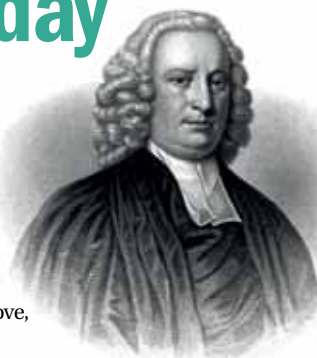

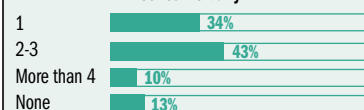

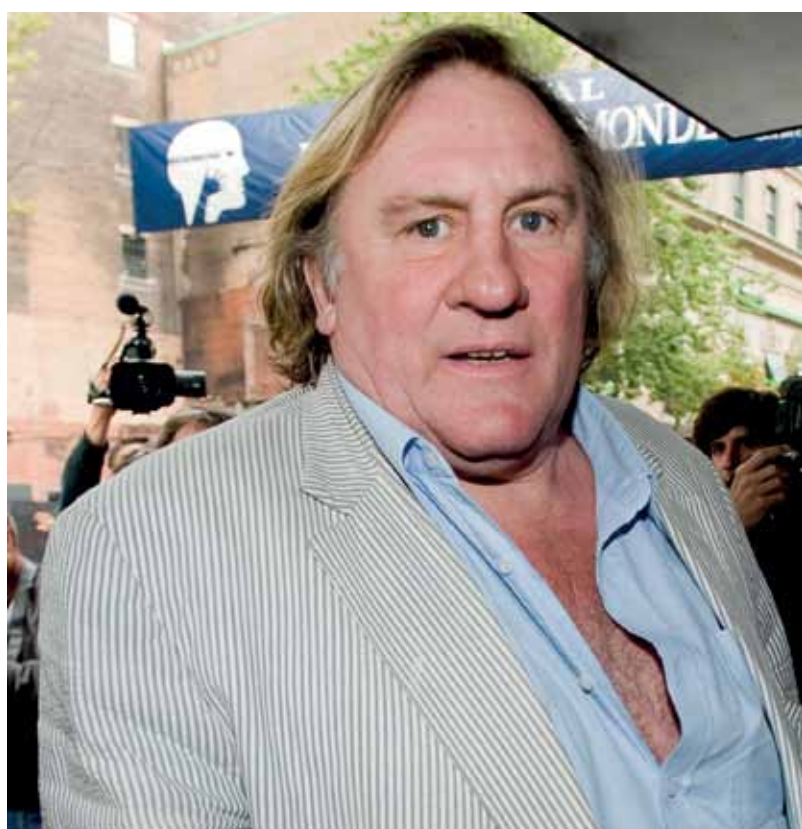

Viktor: A film about revenge and redemption



In his recent film *Viktor*, Gérard Depardieu plays a father who seeks revenge for his murdered son in Russia – a place close to his heart in reality.

Having premiered at the 22nd edition of Window to Europe Film Festival in Vyborg, Russia, *Viktor* is a film about vengeance. It is the story of a father going to extremes to redeem the murder of his son in his absence. The father returns to Russia to find the gangsters who murdered his son while he was serving a sentence in France for an art heist. And who would be more suited for the role than Gérard Depardieu, the famous Frenchman who adopted Russian citizenship after a tax payment row in France.

Depardieu, although fits many stereotypes in his choice of roles, also beaks stereotypes and is fiercely defensive of the Russians. Speaking about the Russian stereotype of the “bad guy” in American films, he said,

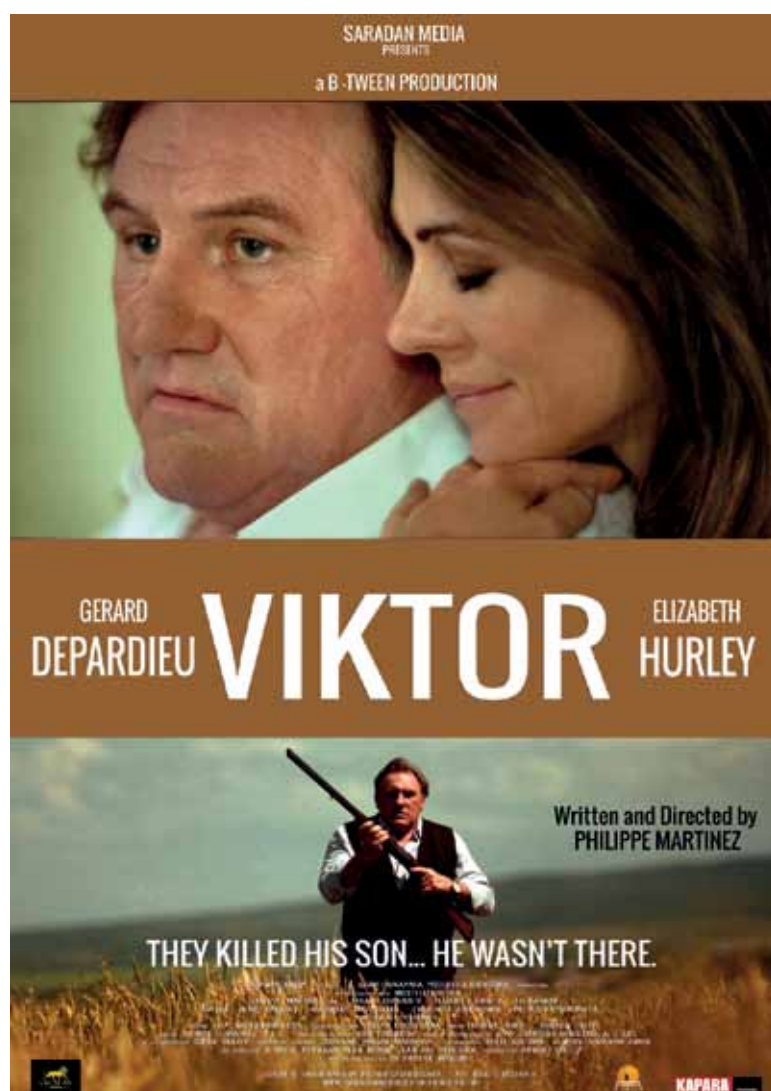
“I don’t believe that if a person is a Russian national means he is bad. It looks like the Cold War has come back. In those times you could choose a bad or good side. But I’m not sure Americans are too good. Every country has its own mafia. Russia has a great culture, but the United States cannot make that claim.”

But what is it that draws this Frenchman to Russia now? “I have always been close to Russian culture, so I am very happy that now I am part of this great country. I am proud that I am a citizen of Russia,” he said refuting claims of a recent liking. So close is he to Russia now, that he admits to having an emotional connection with the country, and claims his “soul is close to the Russian one”.



The film also stars Elisabeth Hurley, his lover and supporter. Shot in Chechnya and Moscow, the film shows a picturesque Russia and brings two contrasting emotions together: love and revenge – how the love for his son makes a thief a killer. “All that he wants is to redeem the sins and avenge his child’s death. He is crazy! He tortures people to know what happened to his son... But personally, I justify his actions. For one’s own children, a person can go to great lengths,” he said.

In real life, the actor is “impressed by Vladimir Putin”, who himself handed Depardieu his Russian passport. and for his upcoming film, *Sex, Coffee and Cigarettes*, which is Russian obviously, the actor is simply playing himself. “I do not believe in the acting game, I believe in life, I trust people and I love to try new things. I loved taking part in this project, with wonderful actresses and a great director,” he said earnestly.

Boxing:

WBO Inter-Continental lightweight champion Anthony Crolla is aiming for a world title shot this year. "I'm due a massive fight and if you look at the WBO ratings there's a good chance I could get a final eliminator to fight for the WBO belt later in the year," he said.



Cricket:

Middlesex all-rounder Neil Dexter has agreed a contract extension with the club, which will keep him there until the end of next season. The 30-year-old transferred to Middlesex five years ago from Kent and managed to play over 215 games for the club, scoring more than 6,600 runs. "I hope the remaining years of cricket left in him will be spent at Middlesex," said Middlesex managing director of cricket Angus Fraser.



Rugby:

Leicester Tigers captain Ed Slater may be ruled out for up to nine months after undergoing reconstructive knee surgery. The 26-year-old was injured playing for the England midweek side on the summer tour of New Zealand. Leicester head coach Richard Cockerill said "He will come back better and fresher than ever, we will stick by him."



Imminent success

Sir Bobby Charlton believes that Louis van Gaal will soon find success with Manchester United and describes the current campaign as a "great adventure". The club has recently signed Marcos Rojo, Daley Blind, Angel Di Maria and Radamel Falcao, making Charlton to feel upbeat with high chances of victories for United.

"It seems strange that Manchester United is not involved in European football for a season," said Charlton. "We have started with some new players, we have not been playing well but we will play well."

"Van Gaal has given me and most of us fans some good news and it is good news. We won't struggle anymore," he added.



A daunting wait

With the Ryder Cup around the corner, Colin Montgomerie believes that it will be a nerve-racking moment for those participating in golf's greatest team event. Europe's former No 1 thinks that many of the golfers would prefer the match to be starting tomorrow due to all the tensions building up.

"With just a few weeks to go the whole team will be nervous, thinking about certain shots they will be hitting," Montgomerie said. "A lot would love to get it over but this all adds to the beauty of the Ryder Cup, and adds to the excitement."



More to come

Marin Cilic insists that he can win even more grand slam titles following his US Open victory against Kei Nishikori. The Croatian's triumph came unexpected after defeating the Japanese with straight sets. Cilic has now become the only man along with Juan Martin del Porto younger than the "big four" of Rafael Nadal, Roger Federer, Novak Djokovic and Andy Murray to clinch a major title.

Cilic is now targeting more grand slam titles after playing some of the best of his career. "It sort of seemed almost impossible to be part of this era and win a grand slam and just by winning it still feels almost unreal," he said. "For sure, it's way closer for me now to win another one."

Progressing recovery

Michael Schumacher's rehabilitation in the hospital has ended and the seven-time World Champion has left Lausanne Hospital to continue his rehabilitation following his skiing accident at home. Schumacher awakened back in June after being placed in a medically induced coma due to head injuries suffered during his ski accident in December 2013.

It is said that progress has been made lately and that doctors had released him to carry on his recovery at home. "Considering the severe head injuries he suffered, progress has been made in the past weeks and months. There is still, however, a long and difficult road ahead."

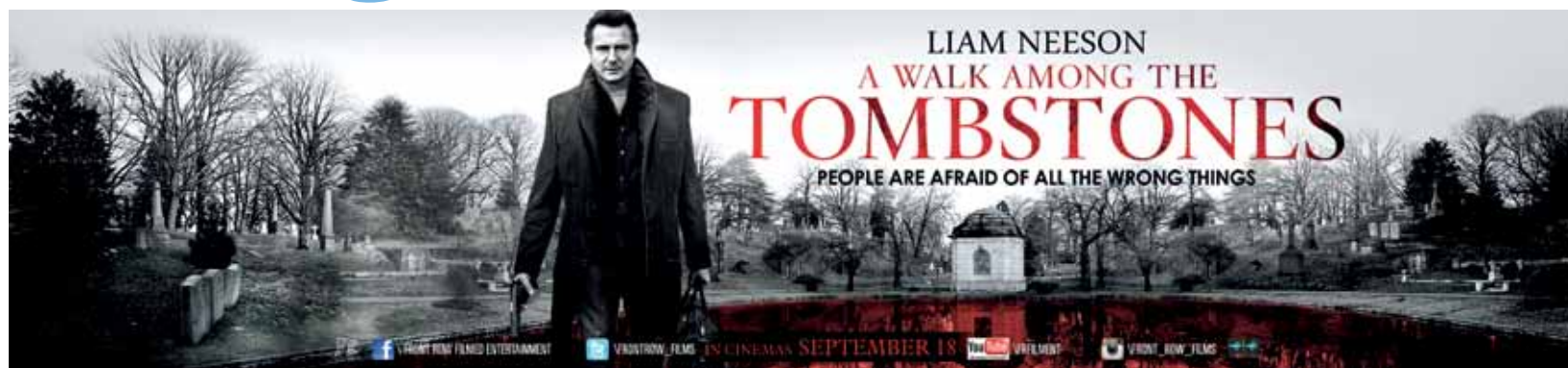

Why you cannot retain your employees

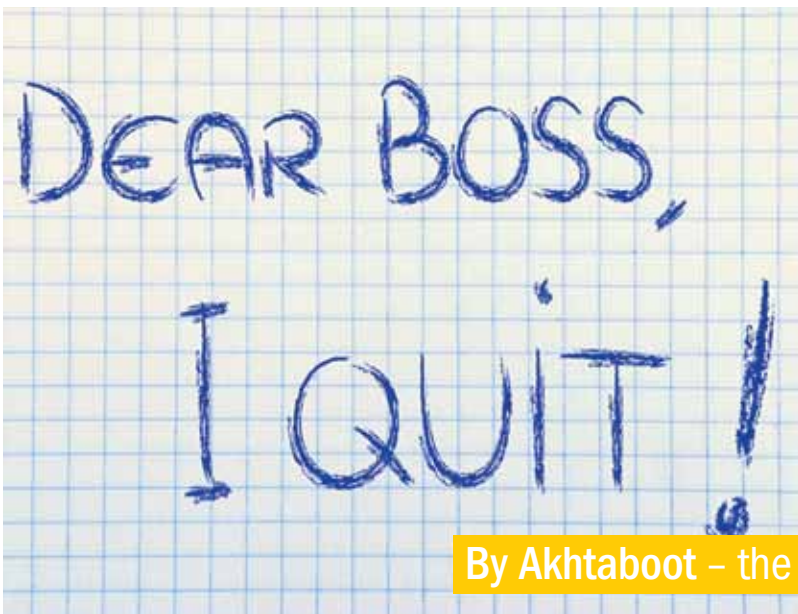
It is hard to retain good employees sometimes, despite giving them a lot of benefits.

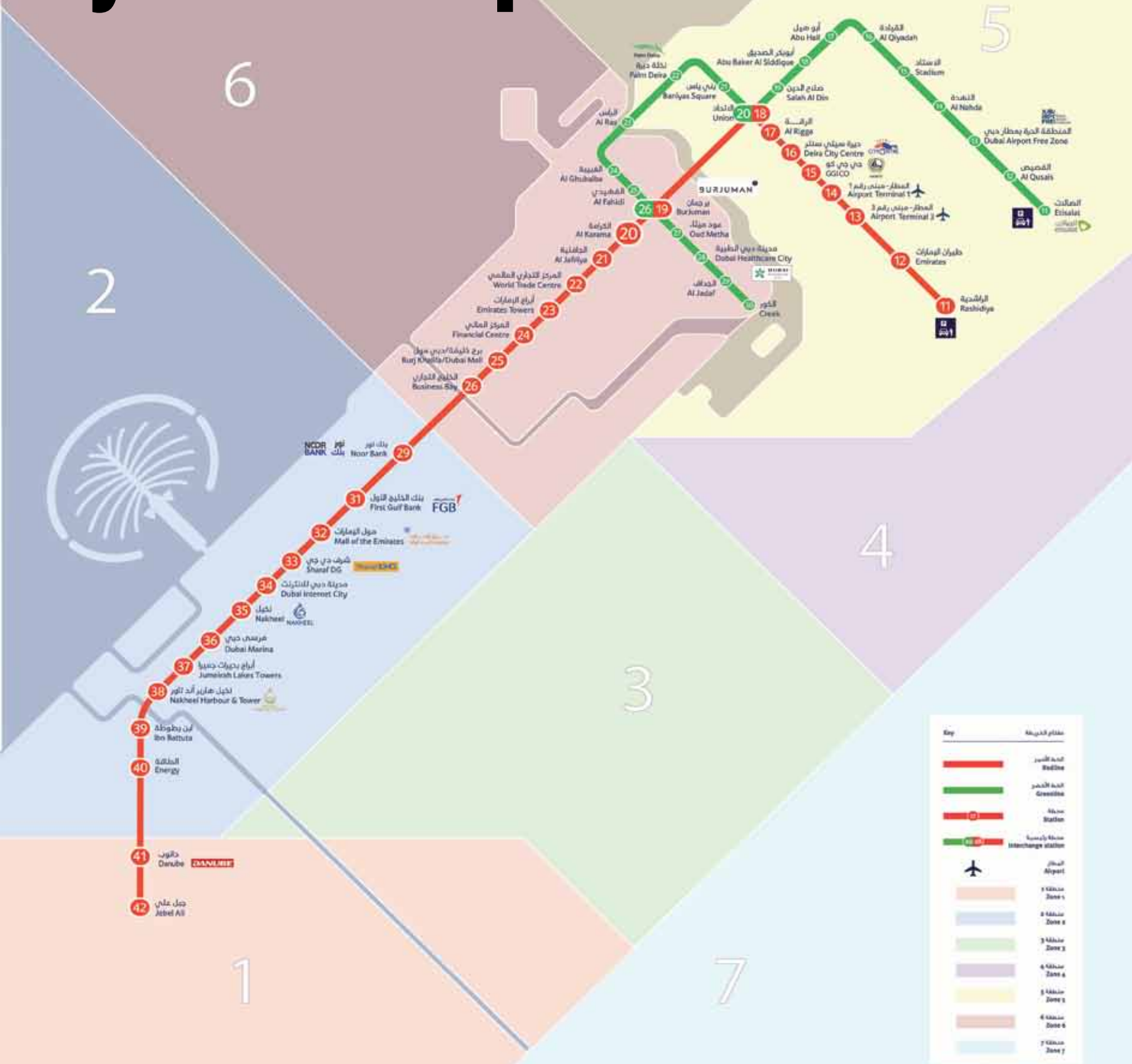
Lack of communication

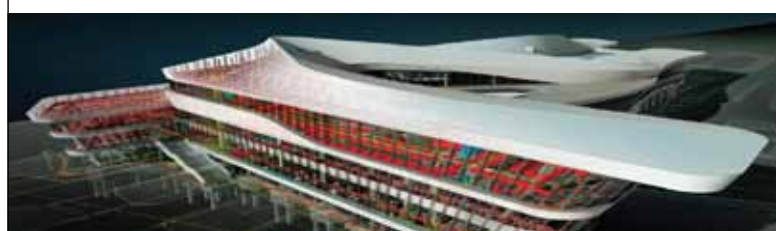

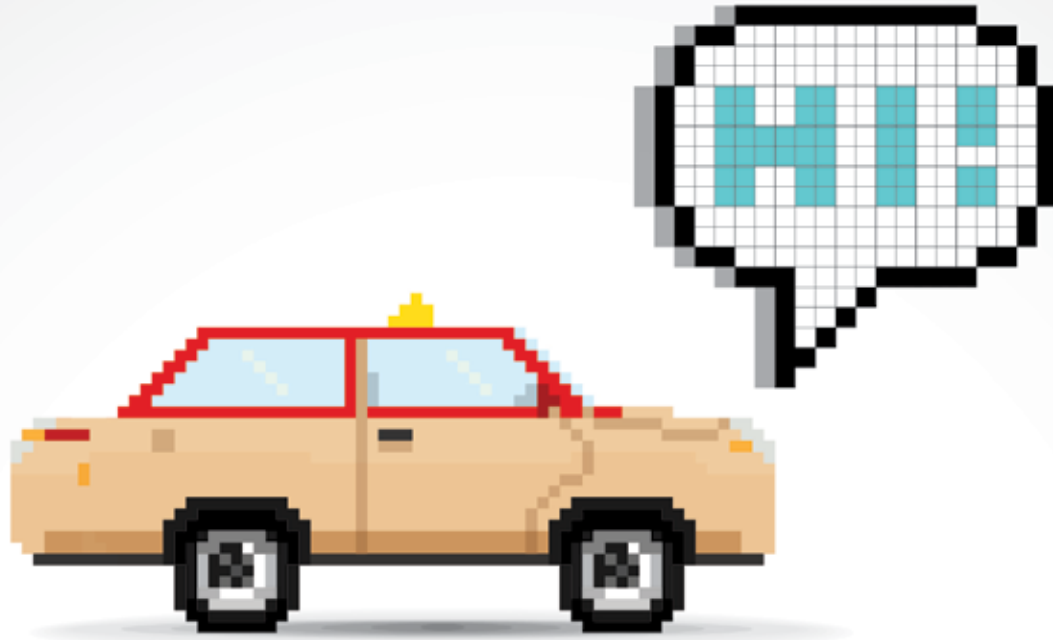

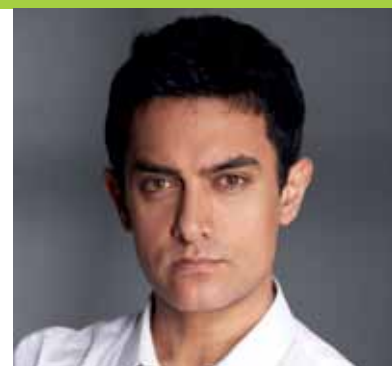
King Khan and his eight packs

The ambiguous and enigmatic Lady Gaga in Dubai

What is the first thing that comes to your mind when you hear artRAVE: The Art Pop Ball tour? A rave or something more artistic? A pop tour or a fancy ball? There seem to be a lot of ambiguities in just the name, but when you know that it's Lady Gaga, it makes sense. She is, after all, a lady, who is gaga. A diva who at once wears a meat dress to an awards show, and some time later, she is a Versace muse.

But for her first concert in Dubai at the Meydan Racecourse, the songstress chose a more heartfelt way to connect with her "monsters". "They used to tell me I was crazy, I would never come to the Middle East. They were wrong, they were the judgmental ones," she said of the criticism she had received before touring. Awestruck with the Arabs, she added, "And here you are very beautiful Arabs."

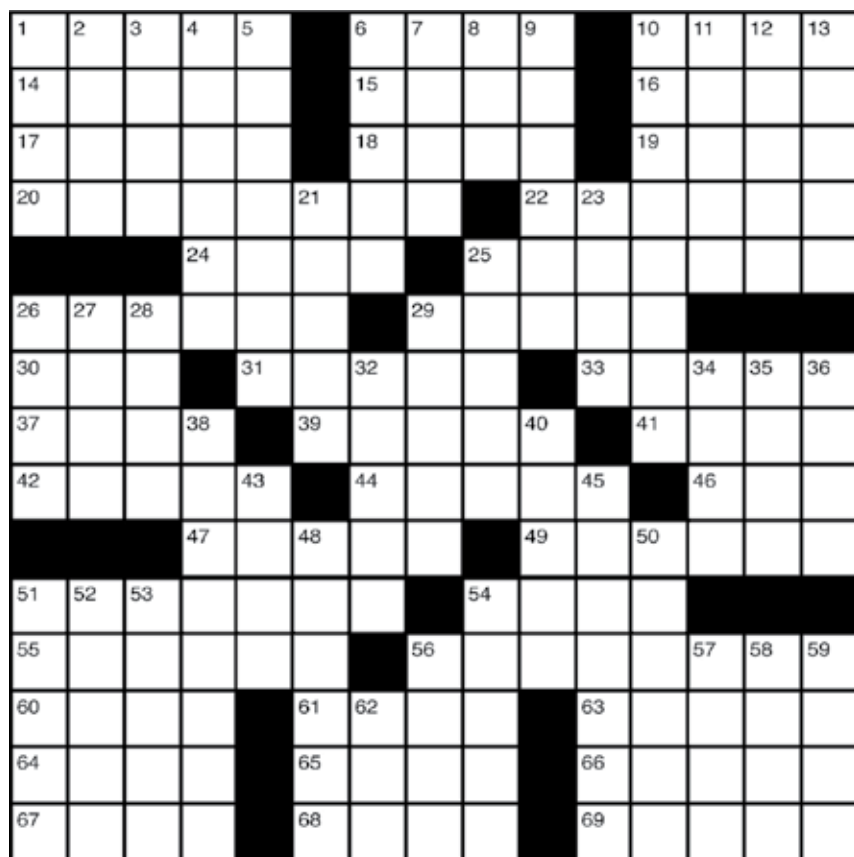

The monsters enjoyed the memorable September night, basking in the glory of a pop star, and left a little part of their hearts there, and for Lady Gaga, she took a little part of Dubai, of which she had no prior knowledge, with her, as she said "shukran" to the roaring crowd.

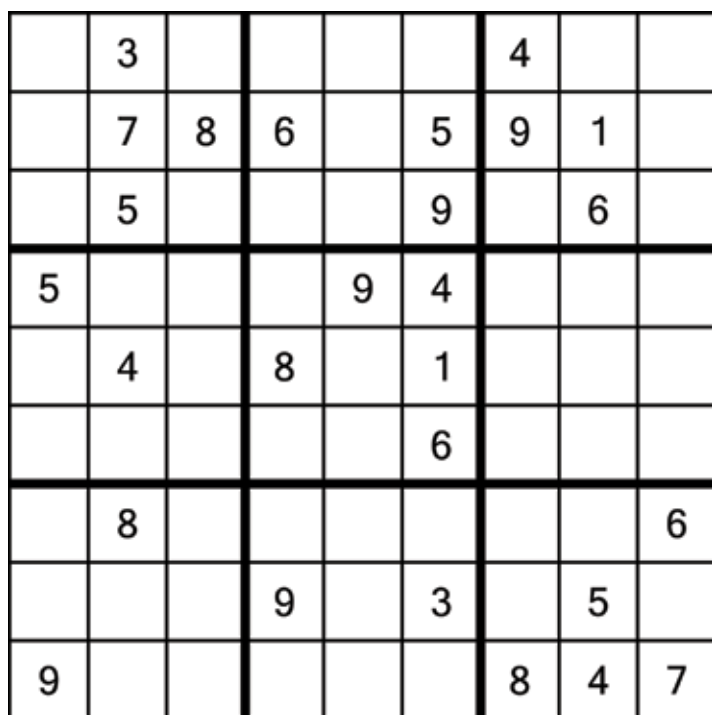
