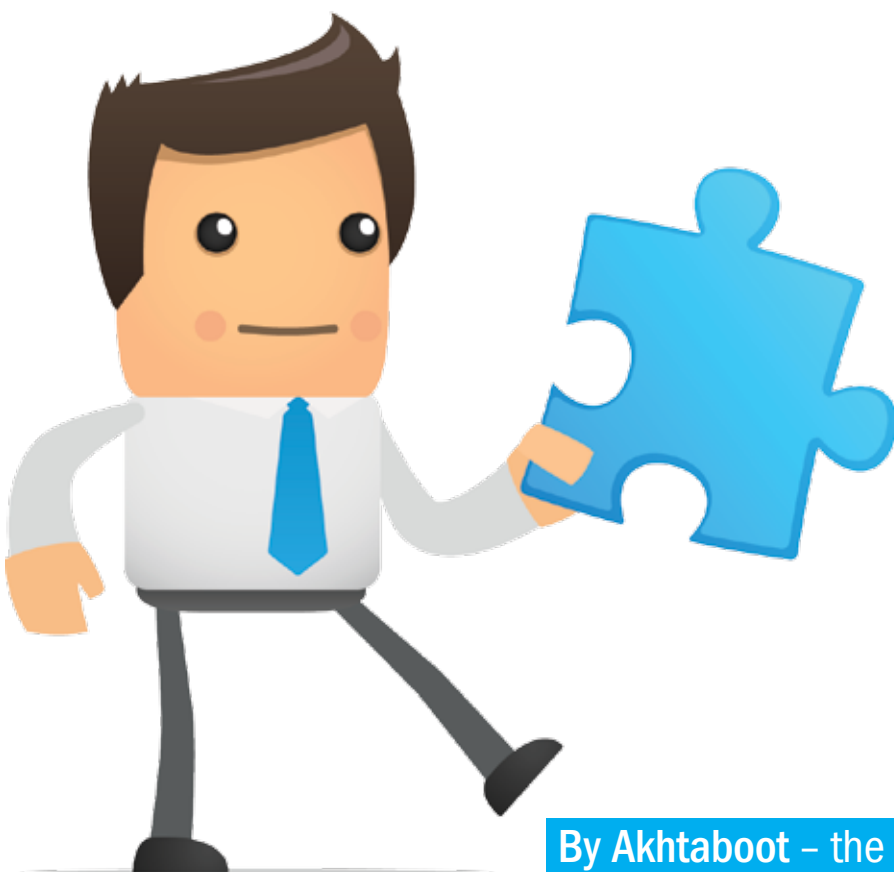

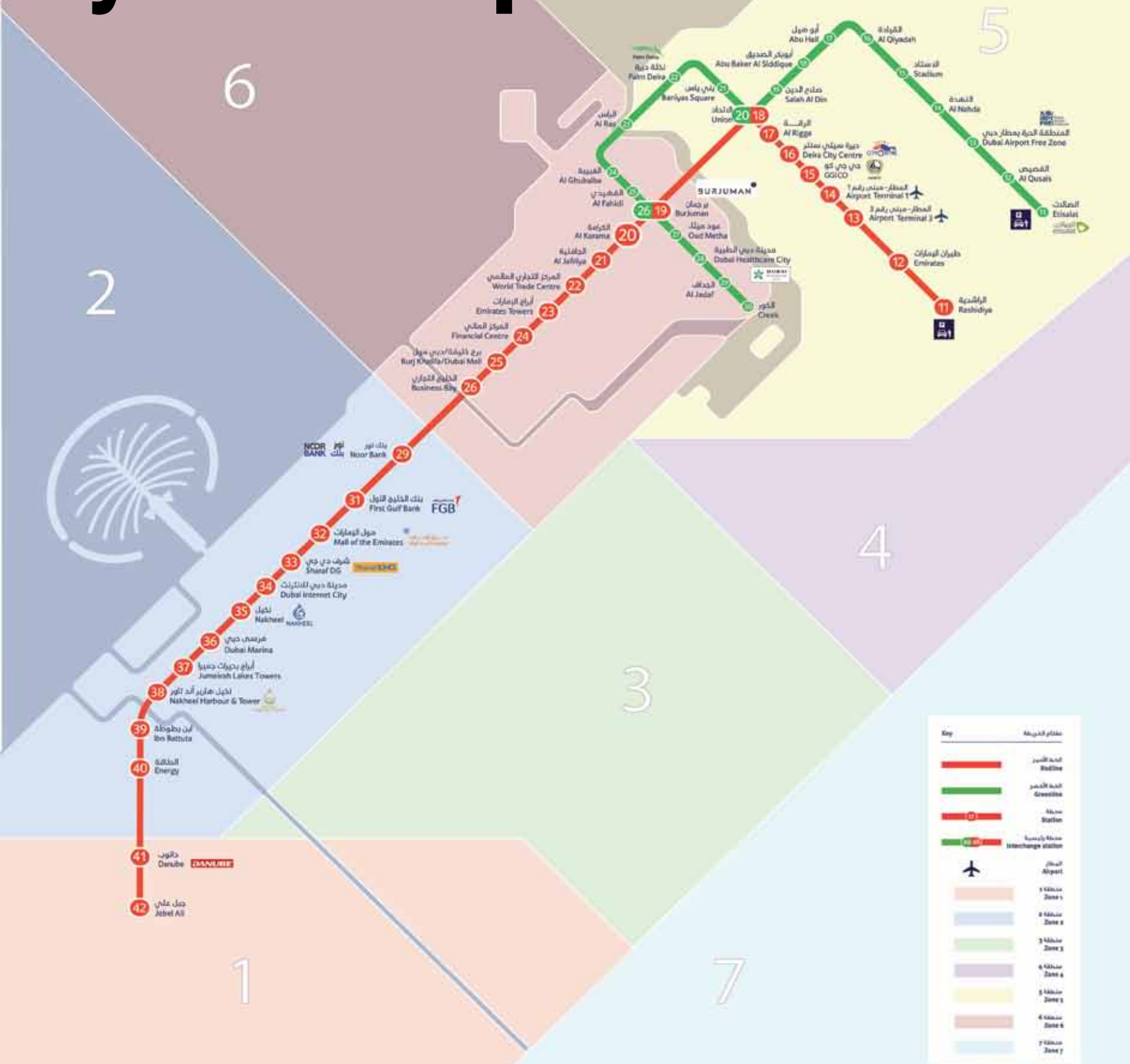

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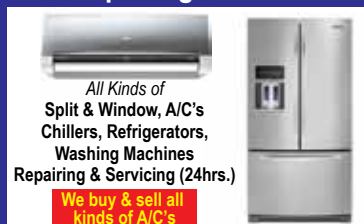
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Al Tayer meets visiting Indian panel

Shah Rukh Khan's security beefed after underworld threats

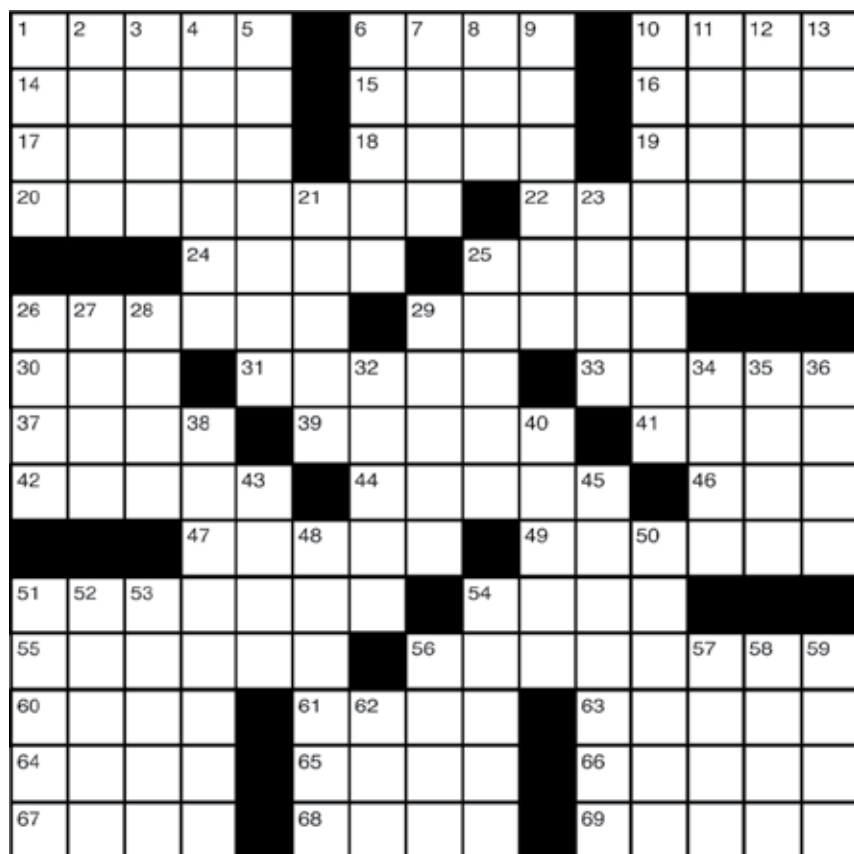

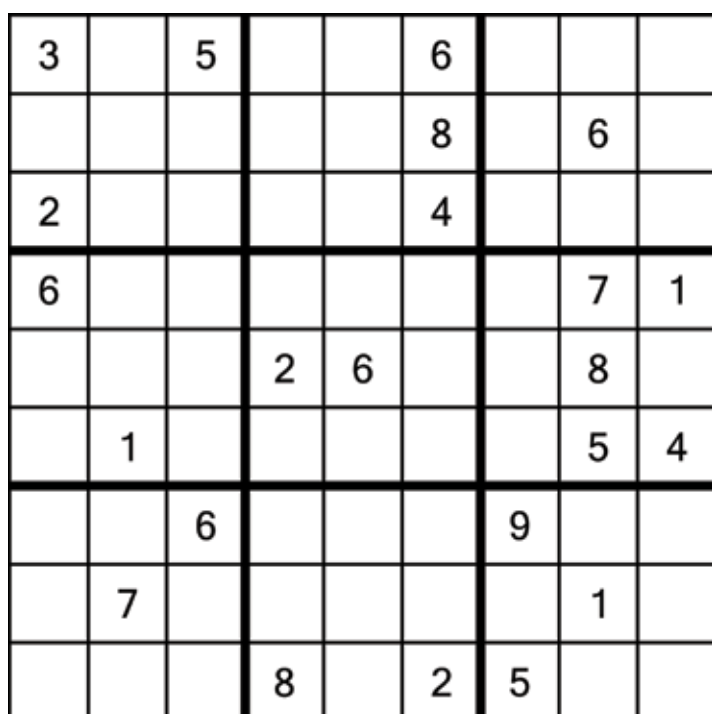
