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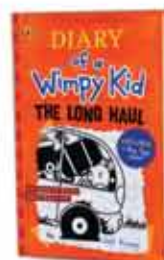
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WINTER glow

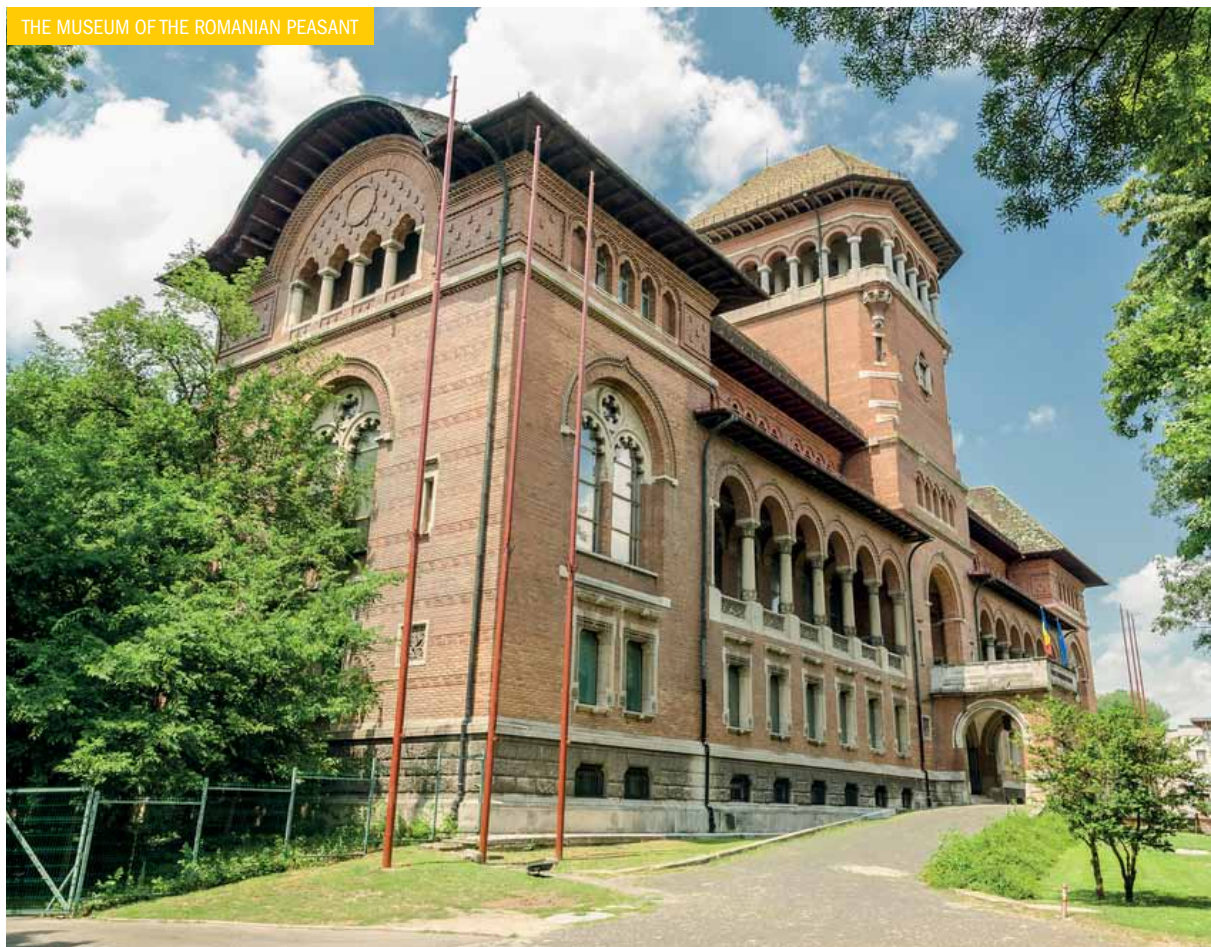

'Voronet Blue'. The monastery boasts marvelous paintings, like "The Last Judgement" which covers the exterior wall. You can find the Heaven and Garden of Eden on the bottom left. This place is well worth the visit to enhance some historical knowledge.

Moving on, you should visit the Museum of the Romanian Peasant, one of the best museums in Bucharest, featuring a collection of traditional peasant bric-a-brac, costumes, icons, artwork and partially restored houses and churches. If you go downstairs you can find the jarring communism exhibition, which focuses on the Ceausescu-era program of land collectivization. Housed in a wonderful red brick building, the museum offers a range of exhibitions showing you all you need to know about the diverse and fascinating history of life around the Romanian countryside over the past four centuries.

Before you leave, make sure you visit the Herastrau Park – the biggest park in Bucharest, spread over 187 hectares around Herastrau lake, being the favourite of all the inhabitants of the capital and beyond. You're probably hungry but don't you worry, there are several restaurants around the park. The park includes a lot of attractions like boats to rent, an old style old village with numerous wood made buildings, terraces to take the sun in the summer, amazing space for children's activities riding bicycles and skates too.



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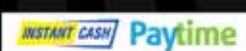

The 28-year-old, who won gold at the London Olympics 2012, began training again last month following the birth of her first child, and plans to start competing next summer.

The Englishwoman has claimed "The focus has shifted but I am still very determined and focused on my athletics. It's about training, putting the work in and seeing if I can get to Rio."

Lewis Hamilton has claimed that he is ready to win as he prepares for the finale in the Abu Dhabi Grand Prix. Hamilton has managed to hold the championship lead following his victory in Singapore, making him the title favourite as he holds a 17-point lead over Mercedes teammate Nico Rosberg.

The 29-year-old will clinch his second title if he comes in at least second place in the race. He last won back in 2008 thus he states "People talk about how long it's been since I won the title - but I honestly feel like I'm fighting for my first World Championship all over again."

Rory McIlroy is desperate to celebrate winning the European Tour's Race to Dubai by claiming the DP World Tour Championship finale. The Northern Irishman clinched the No 1 award in Europe after triumphing in the PGA Championship at Wentworth and the Open Championship at Hoylake, not to forget the US PGA Championship at Valhalla.

The 25-year-old stated "Regardless that I have won the Race to Dubai, I still want to play really well this week and try and win this tournament because there would be no point in me showing up if I felt that I had already won something and was just here for a good time."





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Amazon has recently unveiled a connected speaker that is controlled by voice, named Echo. 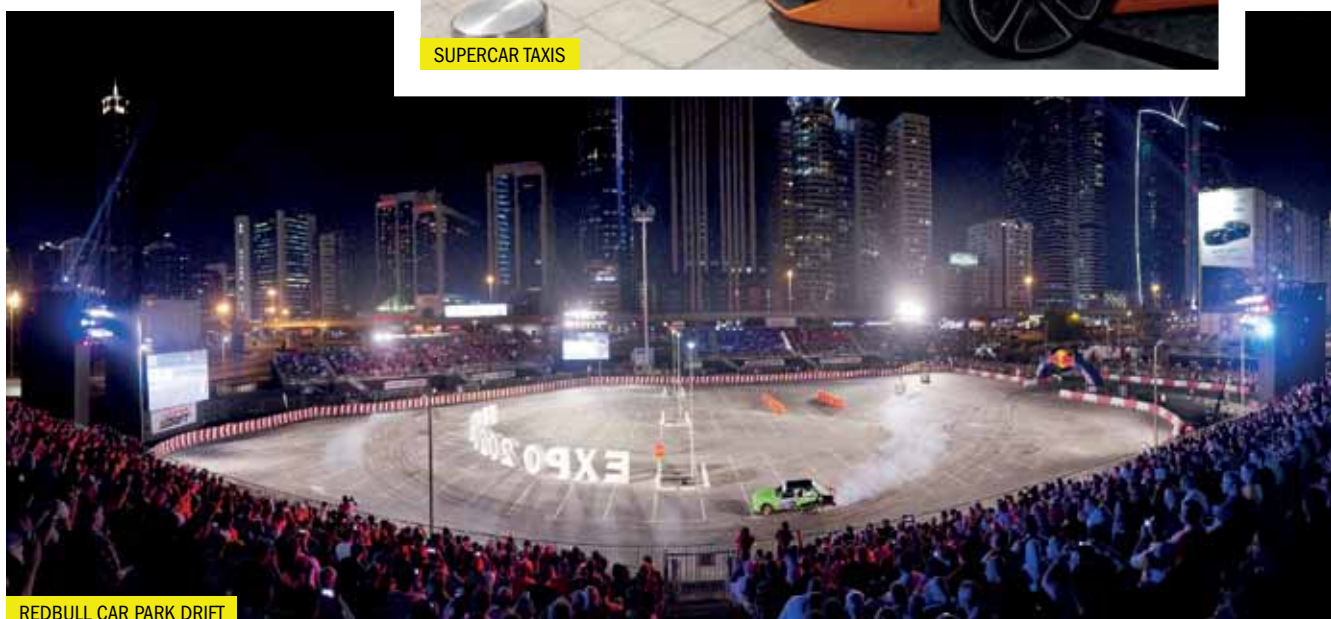

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Dubai Ferry gets smart tourist guide service

Nahaam system continuously displays information about key tourist landmarks en route as well as safety messages.

The Public Transport Agency, Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), has launched a smart tourist guide service billed as 'Nahaam' on board the Dubai Ferry, offering passengers a rich travelling experience with a commentary about tourist landmarks en route, adding to the excitement throughout the trip.

Dr Yousef Mohammed Al Ali, CEO of the Public Transport Agency, said: "The launch of this initiative adds to the smart service offering to various

spectrums of the community and responds to the wishes of Dubai Ferry riders, particularly tourists and visitors hailing from all corners of the globe.

"The smart tourist guide is a dedicated system displayed on board Dubai Ferry screens showcasing tourist landmarks of the emirate on the line of the trip using a GPS based display, enriched with promotional information and materials," said Al Ali.

"We have branded this initiative

as Nahaam; a name of an antique heritage practice once prevalent in the UAE where a person accompanying sailors plying the Arabian Gulf on pearl-fishing trips used to chant heritage songs that inspired, entertained and cheered up pearl fishers relegating the woes and risks associated with their profession. Pearl fishers in turn used to repeat the popular songs after the Nahaam.

"We, in the RTA, are keen on giving heritage-inspired names to the services we offer to the public as part

The Nahaam smart tourist system is a tablet computer fitted in the Dubai Ferry's captain's cabin and is linked with display monitors in the passen-



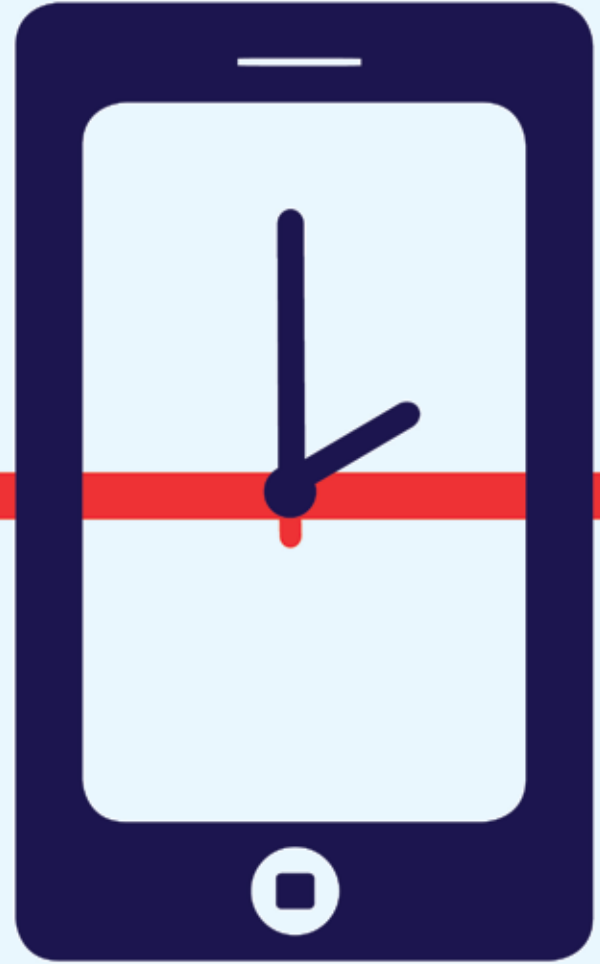

gers' cabin. At the start of a trip, the system displays a short movie about safety tips followed by a pictorial display of key tourist landmarks en route, accompanied by an audio commentary.

The system also displays information about scheduled Dubai Ferry trips, and between different landmarks the system displays a route map showing the current position of the ferry as is the case in airline trips. The system also displays other information about Dubai, the formation of the UAE federation, and Expo 2020, to avoid repetition during the trip back to the point of origin.

The Marine Transport Department, Public Transport Agency, has fitted four Dubai Ferry boats with the Nahaam system.

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Tips for acing your SKYPE interview

Whether the interview is taking place from home or at the office, the interviewer doesn't want to see empty pizza cartons in the background. Clean up your room as you want to avoid distracting the interviewer from what's more important, and that's you!



Dress for Success

Just because this is not a face to face interview, doesn't mean that you shouldn't treat it like one. Dress the way you normally would to a face to face interview. Psychologically, this will help you bring your best game to the table. One of the biggest mistakes that candidates make during a Skype interview is assuming that the bottom half of your outfit will be hidden under the desk and thus you end up looking polished from the top and unprofessional from the bottom.

But what if you dropped your pen and had to get up? Make sure that you look polished from head to toe. Don't forget to do some research on the company so you can determine how formal you need to be.

Be Prepared

A lot of us are camera shy, therefore your first video interviews can make you feel awkward. You might be confused about where to look; at the screen or directly into the camera. Try to make eye contact by looking

Use Notes

Saif Ali Khan on directing

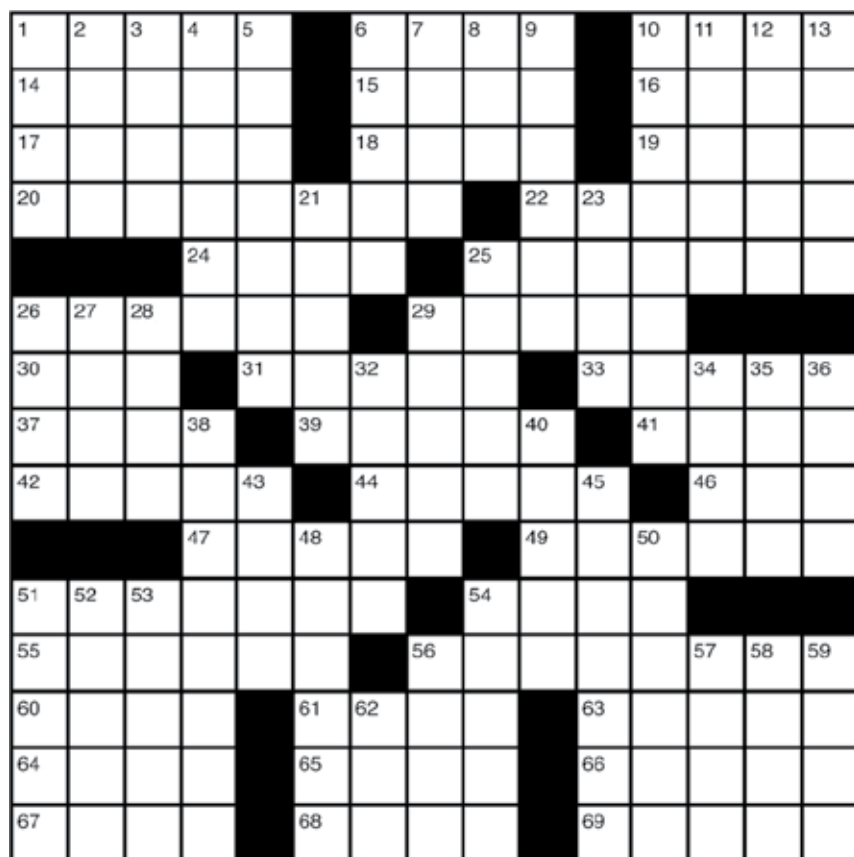

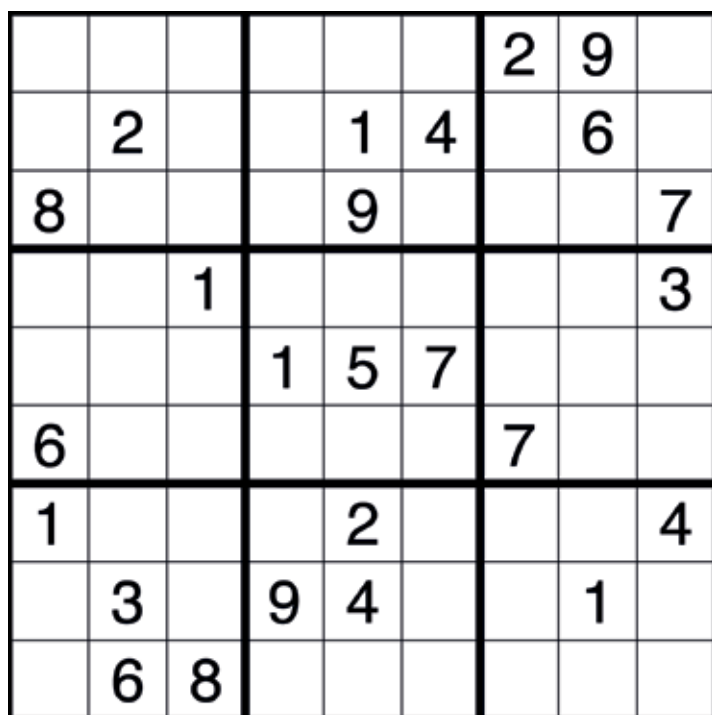

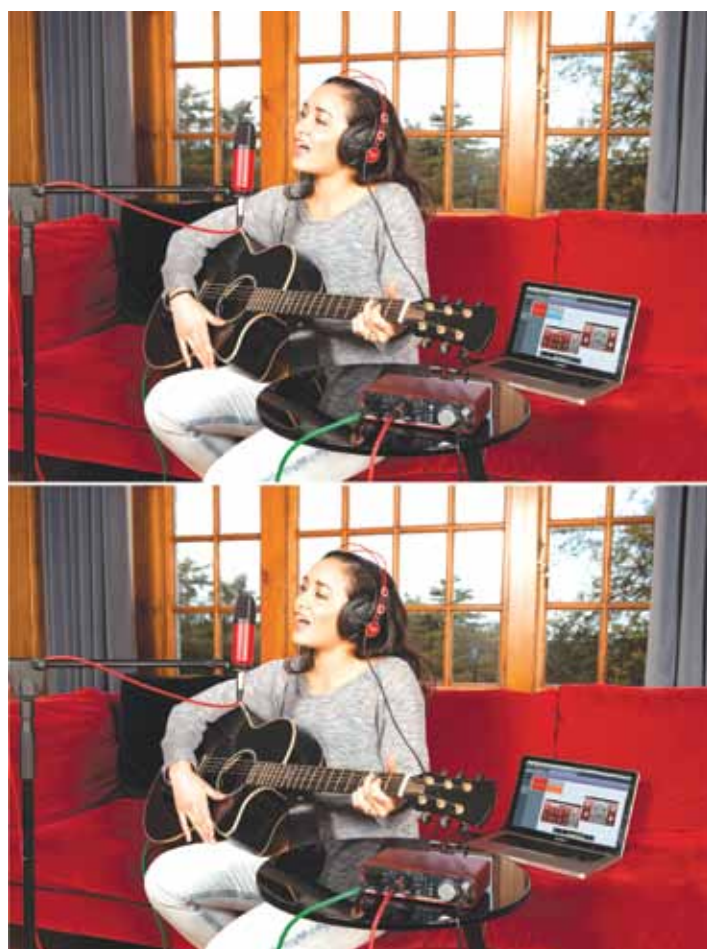
