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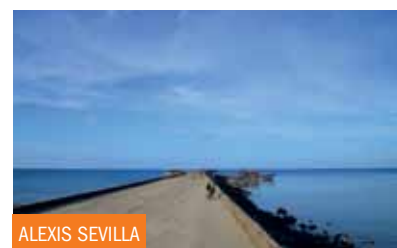

"My grandmother has had Alzheimer's for about 11 years. We were very close. The way we are now is a bit different. She taught me how to sing. She was just a really warm and amazing person. We just had amazing times together. And then when we started noticing that she had symptoms, obviously things changed a little bit and we had to find a new way of dealing with things. It was getting to the point where it was time for her to be somewhere she can be looked after all the time. During dinner, she looked at the knife and fork not knowing how to use them, so we explained it and it was all fine. After dinner she started playing the piano with both hands which was amazing. One of the ways we communicate with her now is through music, but sometimes if she is distressed, and then you play a piece of music, she will start tapping her feet. Today she is not really recognizing anyone, she isn't communicative. She is different from time to time, sometimes she is very quiet, and sometimes she makes a lot of noise. Sometimes there is an amazing moment where you see exactly who she was or is inside. There was obviously a period of time that was very difficult when she was experiencing the confusion and understanding and being self aware that she is forgetting things. But it's almost better now that she has passed that stage and she is in a really amazing home that we love visiting because it is so vibrant and such a joyful place to be in. This is something that's really a painful thing for families which really hurts people and causes a great amount of stress, sadness, anxiety, and grief. And it is just not given the attention that it needs. I think people think that it's just part of being old. So I think when people can understand it as an illness which needs to be researched, prevented and cured, then we can start tackling it seriously."

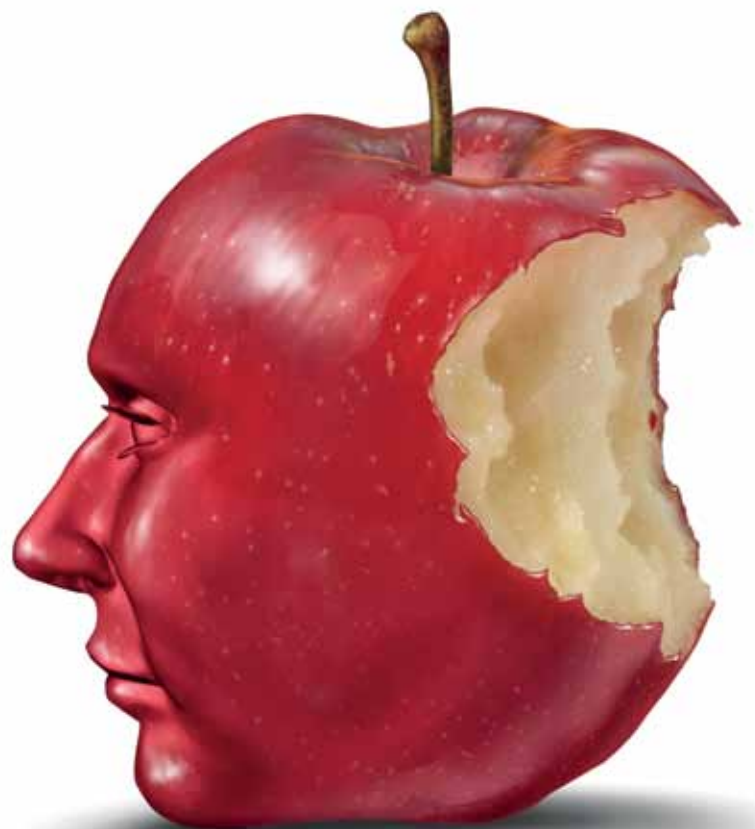
Sleep well to avoid Alzheimer's

Recent studies have found **alarming results** of sleep deprivation linked to Alzheimer's disease.

You don't have any excuse to be a sufferer of ill-health especially when the situation is in your hands. You can manage your style, your sleep hours, or do you want to be just another number in the statistics of Alzheimer's sufferers?

I'm not talking about new drugs or about innovative technology: it's just a question of how many hours you shut your eyes per day. Accordingly, a latest study suggests how women can be more prone to the disease. Recent studies suggest that long-term sleep deprivation saps the brain of power even after days of recovery sleep, and that could be a sign of lasting brain injury. Results of tests conducted on mice, shows that mice on wonky sleep schedule mirrors to shift workers destroys brain cells, in other words if you stay three days of night shifts with only four to five hours sleep in 24 hours, you might lose 25% of your nerve cells comparing with regular sleep shift.

- Your cognitive performance after sleep is less.
- Extended periods of wakefulness actually kill some neurons and cause damage to others.
- You will damage particular neurons located in the brainstem that play a role in determining one's mood, anti social and depressed behaviour.
- Skin ageing is a very important issue for women that threatens to hit them by Alzheimer more than men.
- Try to keep your memory sharp as much as you can because you will need it every day to survive, how? By taking an adequate sleep time.
- These days the slim shape is not just a trend only, but it's very an important healthy concern, so be on the track and save your body from extra weight that dissociates you from the environment around you by getting sufficient sleep hours.

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Safe smartphone in driving mode

It is a very important that we don't use our smartphones while driving. This is a huge debate that everyone is concerned about these days, as it simply can be fatal. Navdy is here to help you stay in touch with the outside world while driving. Navdy wants to prove that we can still use our smartphones while driving in a safer way than what we're used to do. With its head's up display, everything can show up there, in the direction where the driver is constantly looking. The device is powered by plugging it into the on-board computer, which cars

manufactured since 1996. Once it connects to your phone via Bluetooth, its voice and gesture controls allow you to take calls, reply to texts and ask for directions without having to pick up your phone. You do need the iOS or Android app to help set up the device. Furthermore, when it is linked to the car's on-board computer, it can also project speed, RPM, fuel economy stats, tire-pressure warning or battery-voltage warning, among others. Users can customise the display to show something specific, such as a large RPM dial in the centre.



Pawtrack: the cat GPS collar



Don't you sometimes wish if you can use a GPS to track down our cat or dog? Or sometimes to just keep an eye on them when they're out in the backyard or hiding in the house? Pawtrack is a GPS collar, specifically made for cats. Pawtrack's collar design puts the GPS antenna on the back of the animal's neck for more accurate readings and lets owners set how often it tracks. For example, it can be configured to track a cat for two days every 10 minutes, or be set for longer periods of time if owners go on vacation. In addition to GPS, Pawtrack also has internal wi-fi, which means that the collar can recognise when a cat is home and put itself to sleep to preserve energy. On the other hand, Pawtrack's "lost cat" mode will alert owners automatically once the cat is located. As cat owners know how cats run and hide, this should be a great way to keep an eye and find them fast.



Robotic play

Some of us might be able to remember the Sphero robot ball that can be controlled by a phone app. But now, an elder sibling of this ball is about to be launched: Ollie, a bigger cylinder shaped robot can do more than its predecessor. It is also controlled by a phone app, and can do much more. If young kids in yesteryears used to play with remote controlled cars, today there's Ollie – phone controlled robot. It's safe to play, easy to maintain, and can run on different surfaces. All we have to do is to pair up Ollie to our phone app via Bluetooth. It can speed up to around 22 km/h and surely run just anywhere. Moreover, it also has apps to give you feedback about your driving skills, how to improve them, and points you've scored. 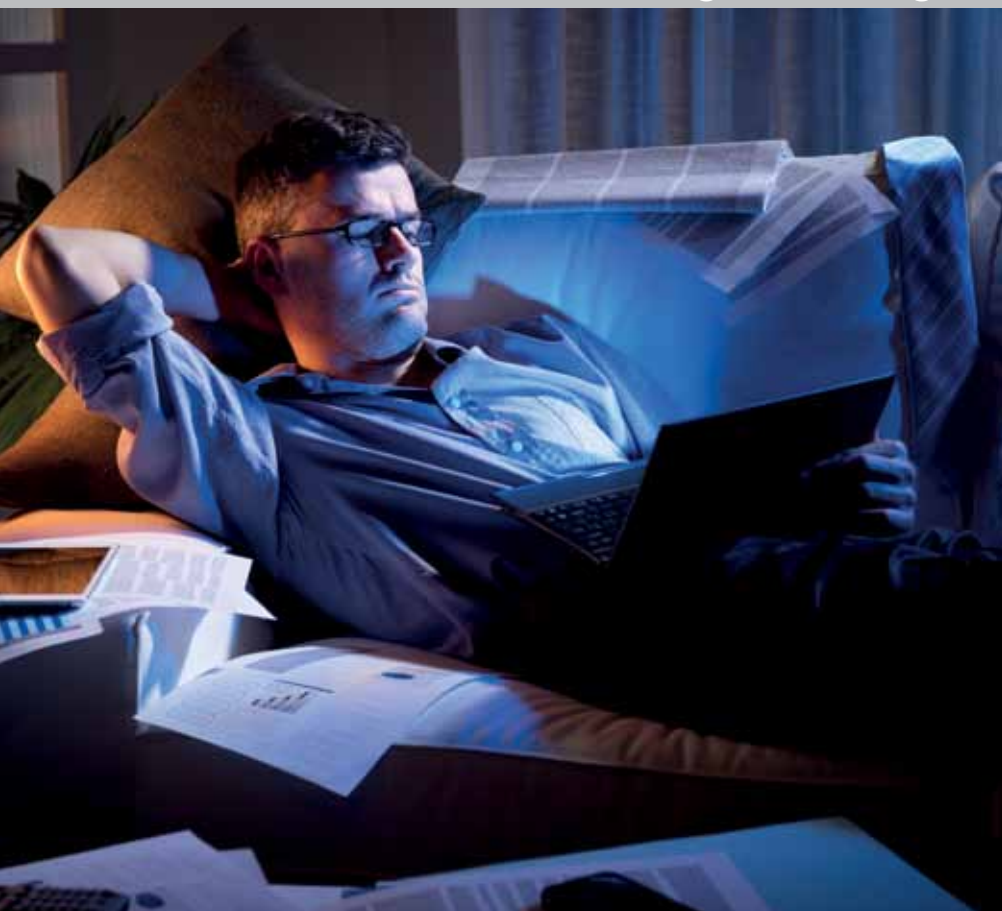

Arts, Emirates and the World Peace Day

With the Gibson Art Guitars to be auctioned off for charity to mark the World Peace Day, READ spoke exclusively to the Emirati curator and artist Mo Abedin about the exhibition, his contribution and peace.

What have you personally brought to the Gibson Guitar?

The guitar that I have created is called 'A Blossoming Universe' and is made entirely out of a vibrant eclectic combination of coloured leathers. The floral designs on the guitar are inspired by a Thai art form and signifies a phase of renewal and growth that an individual goes through after obtaining inner peace. Since leather was a platform that I have never worked with before I partnered up with a super talented interior decorator named Fatima Zain for her experience and expertise in working with leather to ensure that the design was executed correctly.

What was the experience of curating this exhibition like?

I always have a personal connection with all the exhibits that I curate and create artwork for like 'Project: MEGA' and 'Art Wars Dubai' and this was no different. To get the opportunity to work with a legendary brand like Gibson in the name of world peace and the insanely talented roster of artists that I have put together for this exhibit is really humbling and inspiring.

How have the local artists worked for the exhibition, keeping in mind the World Peace Day?

All the artists in the roster have their own personal creative processes



that they go through before creating the artwork. For this exhibit for the 'World Peace Day' they have all interpreted their electric guitars with the face of peace in their own signature ways.

What message are you trying to disseminate through your artwork?

I'm a low brow urban artist that believes in easily digestible design and art, so most of the time the message in my work is quite easy to understand and sometimes there might not be a message at all. This is because I like the connection between people and my artwork to be instant and to appreciate it for what it

is and not what it is trying to be.

Tell us more about the charity organisation the proceeds of the auction will go to?

Peace One Day is a non-profit organisation whose objective is "to institutionalise the International Day of Peace, 21 September, making it a day that is self-sustaining, an annual day of global unity, a day of intercultural cooperation on a scale that humanity has never known." Founded in 1999 by the British documentary filmmaker and actor Jeremy Gilley, Peace One Day was instrumental in the United Nations' unanimous adoption, in 2001, of the first ever annual day of global

ceasefire and non-violence on 21 September – Peace Day.

What inspires you?

Anything and everything. I just have a never ending need to create new things all the time but being half Emirati and half Thai I also draw a lot of inspiration from fusions and the rich and colourful history and cultures of Asia and the Middle East, I am absolutely mesmerised by it.

What does peace mean to you?

Peace to me is about tolerance, equality, compassion, love, and the human spirit.

What was it like for you to work on a guitar?

Having never customised a guitar before and also having to incorporate the theme of world peace was quite an experience. To be able to turn something like the already stunning Les Paul into a work of art was challenging since it is perfect just the way it is. So after going through my personal creative process, I have learned that sometimes beauty should not be altered, so I took the route of enhancing and highlighting what it is that was already perfect.

Big B prays for flood victims

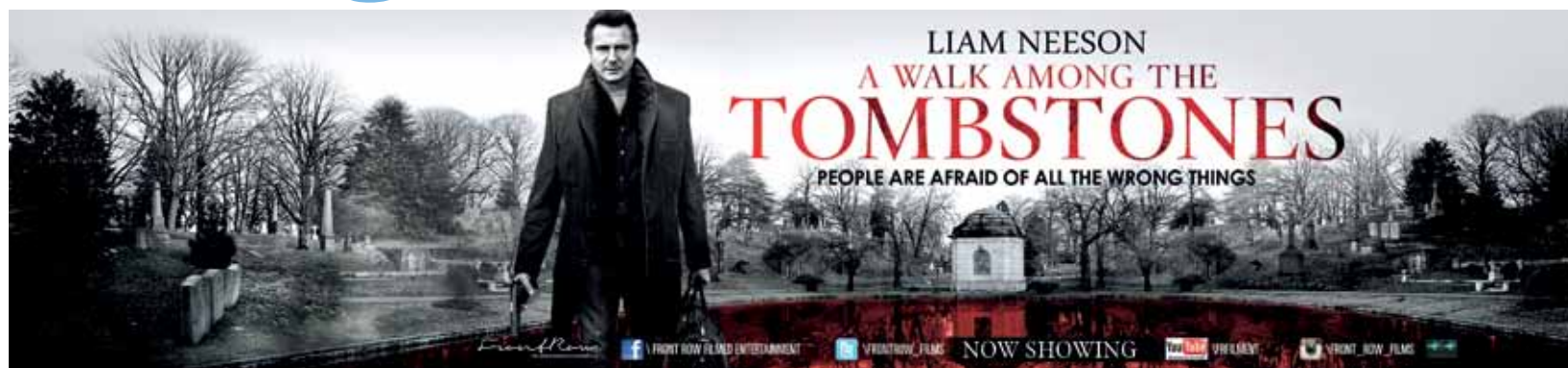

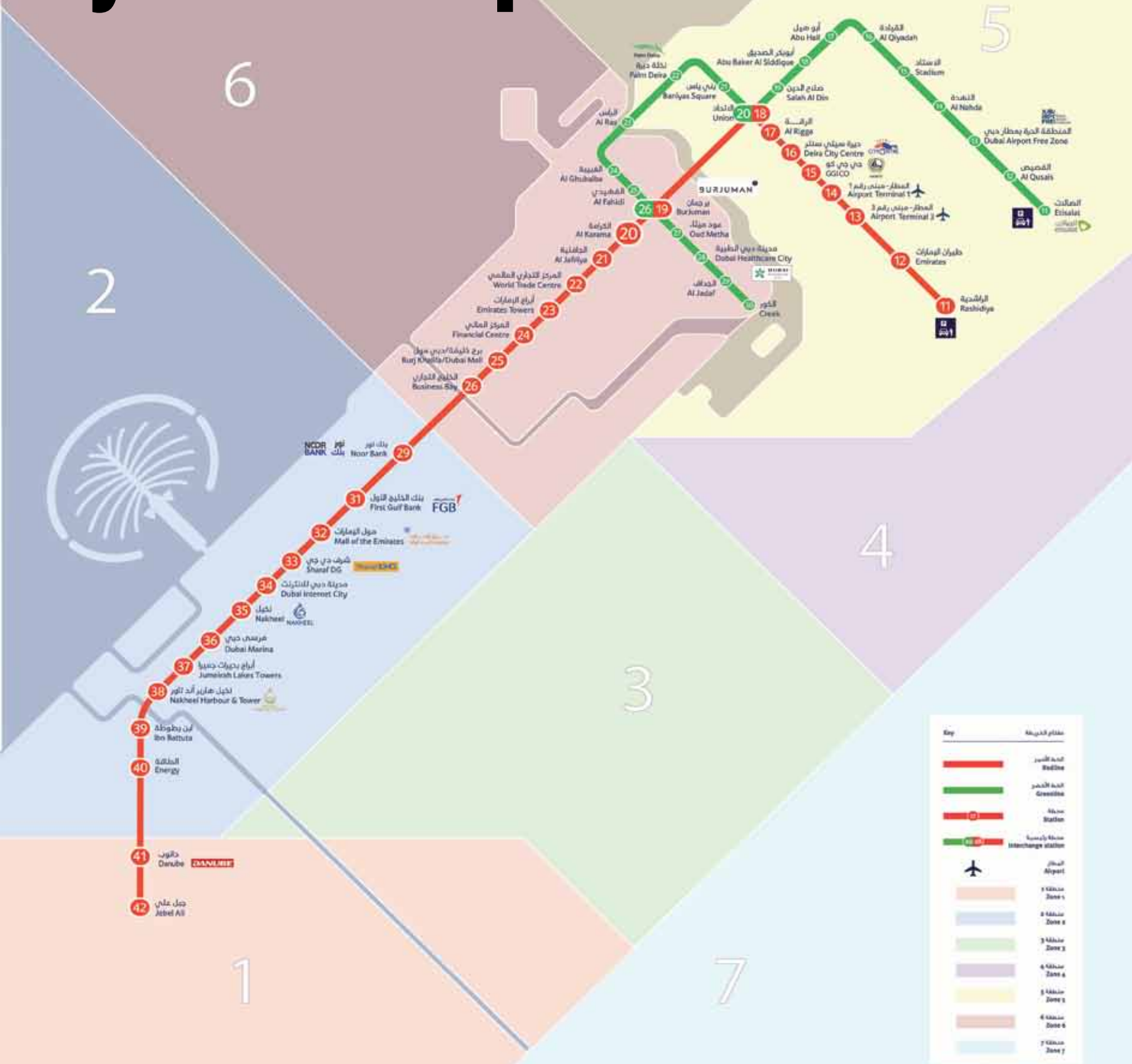
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Dubai Metro system map



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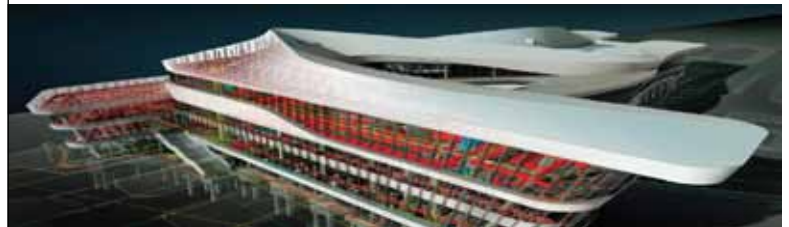
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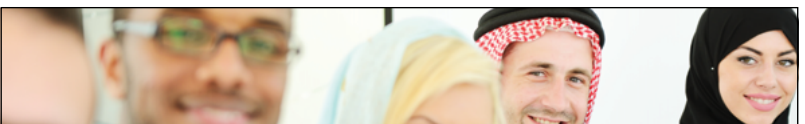

Tiger Woods admits that he is focusing on improving his strength and fitness rather than hiring a new swing coach. The former world No 1 hasn't played since August 3 when he withdrew from the WGC-Bridgestone Invitational after a severe back problem.

"I haven't swung a golf club yet. I've only been shadow swinging without a club but I've been working really hard in the gym," the 38-year-old said.

"I've got my strength back, now I need to get my explosiveness. Am I looking for a new coach? No I'm not. Right now I'm just trying to get physically better, stronger, faster, and more explosive."

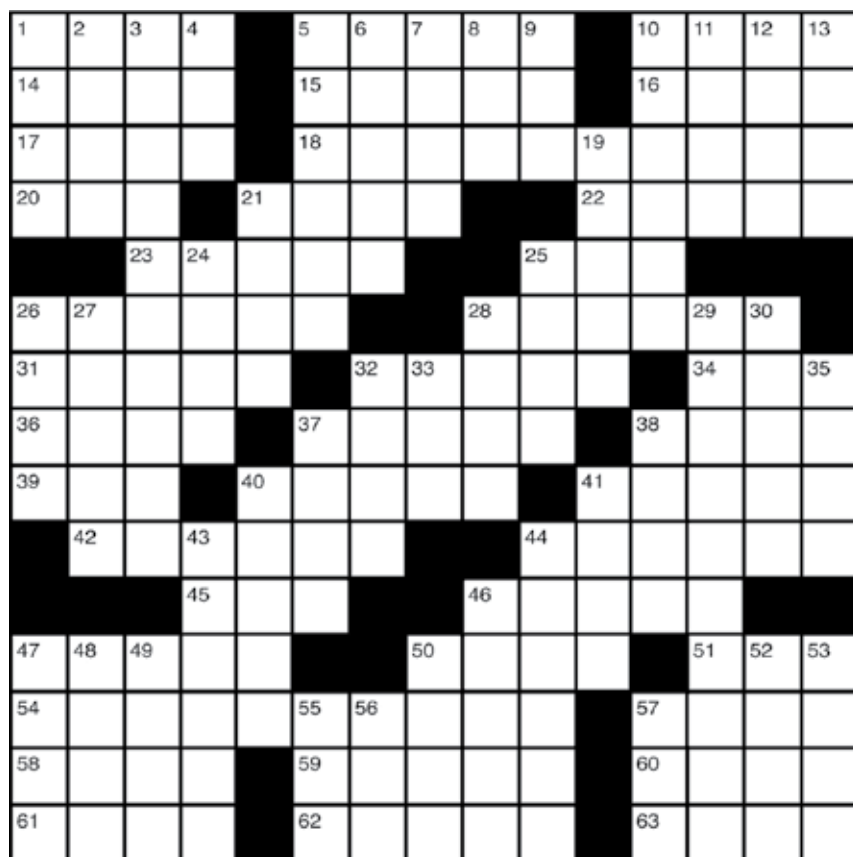


Missing out

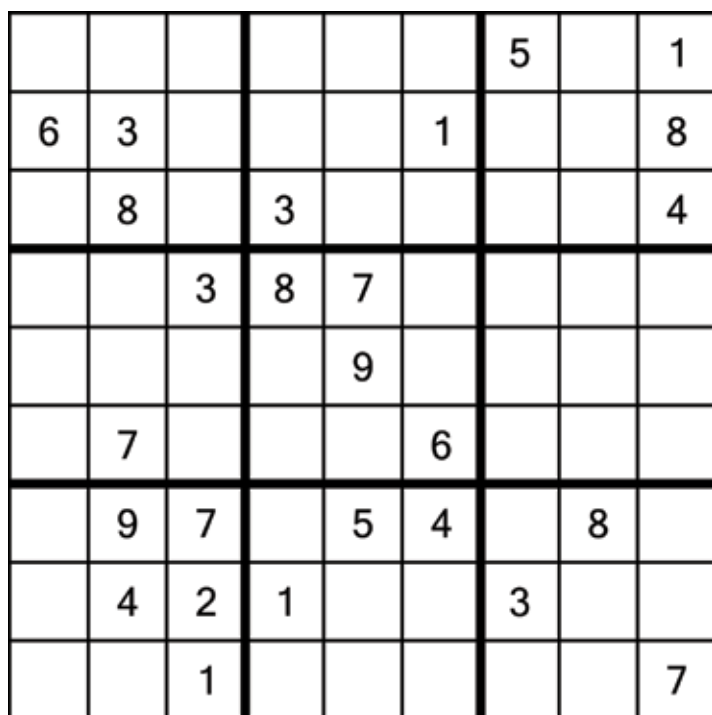
