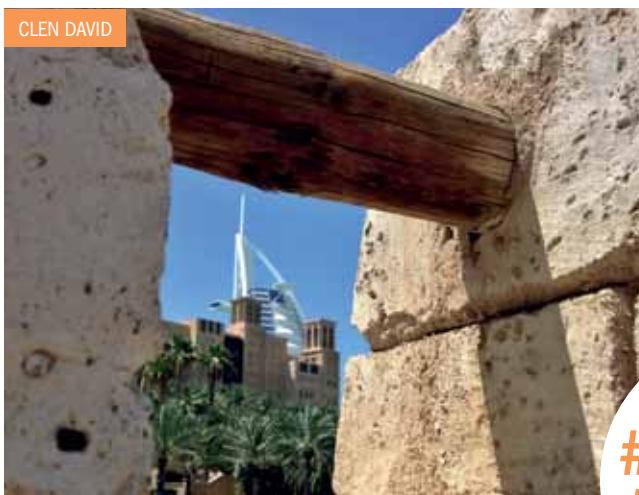

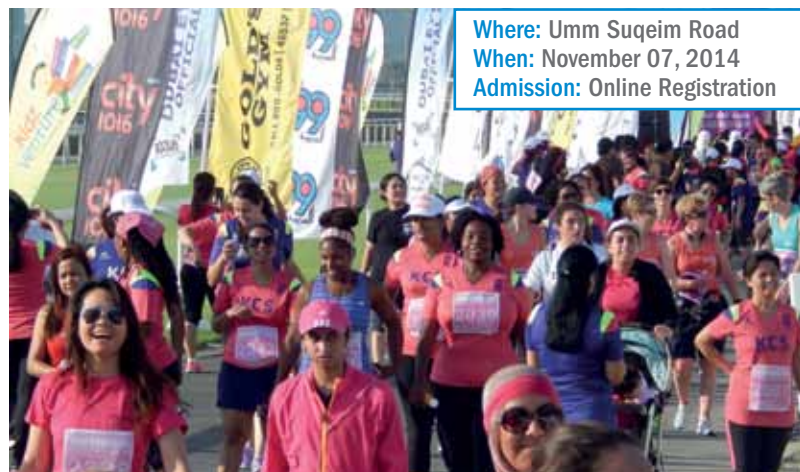

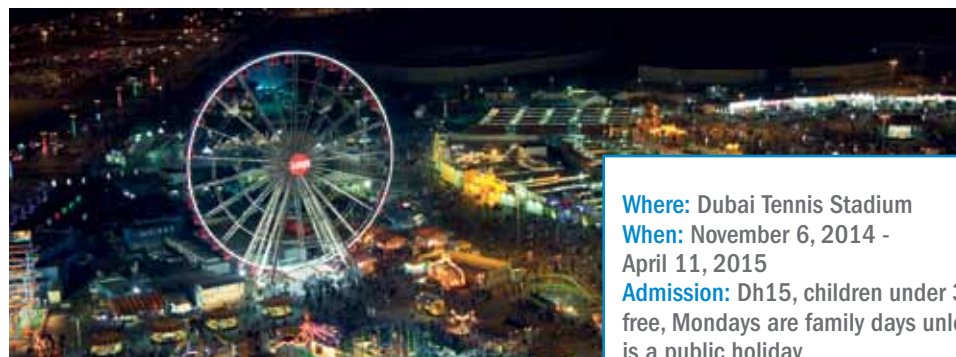

VIEW OVER OLD TOWN LISBON

Caressing the city of seven hills

The end of the year is just around the corner, making it the perfect time for you to escape on a journey. A trip to the Portuguese capital is perhaps the right way to end your year. Lisbon offers all the delights you'd expect of Portugal's star attraction. From gothic cathedrals to majestic monasteries to quaint museums, the colourful cityscape boasts a superb natural setting. Set your mind free and escape to the charming visual time-warp. There is so much to do in Lisbon you might plan for a week.

There's probably so many places you want to visit, but a good place to start with is the Praça do Comércio, with its grand 18th-century arcades, lemon-meringue facades and mosaic cobbles. This stylish area is one of the biggest squares in Europe, and often displays beautiful works of art and sculpture. The Praça do Comércio feels like the gateway to Lisbon, thronging with activity and rattling trams. At the centre of the square you can find the dashing equestrian statue of Dom José I. It simply is a great place for a leisurely stroll.

MOSTERIO DOS JERONIMOS

The next place you can go to is the Mosteiro dos Jerónimos, which is a Unesco-listed monastery. This mosteiro is a heart-stealer that offers pure fantasy, and a fusion of Diogo de Boitaca's creative vision. You can see three trunk-like columns that grow into the ceiling once you enter the church through the western portal. Its beautiful windows cast a soft golden light over the church. And what's even nicer is the moment you walk into the honey-stone Manueline cloisters, as they drip with organic detail in their delicately scalloped arches. If you move to the upper choir, you can experience a superb view of the church.

You can end your wonderful journey by finally visiting the Ancient Art National Museum. This museum contains one of the city's richest collections of artifacts. You will see paintings, jewellery, ceramics, furniture, sketches and engravings. These items mainly represent the period between the 12th and 19th century. If by any chance you feel lost by its beauty, you can join the tour guide service that can cater to special interest groups.

Get the shot

5 killer mistakes to avoid at the workplace

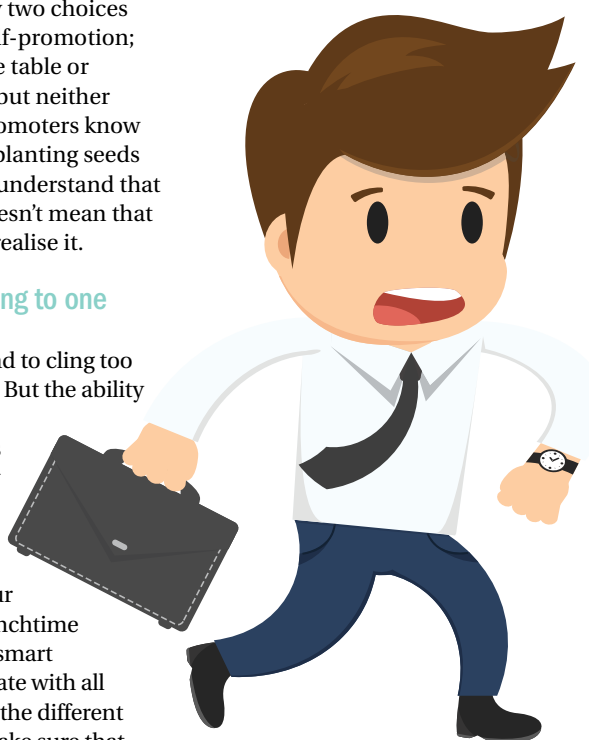

Bernie Ecclestone has assured that Marussia will not take part in the Austin event as he claims "Neither of those two teams is going to go to America."



FIFA Ballon d'Or

Nominees



Five players from Premier League have been nominated for the FIFA Ballon d'Or award on the 23-man shortlist, with Luis Suarez excluded. Premier League leaders Chelsea have a strong presence among the names, including Belgium goalkeeper Thibaut Courtois, Spain's Diego Costa, and Eden Hazard. The Red Devils also play a role in the list, with Argentina's Angel di Maria. Whereas Manchester City's Yaya Toure has also been nominated.

Lionel Messi, the most awarded player in history winning four Ballon d'Or trophies, represents Barcelona alongside Neymar Jr, Javier Mascherano and Andres Iniesta, however Suarez was not chosen amongst them. Last year's winner Cristiano Ronaldo is earmarked as the favourite once again and leads six Real Madrid players in the list, including Gareth Bale, Karim Benzema, Toni Kroos, Sergio Ramos and James Rodriguez.

As for the German players, the list includes Thomas Muller, Manuel Neuer, Bastian Schweinsteiger and Mario Gotze. The list is concluded with Sweden's Zlatan Ibrahimovic, Paul Pogba, and Arjen Robben.

Going through

Andy Murray is inspired by his great win over Tommy Robredo in the Valencia Open final. The British No1 has said that the victory filled him with confidence for the challenges ahead. This win moved Murray to fifth in the race to the ATP World Tour Finals in London.

"I kept fighting and it stands me in good stead for the end of this year and the beginning of next," he declared. Murray's third title in five weeks followed a rollercoaster match that lasted longer than any other ATP tour final this year. Murray now expects a better journey ahead following this victory. "When you have to work hard for something it means more, you get more satisfaction from it."

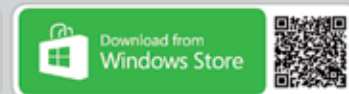
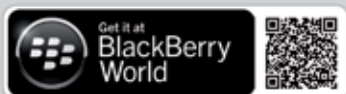

A plunge for LEUKAEMIA

Bashar Al Hussaini talks to Read about his 'Skydive for a Cure Campaign'

Bashar Al Hussaini is a 34 year old Iraqi-Canadian who was born in Abu Dhabi. Having his father pass away due to leukaemia at a young age of 11, he comes back to Dubai and starts the 'Skydive for a Cure Campaign' which aims to promote awareness and strives to collect donations for further treatment research. On November 14 he is scheduled to do his first ever skydive at Skydive Dubai to mark the end of the campaign.

Is there a particular reason for you in choosing skydiving to forward your cause?

Jumping 13,000ft from a moving plane is not a simple thing for me – luckily I have avoided thinking about it so far and only focused on

the campaign itself. In addition to grabbing attention as a novel way to raise funds, I thought it was a fitting personal challenge that forces me to face a fear of mine (heights); something which I think relates to those who are affected by leukaemia in which they deal with fear and significant challenges daily.

Do you have any other fears you would want to conquer?

I think the fear here is really about the unknown and those with leukaemia, unfortunately have no other choice but to face those fears. Whatever fears I have are of control and can easily be avoided or can be overcome (such as jumping off a plane) and these things seem trivial in comparison. Most of my fears

include things that are not of my control, such as family and friends being safe and healthy.

How is the campaign a tribute for your father?

I was about 11 years old when my father passed away from leukaemia; it was a difficult time for my family. We had a close relationship but since he had been sick with leukaemia for years, he was not able to do many of the father-son activities as he would have probably wanted, but he did his best - and my mother was strong enough to raise my brother and me in such a difficult situation. At the time, support was limited and awareness of the disease was too, I certainly did not appreciate what was happening to my father before

my eyes, and despite my young age I did not take the time to research or understand what he was going through. This campaign helps bring this to light and awareness includes understanding the daily challenges of those affected and hopefully understand how we can ease these challenges, which sadly I did not attempt to do or try to appreciate back when my father was still around.

What are your hopes and expectations from 'Skydive for a Cure Campaign'?

My 'Skydive for a Cure Campaign' has three goals in mind; firstly it is intended to bring leukaemia to light as a disease that affects many people. With awareness comes appreciation of the pain people and their family go through who has been diagnosed with this disease, having the knowledge and empathy would make a world of difference to those coping and their loved ones who are battling the disease daily. Secondly, the donation raised by the disease will go towards the 'The Leukaemia and Lymphoma Society of Canada' (LLSC) - unfortunately no such organisation exists in the UAE or the region. The LLSC organisation is a non-profit organisation that supports research for the cure and awareness of the disease. Thirdly I hope, that through ongoing efforts to facilitate or start a discussion, which will perhaps be a start to establish such a society here in the UAE that will be a boon for those affected not only here, but the region as a whole. It will form a focal point to provide emotional, informative, and financial support to help battle the disease and support those affected by it. This will be the ongoing and ultimate goal of the campaign with –hopefully– an annual fundraising campaign to support such an effort.

Tell us more about the current leukaemia centres and treatments being offered in the UAE and what they lack?

I think as the UAE develops so do the concepts of raising awareness of diseases and possible prevention, volunteering and charity work. I think there is a lot of good work taking place in the UAE such as 'Friends of Cancer in Sharjah', however it is non-specific to leukaemia and lymphoma which is often forgotten. However what makes leukaemia such an important disease to understand is because of its indiscriminate nature that has no regards to race, gender, age, or family history. I do think that starting an LLS chapter in the UAE would be a boon for the UAE and the region as a whole acting as a resource and support centre for the Middle East complimented by a bone marrow database to increase finding a match to patients. Bone Marrow transplant match registries are non-existent which is detrimental in finding potentially time sensitive solutions to those affected, particularly Emiratis or those from the Middle East which are more likely to find matches in their geographical origins than in any other part of the world. By establishing a Leukaemia and Lymphoma Society here in the UAE, that can perhaps work with other LLS centres around the world such as Canada, US, or the UK in order to make resources available and provide better support to patients in this region. Hopefully this campaign is just the beginning.

Why donate money to LLSC?

The Leukaemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada (LLSC) is a voluntary health agency dedicated to blood cancer. LLSC funds lifesaving blood cancer research across Canada and provides free information and support services. Its mission is to cure leukaemia, lymphoma, hodgkin's disease and myeloma, and improve the quality of life of the patients and their families.

How does LLSC work?

LLSC funds promising researchers at leading cancer centres and universities; and since LLSC has no campus or laboratories to maintain, the donation funds more research and have less overhead than a donation made elsewhere. It takes about eight years to develop a successful new drug, so now is the time to invest in new therapies.

What do you have to say to the families of leukaemia patients to help them cope with it?

It is very hard to say anything to such families as each person is different in how they react and

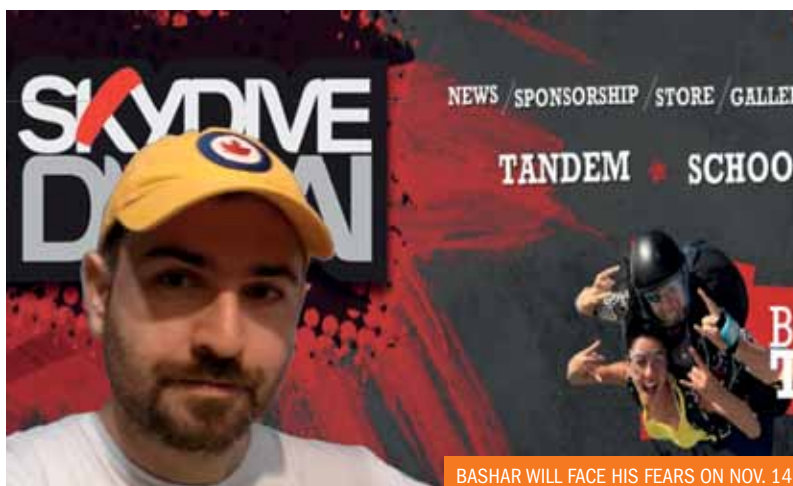

how the disease affects their lives. I don't think families affected should be preached to, on the contrary we should be listening to their experiences and have them tell us how we can support them on their daily challenges in dealing with this disease. I can however say that generally, I am optimistic that a cure can be found and I hope with the generous donations, this campaign will contribute to such a cure. Due to the random nature of this disease anyone can be at risk, which makes this such a tragedy. I hope through support and efforts that LLS is established in the UAE to act as a regional go-to-point to patients, their families and researchers in battling this disease.

What can we expect from you in the future?

Donations will be collected until my skydive is completed on Friday, November 14th hopefully to celebrate in meeting our intended financial goal of \$10,000 donation to the LLSC. I hope that if enough support and interest is shown that this be taken further to look into establishing an LLS here in the UAE. This will require ongoing discussions with authorities and the medical community to make it a reality. I think at the least a bone marrow registry should be established with annual events to encourage people to sign up to the registry here in the UAE to increase the possibilities of a match for patients residing in the UAE.

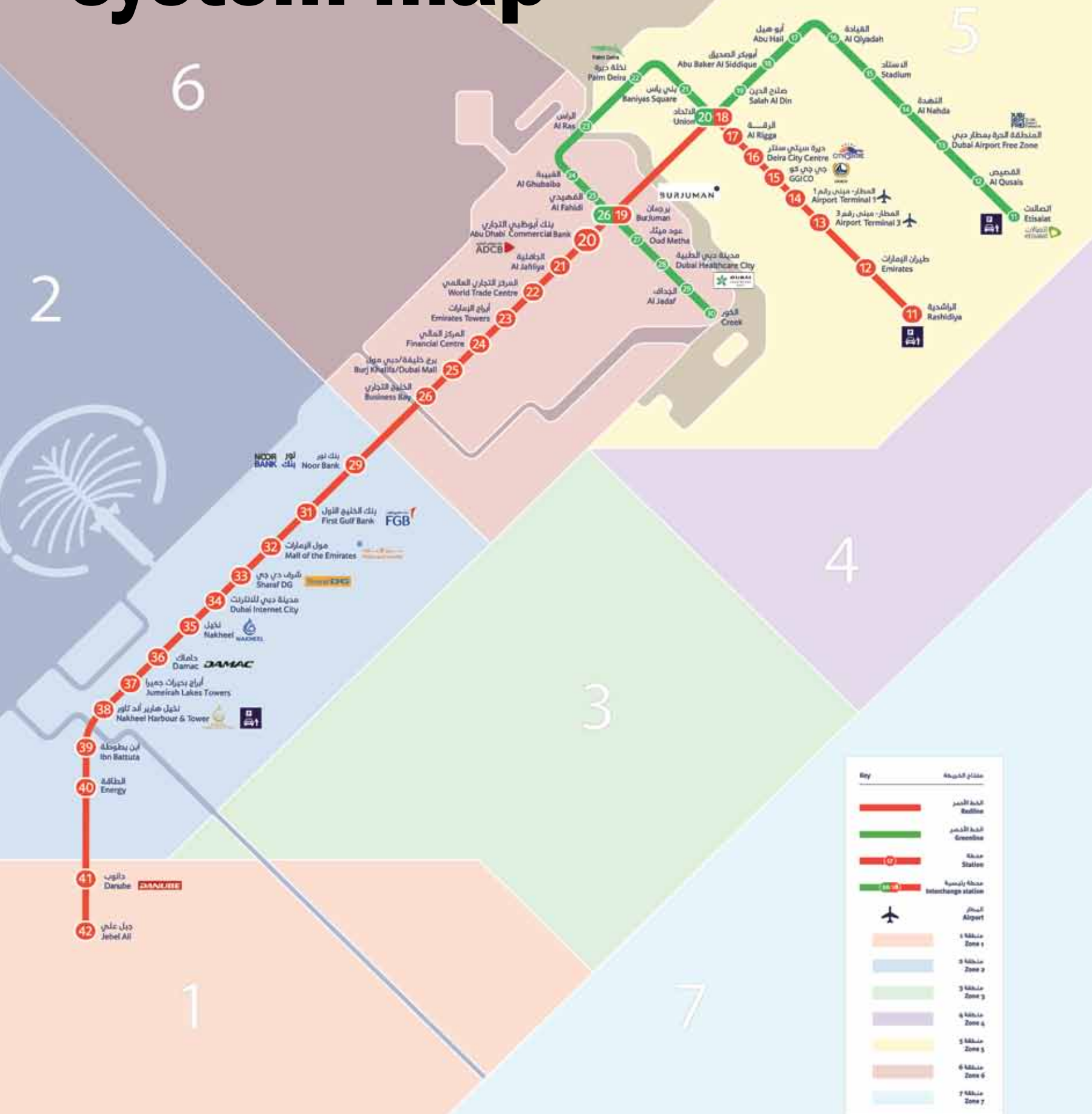

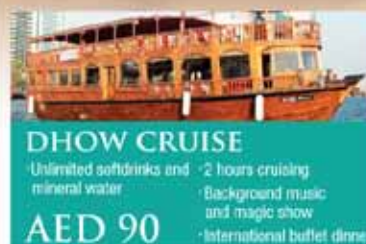

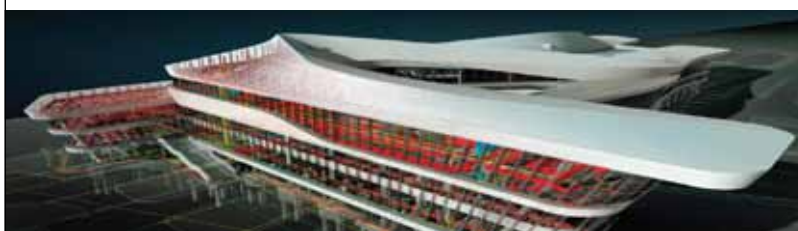
