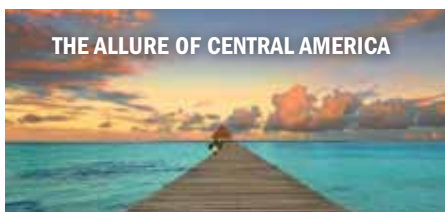

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Choosing the right CHRISTMAS tree

1,2,3... Here's a checklist for you to select the right tree that suits your style and your home space.

Festive season has begun now, and you have to be a part of it, in home decor, fashion, and in the usual traditions. It's time to start searching for the perfect Christmas tree as soon as the Christmas bells start to ring. But how do you make sure that you are buying the appropriate style of tree well suited for the space available in your house?

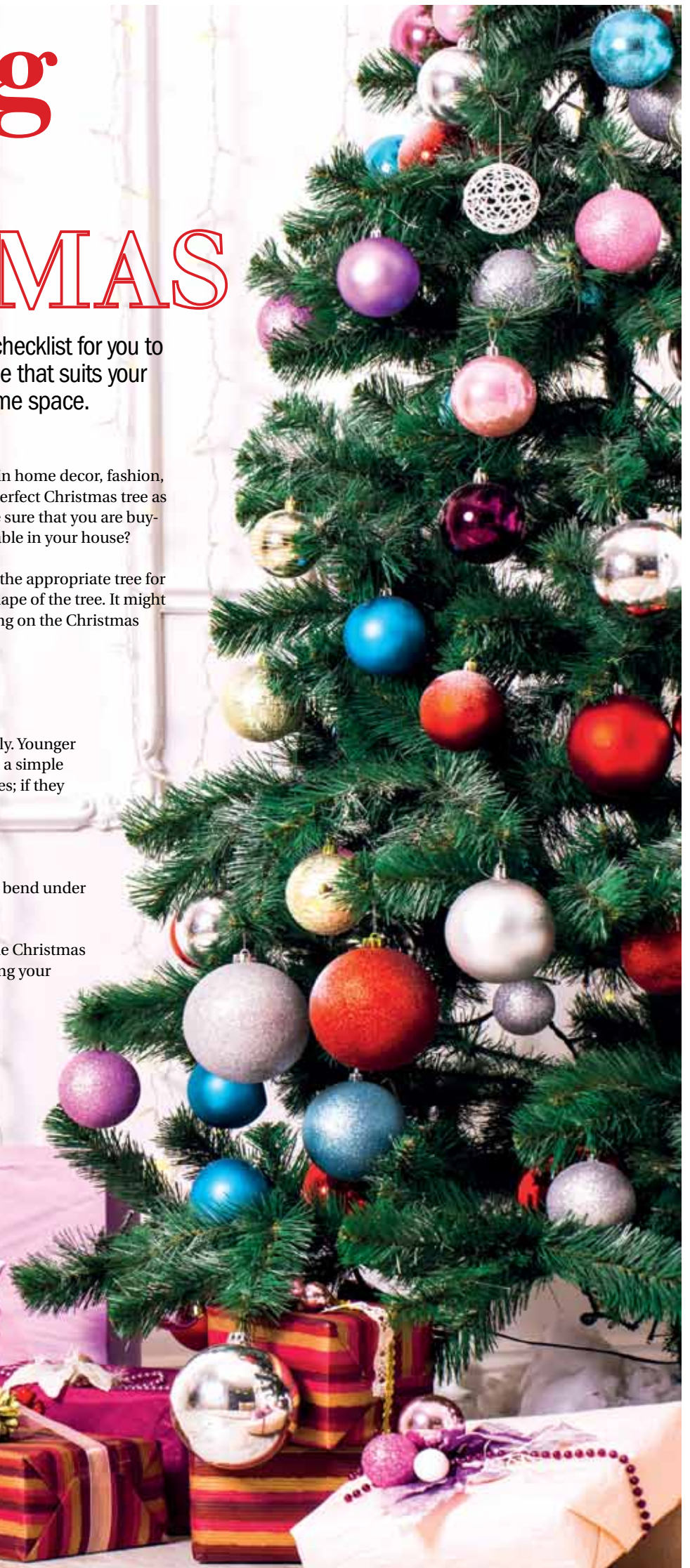
Start by writing down a list of specifications you require to get the appropriate tree for your home. Select your options regarding the freshness and shape of the tree. It might be useful to think twice before choosing a green tree, depending on the Christmas trend this year.

Freshness signs

1. Make sure the cut is straight so the tree will stand up properly. Younger looking trees tend to give a more upright appearance. Perform a simple test by rubbing your hand along a branch and the green needles; if they don't fall, it's the correct choice.
2. Check the sturdiness of the branches.
3. Avoid trees with long needles, because the branches tend to bend under the weight of even small ornaments.
4. Remember if you live in a very cold area, you have to pick the Christmas tree early on in the season as the ground freezes earlier reducing your chances to get a fresh tree easily.

Choosing the appropriate shape

1. Choose the height of the tree to suit the ceiling before you set off shopping.
2. Try to find symmetrical trees; you want it to look perfect from all sides.
3. Fir is an excellent choice if you are looking for a short tree with a smooth style, but Pines make very good Christmas trees if you are planning to throw a big party in a large room.

Share Your Concerns

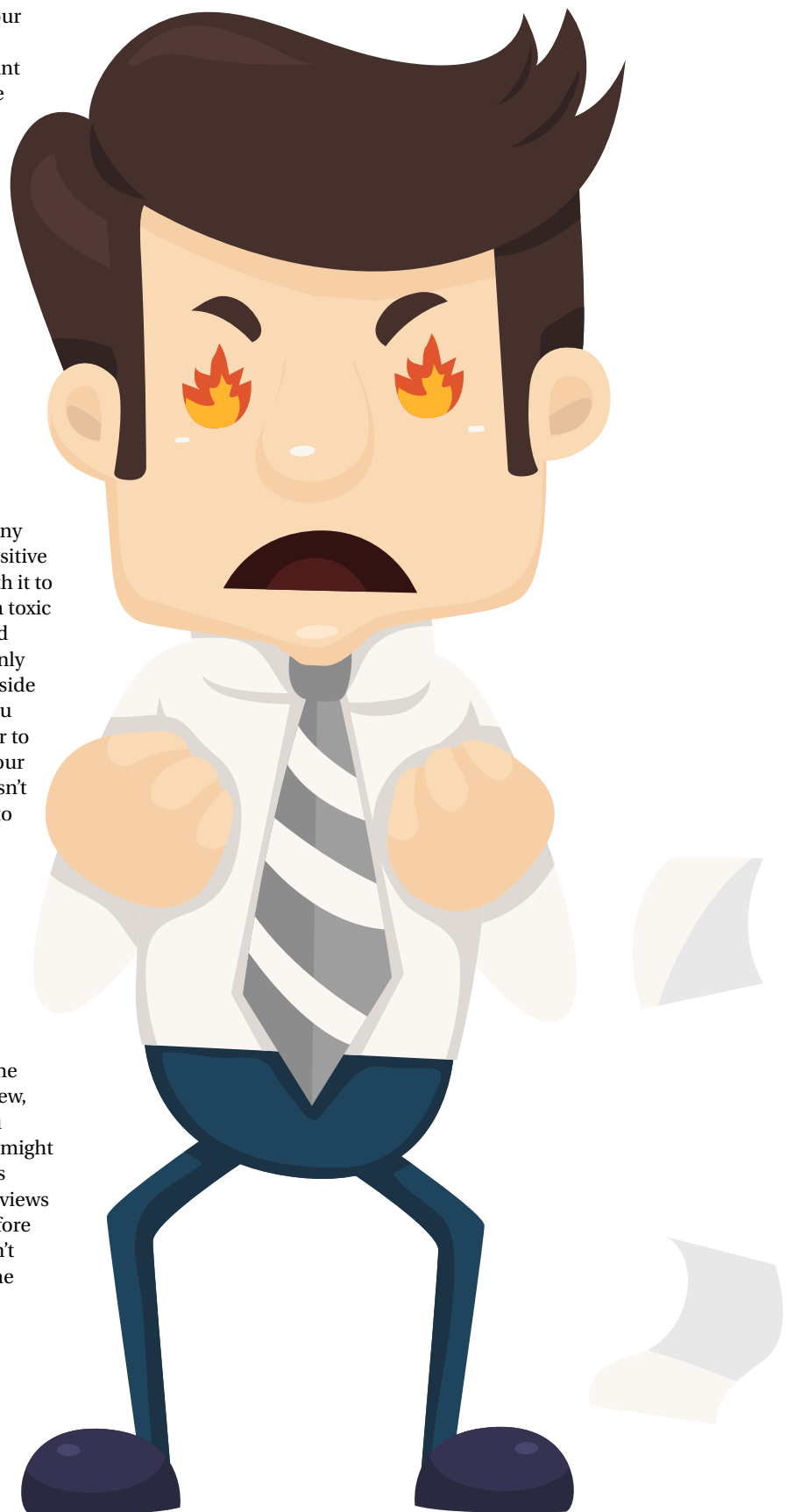
If you love your job but hate your boss, try sharing your concerns with him. Bottling up your feelings will only make you feel more stressed, leading to a spiral of anxiety. If

As for the exterior, the car looks much like a conventional Mercedes S-Class sedan. However this version has been extended by about 10 inches compared to the S-Class long-wheelbase version.

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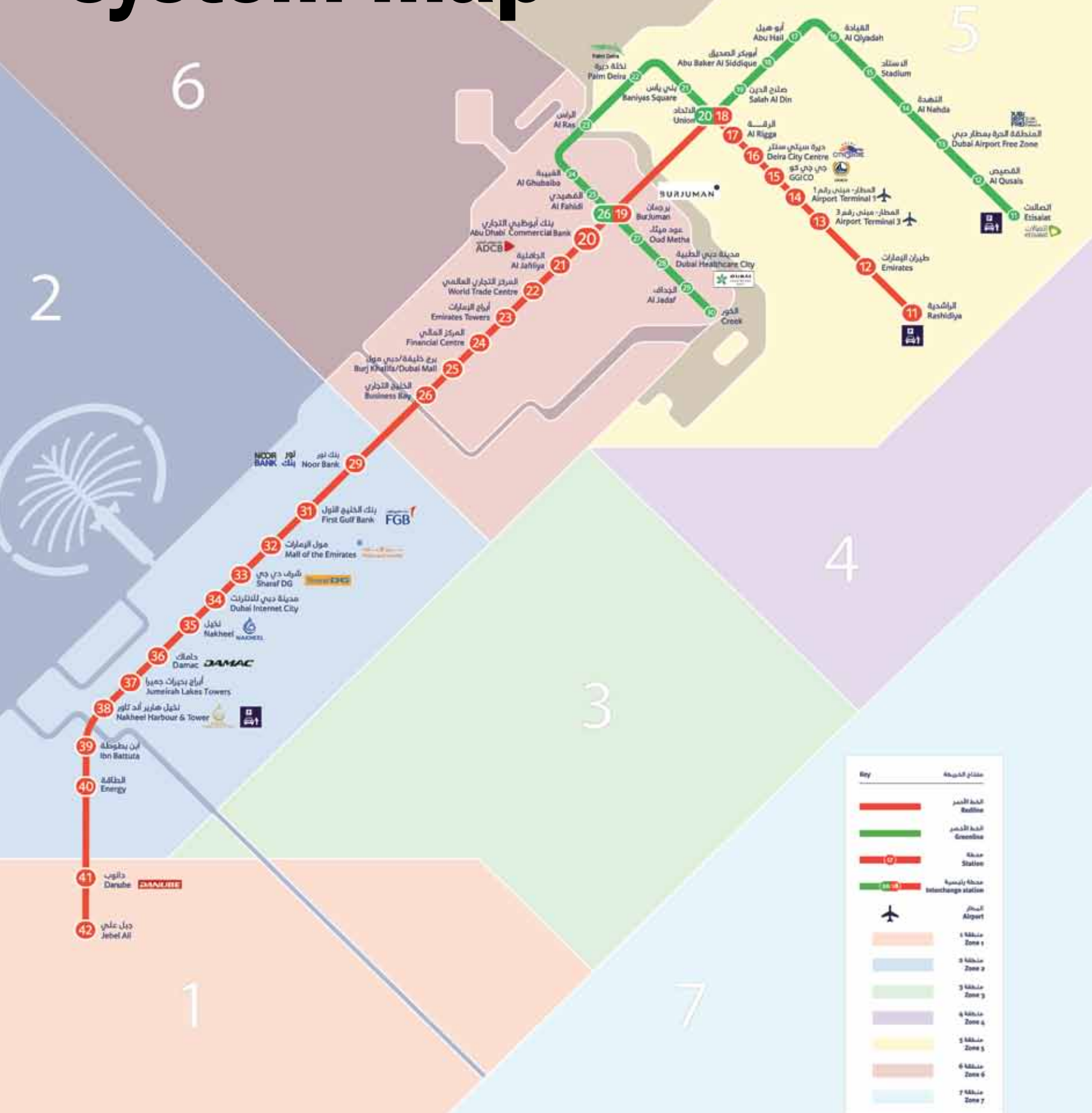

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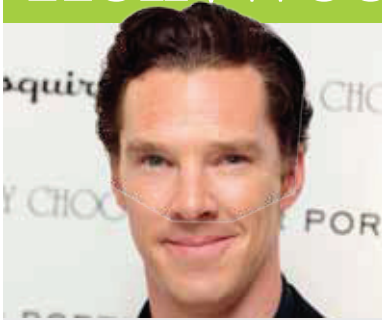

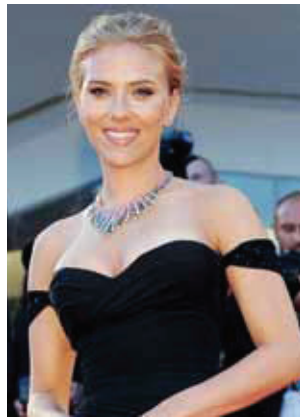


Benedict Cumberbatch will not leave *Sherlock*

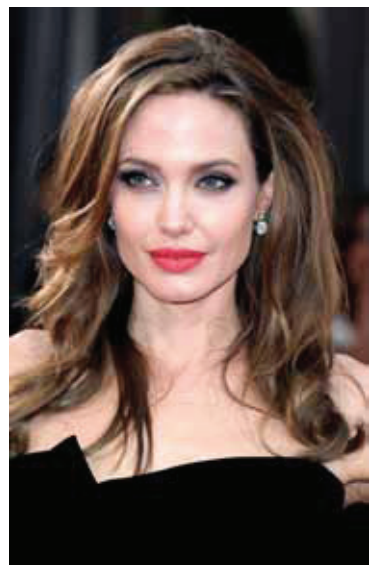
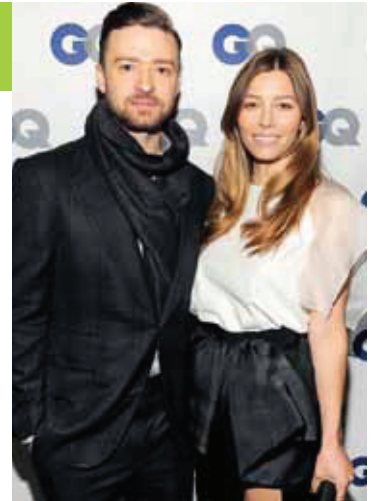
The Timberlakes to bid adieu Hollywood

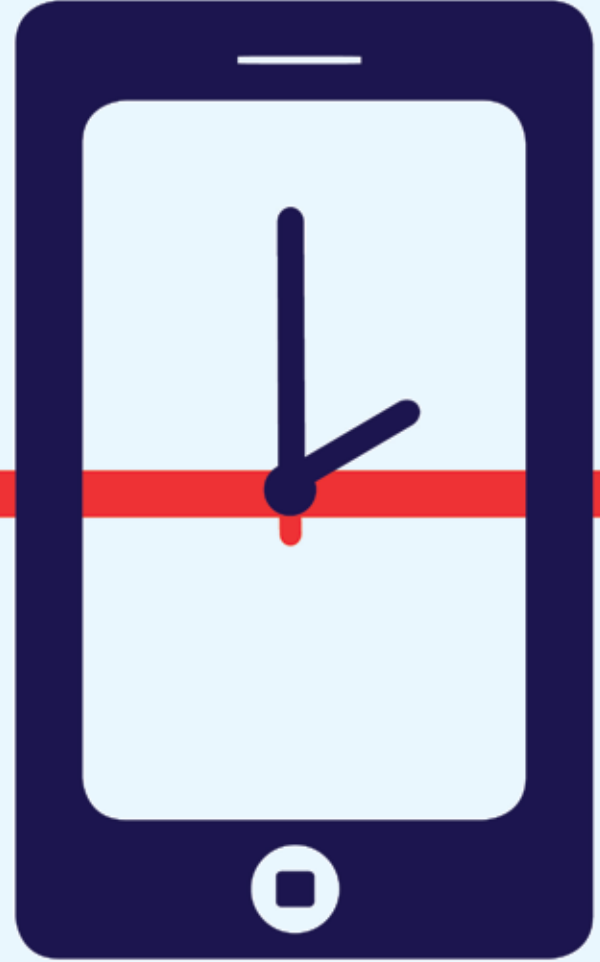

The two drivers, who have been friends since racing in karts together 14 years ago, said that they have no regrets whatsoever and that the season was an incredible experience.

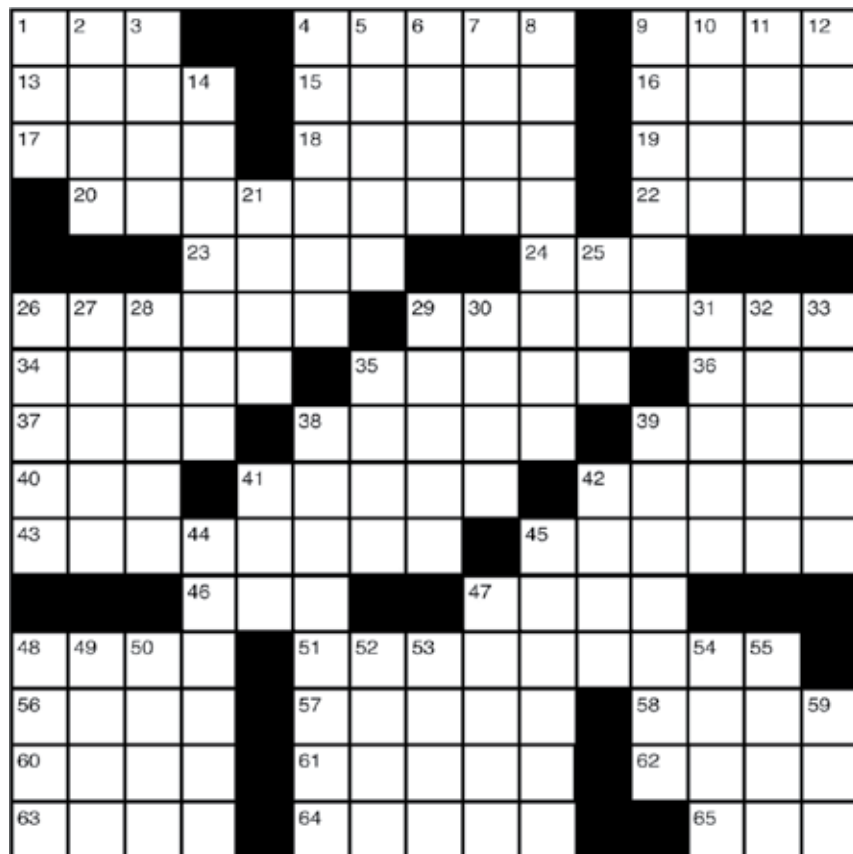


Ready to rumble
