the hero of her book.



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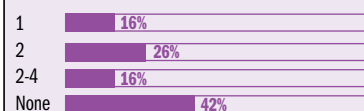

Baby proofing your house

If your toddler is just about to start crawling, or if he is taking the first steps, it means a lot of excitement, but it is time that they will have to be constantly monitored. They will climb on everything, pull things they can't reach, put things in their mouth and everything in between. Nothing beats constantly keeping an eye on the young ones, but a good way to avoid accidents is by baby proofing your house.



Gates, latches and switches

- Install gates at places that you don't want your baby to enter like before the stairs.
- Put safety covers over all electric switch boards so that the baby doesn't pull out plugs.
- Install baby proof latches over main electricity points, swing doors and other hazardous points.

Poisoning

- One of the most hazardous probabilities is poisoning as babies put everything they see in their mouth. Keep your floor sanitised at all instances, so that it is germ free.
- Put tight lids on foodstuffs, kitchen items, cleaners and other household things.

- Stow all the furniture next to the wall so that the baby cannot bump into it and injure himself.

What does the fairy tale mean to you?

This is such a special story to me because I love talking about love, I love trying to understand love, I love trying to apply love in my life and this fairy tale is really all about what true love is. Belle didn't want to spend any time with Gaston because she could see how this person is on the inside whereas with the Beast, he's got this frightening exterior but on the inside has a loving personality. Belle is amazing because she can see through this and can really see the beauty in everybody. This really is such a crucial message for everyone of what love is.

What is it like enacting such larger than life characters?

It's pretty crazy to be honest. It's actually quite amazing because I'm just trying to make the Beast as human as I can despite all the costume and hair and makeup. I really try to humanise the Beast so

the audience can relate to him and the emotions that he's feeling.

Stage is so much more different than film or television. What is the experience like of performing live?

The cool thing about going to see a live performance is that it's actually happening right there in front of you whereas with a movie you can watch it 1,000 times and it's going to be exactly the same. Live performances are something really special because we actually get to experience the story with the audience so in every place that we've been to it's been an amazing experience to kind of have this living and breathing experience with the audience and they react that way because they are invested in it as well. I've seen people leap to their seats because they just love the show so much and I've heard some people say they didn't want it to end so it's really amazing. On top of that one of my favourite things is that I remember having four generations of one family - the great-grandmother,

How do you prepare for a character?

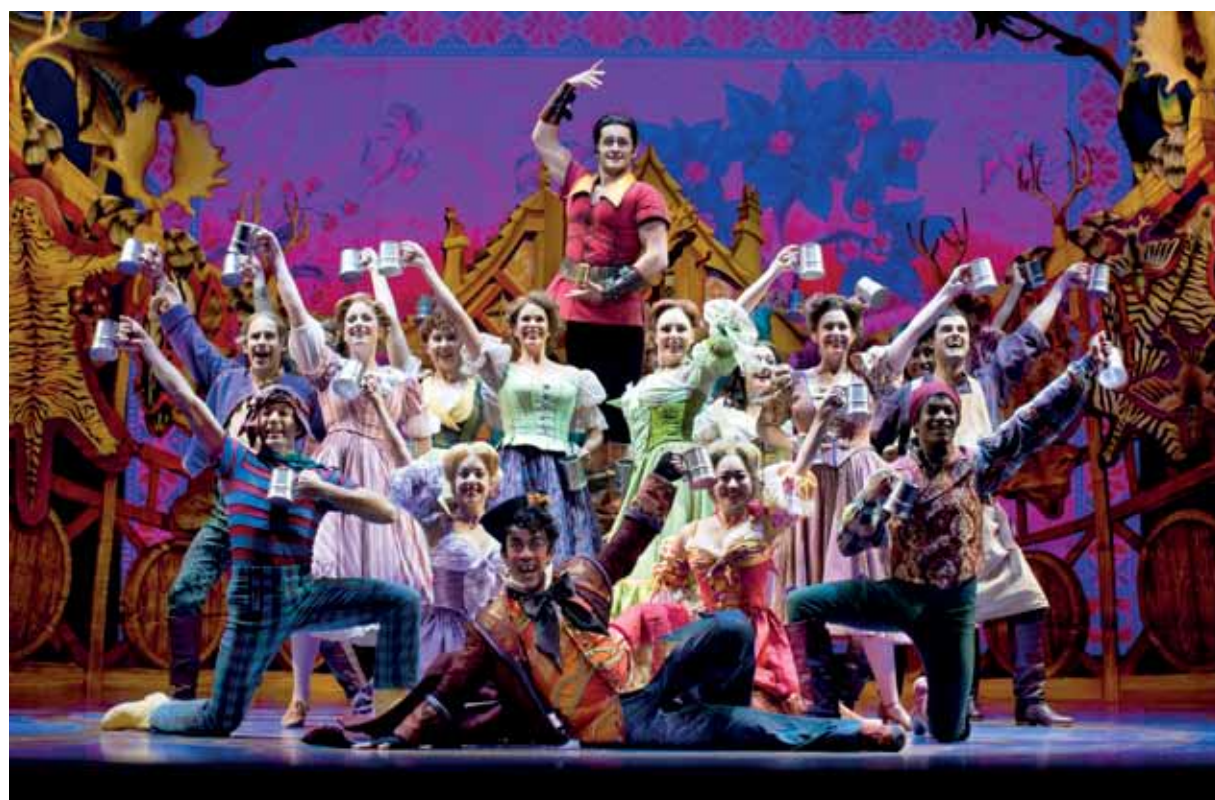

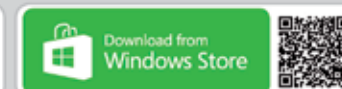
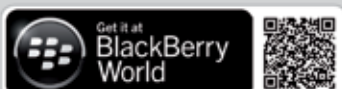

"There's a lot of familiar faces still here and plenty of talent coming through," said Denly.



Pavey targets further success



Jo Pavey aims for a fifth Olympic despite shelving thoughts of retirements at the age of nearly 43. The Englishwoman became the oldest woman to win gold at a European Championship with her 10,000m victory.

"I would just love to run in my fifth Olympics at Rio in 2016, and hopefully perform well," said Pavey. She has recently stated that she plans to continue concentrating on the track events. "Next year I'd like to qualify for the World Championship in Beijing in the 5,000m or 10,000m, and my long-term thoughts are getting to Rio." The 41-year-old hopes there could still be more to celebrate at major championships in the future.



McIlroy faces court

Rory McIlroy will face a break from Golf in order to prepare for a court case early next year. Attempts at a resolution due to a contractual dispute between lawyers representing McIlroy and his former management company 'Horizon' has failed, with the legal battle now poised for the courts.

"I'm going to need time away from tournament golf to prepare for the trial over my legal dispute with Horizon Sports Management," the Northern Irishman said.

The hearing is expected to take place in February, making McIlroy withdraw from two events in Shanghai, the BMW Masters and World Golf Championship HSBC Champions tournament.

Nico Rosberg has admitted that he must start winning again if he wishes to overcome Lewis Hamilton in the title race. The German failed to stand atop the podium since his home race at Hockenheim back in July, thus allowing Hamilton to hold a 17 point deficit after the Russian GP.

"I just know I need to go out and win races now and see how it goes," Rosberg said. He has previously led this season for quite some time, making him the hunter in the title fight. "I don't feel like I'm being the hunted, I feel like I'm hunting. I'm hunting for the championship. There are three races to go and a lot of points still to get, so I need to get them," he declared.

At a first glance, the Electric Bubbegum looks pretty similar to any other skateboard, but more compact and streamlined. 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Public Transport Day prizes top the Dh1 million mark

Transport Week to benefit mass transit users in Dubai with a programme that consists of contests and events.

The Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) is offering a bonanza of prizes to public transport riders as part of the fifth edition of Public Transport Day which will be observed on November 1. Events will be kicked off by a draw for prizes on October 26 and roll on till the date of the event. About 4kg of gold will be distributed to winners over the week along with complimentary Nol cards and other gift items," he added.

"The Public Transport Day event this year requires all public transport users to configure their gold and silver Nol cards by registering their numbers through the RTA's public transport app on smartphones or using their personalised blue Nol cards to qualify for winning various prizes offered during daily draws. The Transport Week comprises a host of week-long events and programmes

including basketball matches hosting the American star Karim Abdul Jabbar. This event will be run at Al Ghubaiba bus station for one day only from 9am to 6pm on November 1," said Al Ali.

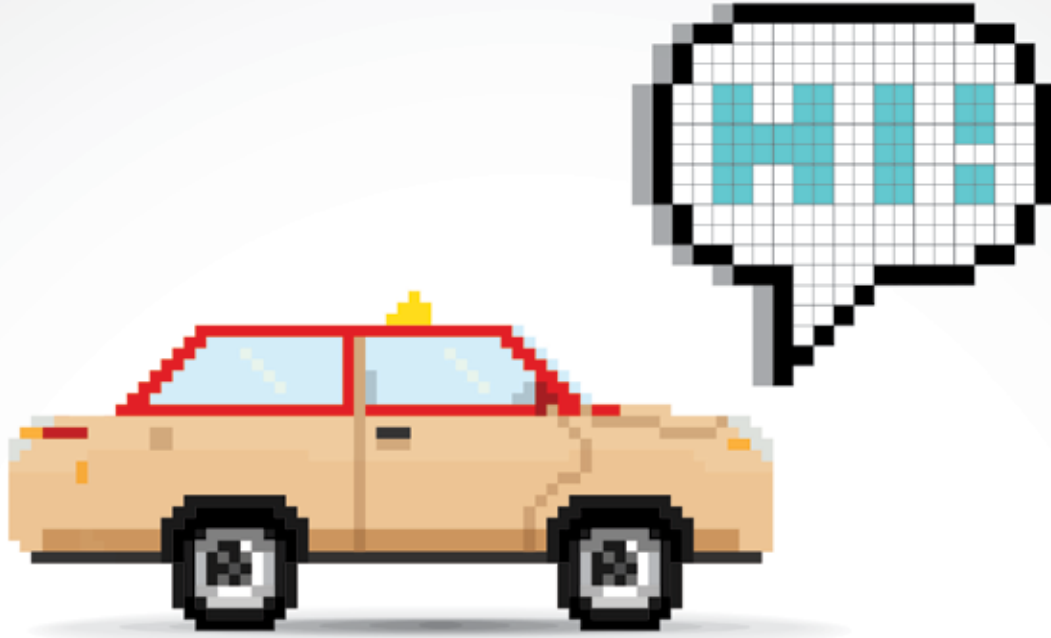
"The Electronic Bikes contest will be staged during the week at several metro stations namely: BurJuman, Al Ghubaiba, Al Fahidi, and Mall of the Emirates stations, as well as Al Satwa and Al Ghubaiba bus stations, and Al Ghubaiba marine station, from 8am to 8pm. A variety of other events and contests oriented to families and children will be staged to encourage students in Dubai schools to visit the festivities venue at Al Ghubaiba bus

station throughout the week. Events in place include juggling, face painting, handicrafts and cartoons among others," said Al Ali.

"Questionnaires were distributed among mass transit users to get their preferred events during the Public Transport Day and where it became evident that conducting medical checkups was ranked high amongst their priorities. Medical checkups therefore, will run at the Union, Terminal 3, and Healthcare City metro stations throughout the week. Blood donation events will be coordinated with Dubai Health Authority and will be held at Al Ghubaiba bus station on October 31

and November 1," he further added.

"The Public Transport Day initiative aims to showcase the role of Dubai in supporting efforts aimed at improving the environment, achieving sustainable development, encouraging and educating the public about the benefits of using public transit means in order to increase their ridership, and promoting the RTA's modern public transport means spanning the metro, buses and marine transit modes. The initiative also aims to enhance the integration between various transit modes and boost the leading role of the emirate in general and the RTA in particular in uplifting public transport," said Al Ali.

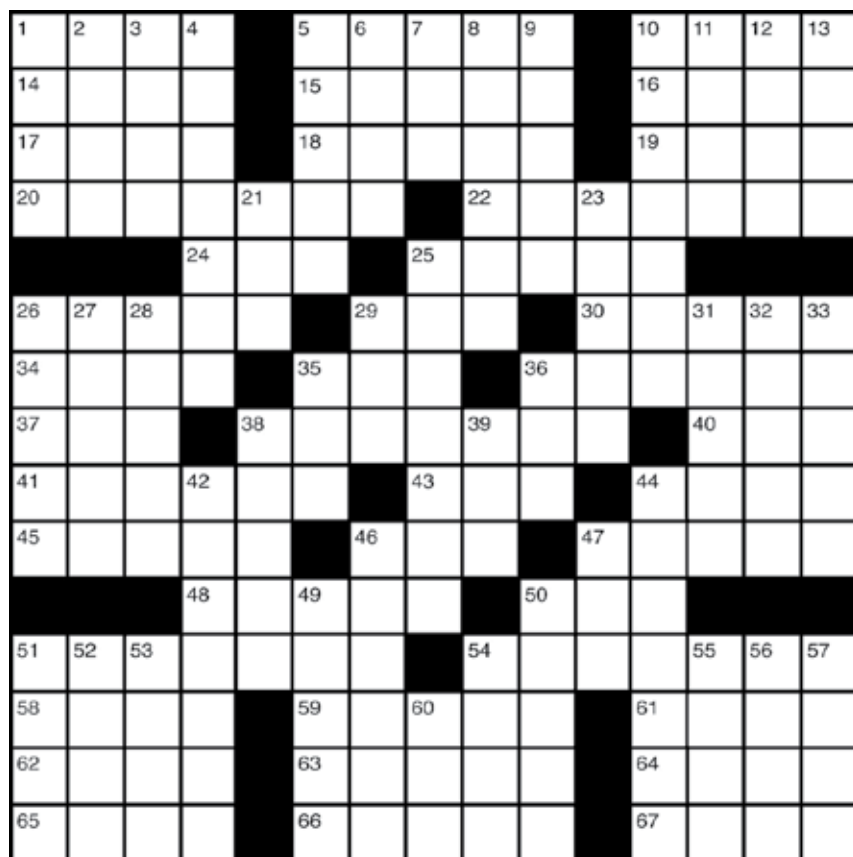

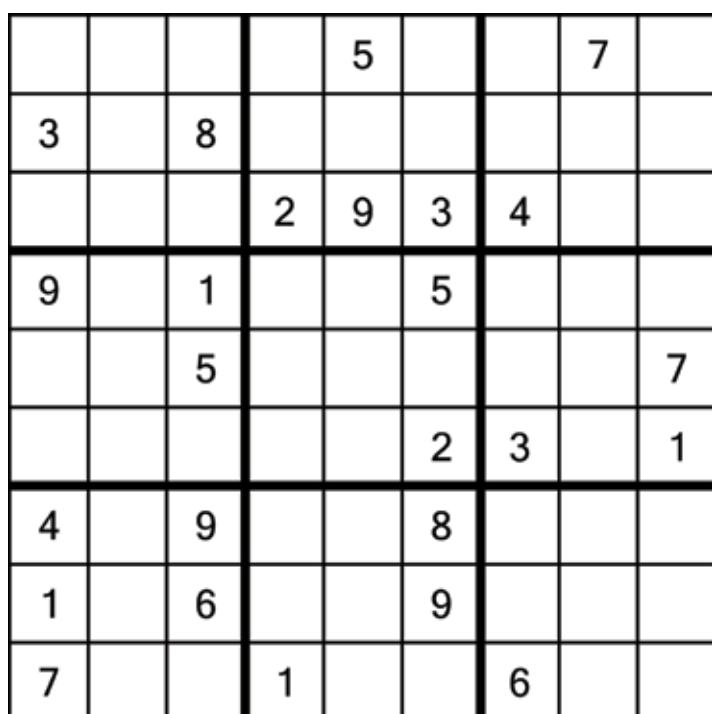
