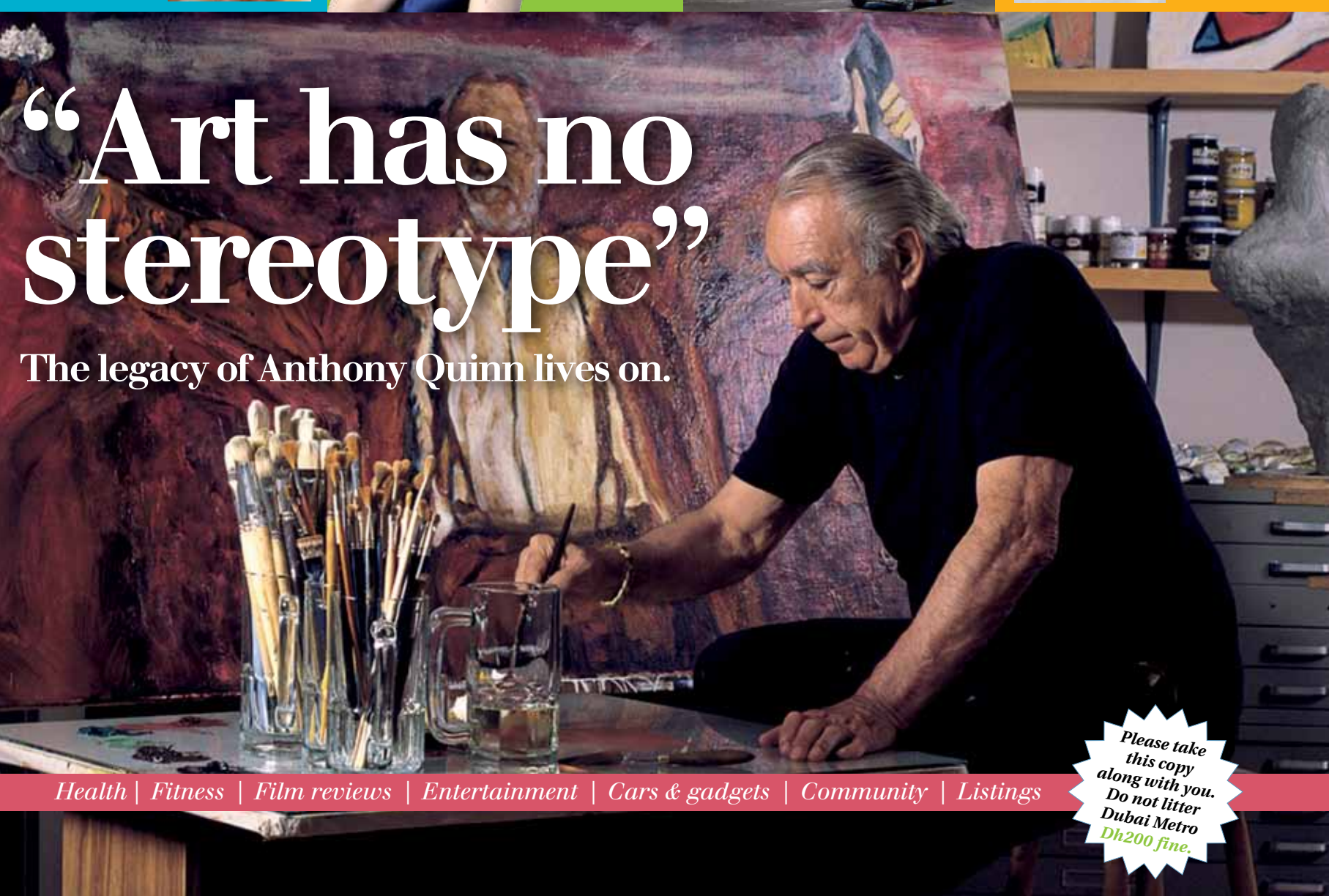

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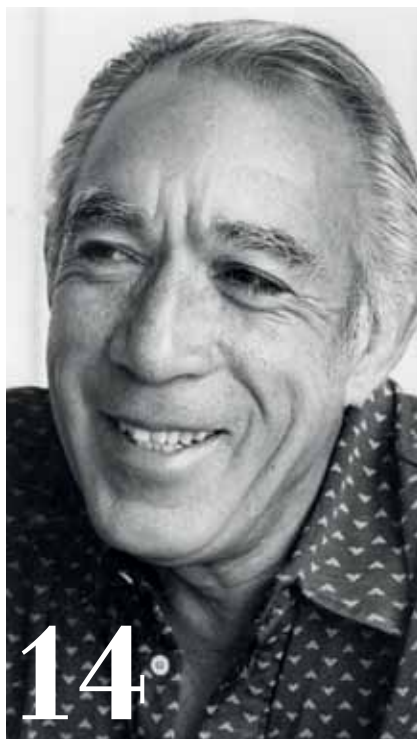

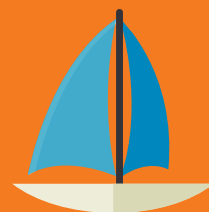

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5 Email etiquette tips for JOB SEEKERS

Email has become the main form of business communication, and that's why knowing the proper etiquette for email job search is without a doubt crucial for the success of your career search efforts. Sticking to the basic protocol of email is extremely simple and once you get accustomed to it, it will become second nature to you. But it's this convenience that can lead to making embarrassing mistakes. Making a major email mistake when applying for jobs can significantly ruin your chances of landing the job you want. Fortunately, email etiquette can be easily learned and once you master it, you can boost your career potential. Here are Akhtaboot's 5 email etiquette tips for job seekers to stop your emails from being ignored.



Proofreading

People who read your emails form perceptions about you as a professional. Typing mistakes give a negative impression about you and sends the wrong message on how you do business. Poor spelling and grammar are similar to you showing up unprepared for an interview. The wrong use of full stops or commas can also change the meaning of the text. Editing software and email programs have built-in spell checkers, so you have no excuse. Make sure that you proof read your emails and possibly pass it on to a second eye to be 100 % sure.

Keep Straight to the Point

Long emails look intimidating and tend to get ignored. If you have additional info that you'd like to include such as your CV or a cover letter, attach it as a separate document. Using witty and precise sentences is all you need.

Include a Clear and Direct Subject Line

Your email's subject line should always be informative, interesting and most importantly, searchable.

No matter how well an email is written, if the subject line is not catchy and relevant, then chances are the email will end up in the junk folder. Subject lines should communicate exactly what the email is all about. Always include keywords related to the topic of the email to avoid it landing in the spam folder. If you want to include a number of points, make sure that you add them in numbered bullets to ensure that they all get read. Pick your words wisely and precisely. The best emails say one thing and say it clearly.

Show Enthusiasm

Every job-related email you send out is a reflection of who you are. If you're truly interested in the job, make sure that your feeling shows with the words you use. Showing enthusiasm doesn't mean repeating yourself again and again; the recipient may get bored and confused. Focus on the real subject so you don't waste the time of the reader. Also, always keep a professional tone and avoid writing in capitals as it gives the impression that you are shouting.

In the professional world, people's perception of you does matter and can hinder your career success if you present yourself the wrong way. There's nothing easier than sending out a well-written, organized email. So why not take advantage of forming a great first impression before meeting your potential employer. 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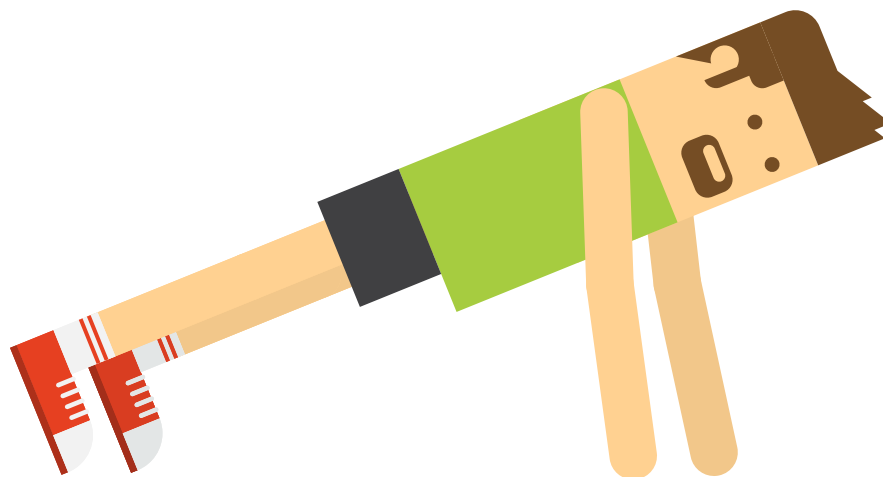
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Morning Workout

With the holidays and fun festivities over, we are all now settling back into our daily routine. Let us not forget that this is a New Year and with this we should all try our best to keep our New Year's Resolution. What better way to start 2015 than to feel good about ourselves, because once we feel good we have more courage to face the adventures waiting for us in the months to come. Let READ show you some workouts that you could easily add to your morning routine, this should be the year for you to start taking care of your body.

30 crunches

Sit-ups are different from crunches wherein crunches are a smaller movement, where you lift your head and shoulders up from the floor about 1/3 of the way, then back down again. Lie on your back with your knees bent and feet flat on the floor, hip-width apart. Place your hands behind your head so your thumbs are behind your ears. Don't lace your fingers together. Hold your elbows out to the sides but rounded slightly in. Tilt your chin slightly, leaving a few inches of space between your chin and your chest. Gently pull your abdominals inward. Curl up and forward so that your head, neck, and shoulder blades lift off the floor. Hold for a moment at the top of the movement and then lower slowly back down.

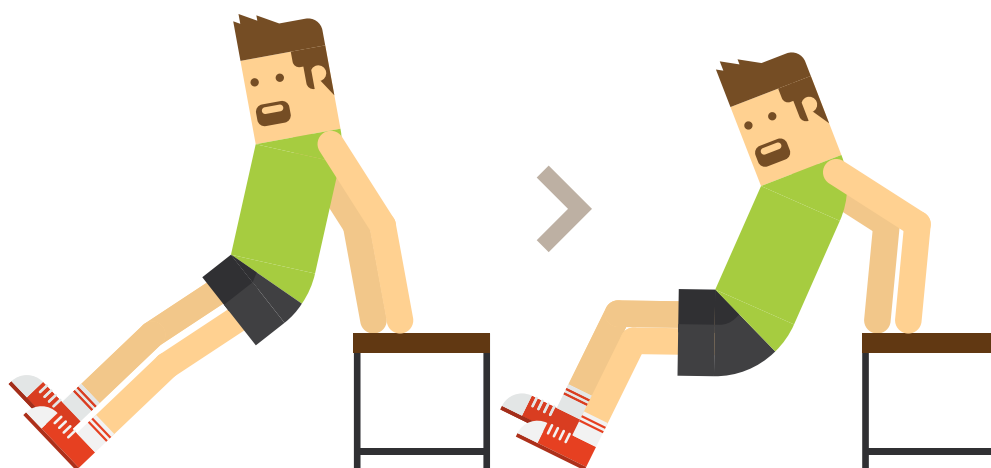
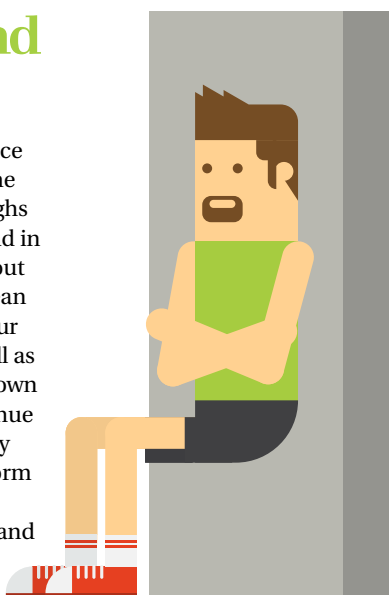


25 push-ups

Push-ups are one of the most effective and simplest exercises in order for you to build a strong upper body and midsection. Some key points to ensure a proper push-up: one is to keep your body stiff and straight as a plank, have your elbows at a 45-degree angle from your sides, remember to breathe in on the way down and then lower your body all the way down, allowing your sternum to gently touch the floor and lastly breathe out on the way up.

50 second wall sit

A proper wall sit increases endurance and strengthens the muscles in the thighs and buttocks. Stand in front of a wall (about 2 feet away) and lean against it. Slide your back down the wall as if you are sitting down into a chair. Continue lowering your body until your knees form a 90-degree angle. Hold the position and then stand back up.



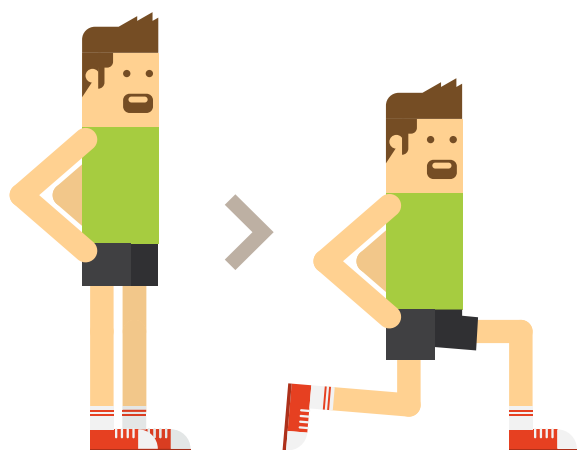
10 tricep dips

Push-ups have your feet planted. Dips move your whole body through space. Dips are harder and thus superior to push-ups because you have to balance your body. Raise yourself on 2 supports with elbows locked. Lower your body until your shoulders are lower than your elbows. Push yourself up by straightening your arms.



45 second plank

Planking is a simple but effective bodyweight exercise. Holding the body stiff as a board develops strength primarily in the core, as well as the shoulders, arms, and glutes. Place the forearms on the ground with the elbows aligned below the shoulders, and arms parallel to the body at about shoulder-width distance. If flat palms bother your wrists, clasp your hands together.



30 lunges (each leg)

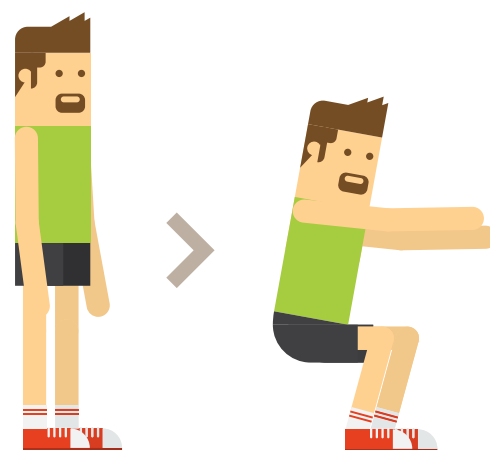
Step forward with one leg, lowering your hips until both knees are bent at about a 90-degree angle. Make sure your front knee is directly above your ankle, not pushed out too far, and make sure your other knee doesn't touch the floor. Keep the weight in your heels as you push back up to the starting position.

Always remember

Do this routine 3 times every morning! Once you've done it continuously for a full week try to increase the time for the exercises each week. Remember to talk to your doctor before you do any new exercise, especially if you have a knee injury or prior health condition.

15 squats

The squat is a compound, full body exercise. You squat by bending through your hips and knees, with the weight on your upper-back, until your hips come lower than your knees. Think about where your weight is on your feet – it should be on the heels and the balls of your feet.

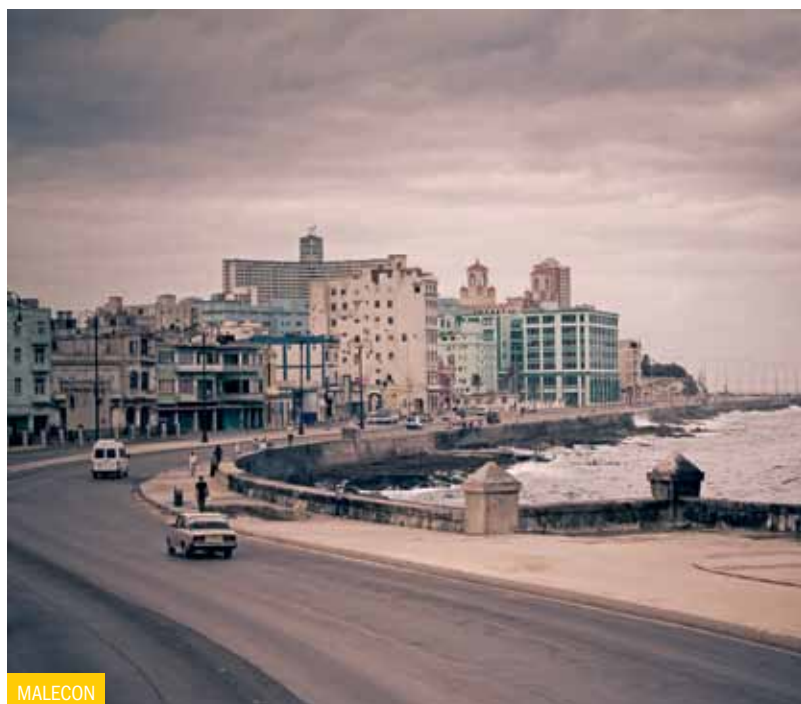

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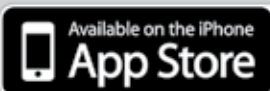
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“ART has no STEREOTYPE”

A conversation with Mrs. Anthony Quinn

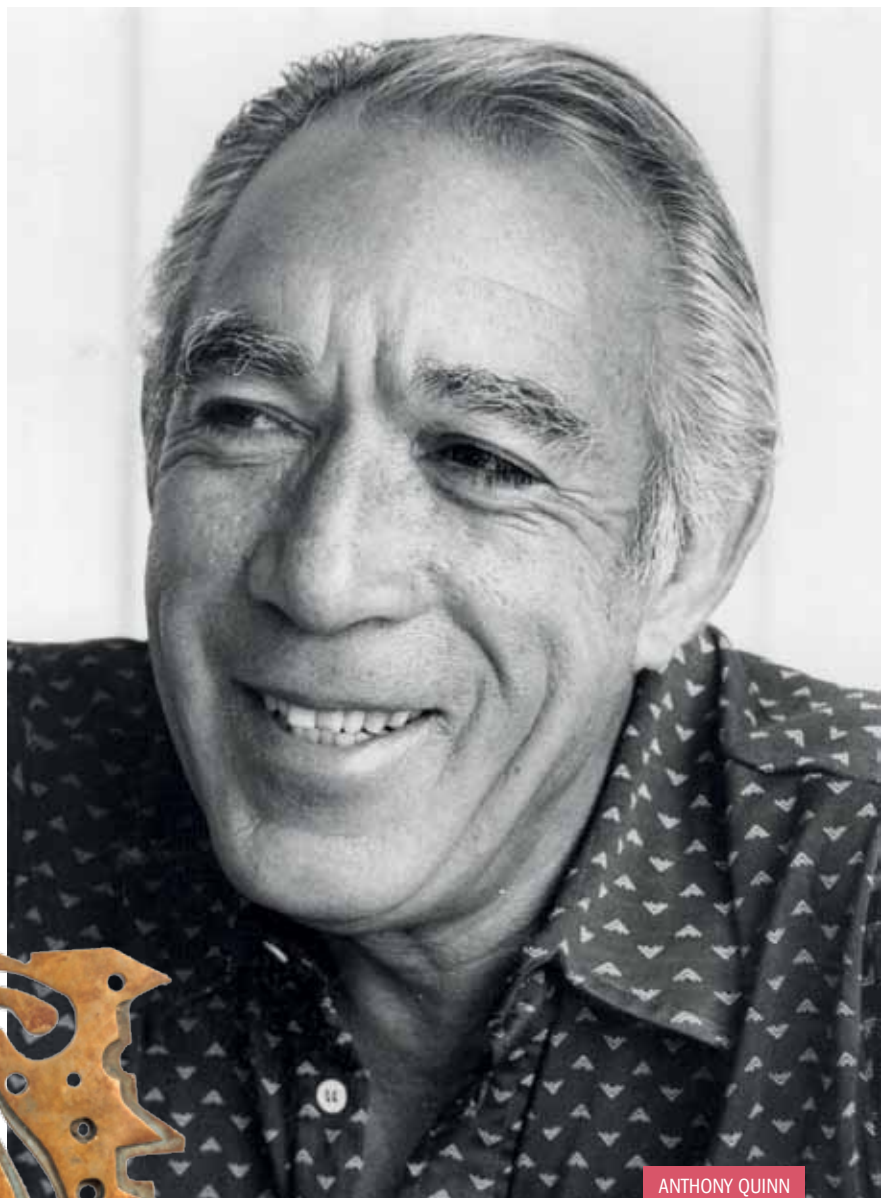
A woman of grace and passion fueling her motives, Katherine Quinn sits with her legs crossed; wearing a radiant smile on her face she passionately recalls about her husband Anthony Quinn and his philanthropic efforts.

Who can ever forget the legendary Hollywood actor Anthony Quinn? The Mexican-American actor who had passed away back in 2001 has over 170 films to his credit, some of which include titles like *Zorba the Greek*, *Lawrence of Arabia* and *The Guns of Navarone*. Among recent titles are *Avenging Angelo* with Sylvester Stallone, *A Walk in the Clouds* with Keanu Reeves and *Last Action Hero* with Arnold Schwarzenegger; but besides being an Oscar and Academy Award winner, Anthony Quinn was also a painter, sculptor, an amazing husband and father.

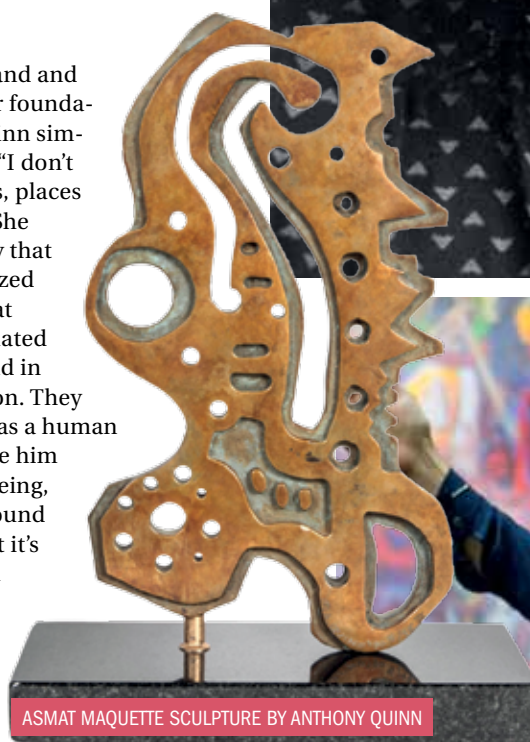
Last week marked the day when the Quinn family, which included his wife Katherine Quinn and his two children Antonia and Ryan, came to visit Dubai to talk about the Anthony Quinn Foundation which was founded by Katherine back in 2001. The foundation aims to promote the importance of art especially to the youth. This follows the legacy of Anthony Quinn himself, who believed arts to be a universal language. This year marks Mr. Quinn's centennial celebration and Dubai has been graced by the presence of his family.

When asked about why they chose

Dubai to expand and promote their foundation, Mrs. Quinn simply said that, “I don't choose places, places choose me.” She goes on to say that she was “amazed in the way that the people related to my husband in the Arab region. They relate to him as a human being and love him as a human being, as they do around the world; but it's very powerful for me here to see the reaction of the people.” She describes her late husband as a person who was curious of the world and loved people. “I think what would have been more important to him was to touch people's lives one way or another and his life touched people's lives and still does through some of his films. I think I can expand that through his artwork as well.” She further goes on to say, “It's just a very dynamic region, Dubai is such an amazing place. There's so much here. I think he would have loved that his legacy have lived on until the 21st century; I think there's no better example of what's booming in the 21st century than what's going on out here. There are

so many dynamic arts and culture and he would have related to the creativity of the people here." She recalls when Mr. Quinn was filming a movie back then, "he was here in the desert making movies. He fell in love with the Arabs when he was out here, he said that both the men and the women were so passionate and he couldn't believe the women –how they were covered up- were so expressive with their eyes."

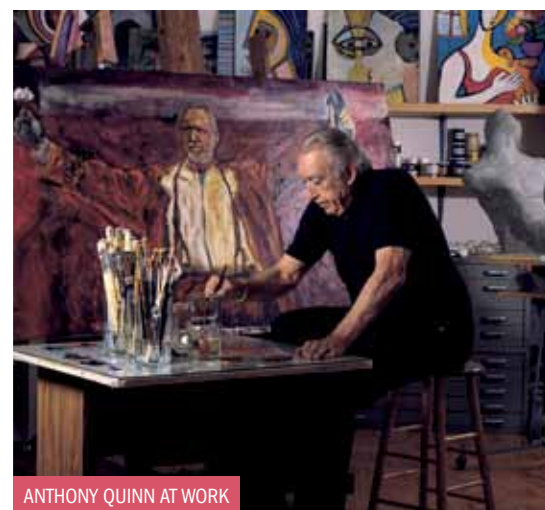
The foundation scholarship supports high school students' extra-curricular study of visual arts and design, performing arts, media arts, and literary arts. "Because Anthony wasn't able to finish high school, it was in that stage of his life that he wanted to become an architect. High school is also the place where the youth develops their own personality; they either hide it or develop it," she said emphatically. She further mentions that financial assessment is not part of their

criteria as she believes that "there are kids in every level of finance who need this encouragement." Art is indeed a special and important trait to have, developing this kind of awareness especially for the youth is critical. It gives them another outlet wherein they can pour their emotions and develop and nurture their creative minds. "Art does what nothing else can do: that is to bring people together from different cultures. Because you tend to have stereotypes, art has no stereotype. I think art is what will eventually bring peace to the world."

For Katherine, the most important thing is the upbringing of children, "Speak to your children, observe them and especially when an artistic talent emerges, nurture the art in their lives always; raising a child is like watching a tree grow, you can't tell it where to go but you can trim a branch here that you see is kind of bad and encourage the ones that

are strong.

When you see your child dancing and playing music, don't dismiss it, encourage it and see what can emerge from it. Encourage creativity everywhere." And for the youth, she has some pearls of wisdom, "It takes great courage to be an artist. Just keep fighting for what you believe in, do what you love. Don't be afraid of having multiple talents, do them all and wait to see which one will present itself as stronger." This is one thing that the young generation of Dubai can look forward to, especially now that Dubai presents itself as a very artistic and inventive city.

It is now being reported that the 34-year-old is close to signing a deal to join Major League Soccer side LA Galaxy. The deal for Gerrard to extend his stay at Liverpool was not offered until November, by then it was too late. The Englishman said "If a contract had been put in front of me in pre-season I would have signed it. I'd just retired from England to concentrate all my efforts on Liverpool."



The Korean Grand Prix will officially no longer take part in the calendar for the 2015 Formula 1 season, which leaves the season with a total of 20 races to be held. The race, which was supposed to be held on May 3, is now clear, leaving a three-week gap between the Bahrain Grand Prix on April 19 and Spanish Grand Prix on May 10. We let them off for a year on the understanding they would be back."

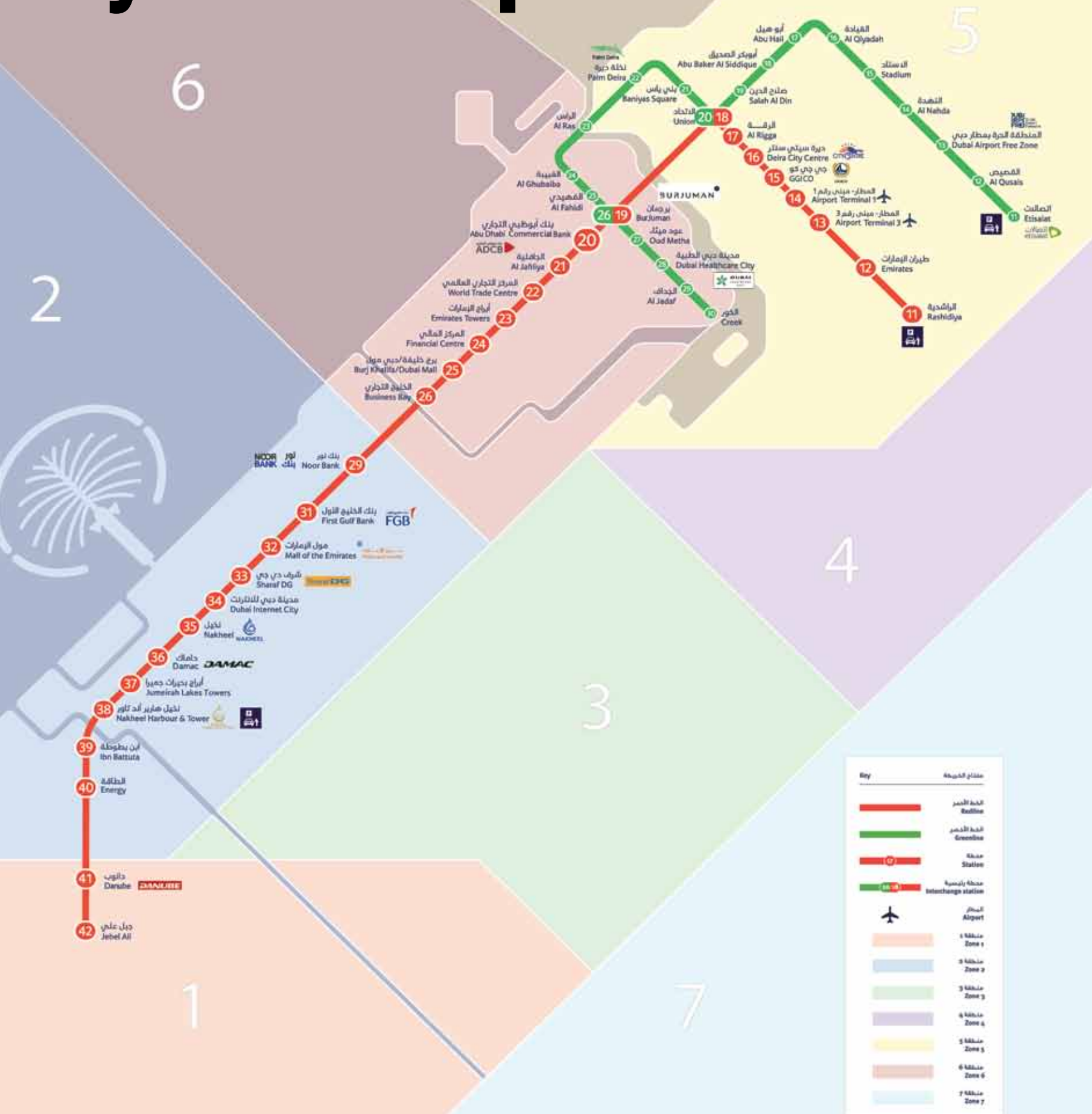

The Public Transport Agency (PTA), Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), has launched its 'Saher' campaign to combat the illegal transportation of passengers in Dubai. The campaign is being conducted in collaboration with the General HQ of the Dubai Police as part of endeavours to eradicate the outlawed activity which has mushroomed into a phenomenon that warrants concerted efforts to curb its negative impact on both the RTA and the community.

Some of these are ex taxi-drivers who, after the taxi business has been regularised in other emirates, have converted their cabs into private vehicles and engage in unlicensed passenger transport activities in Dubai."

As for the losses inflicted by illegal transportation of passengers on the taxi sector in Dubai, Al Mahra said: "The practice has negative financial repercussions on this vital sector in Dubai; which is considered one of the key tourist cities in the region. It distorts the profile of the RTA as a service-providing entity that seeks to deliver best-in-class services through creative techniques aligned with the

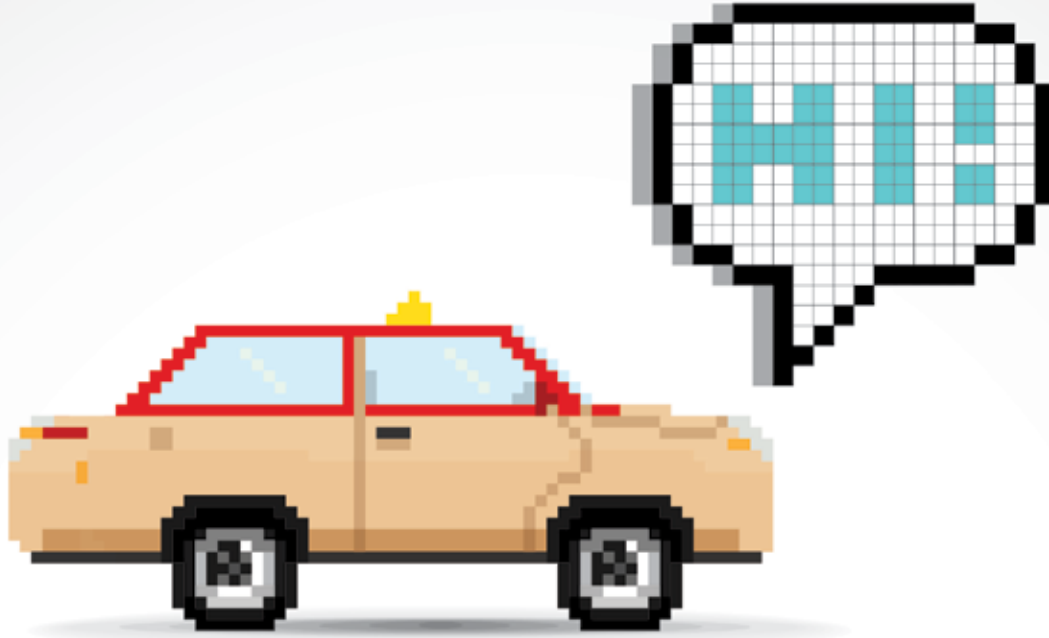

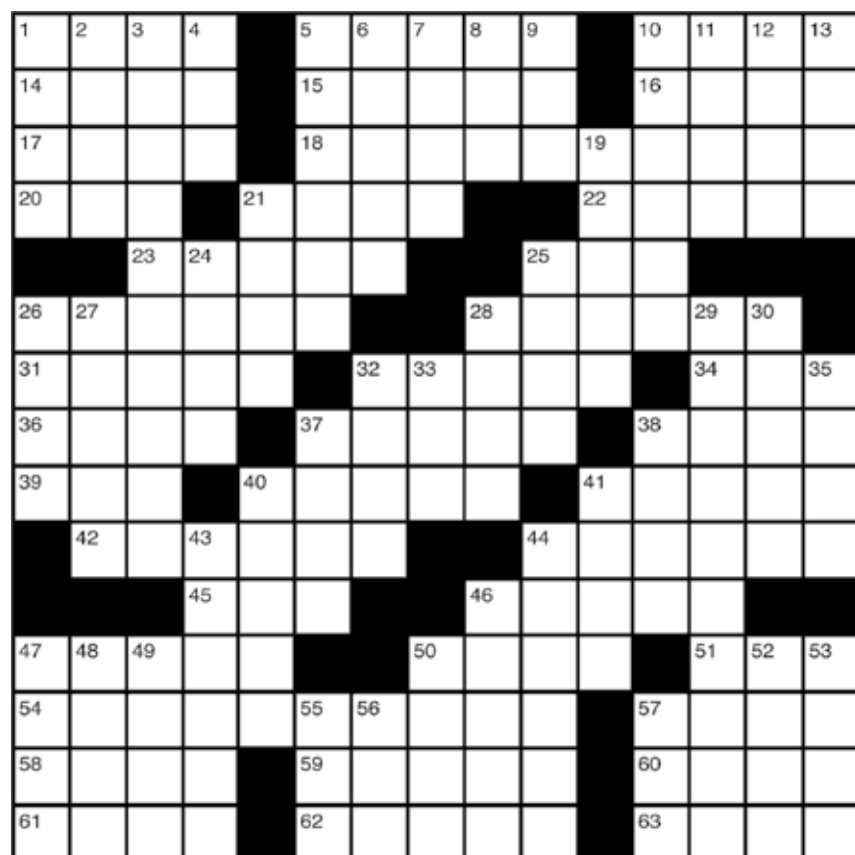

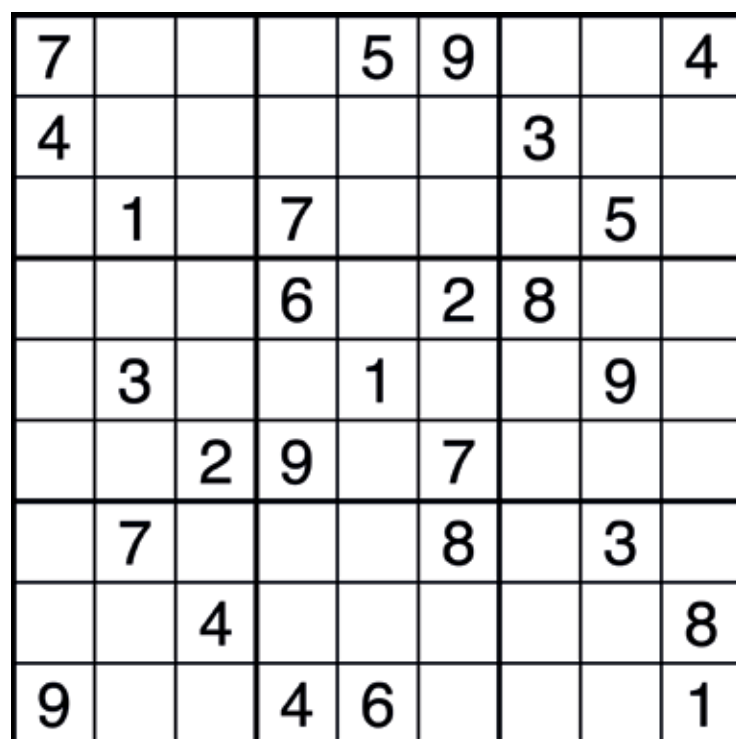
