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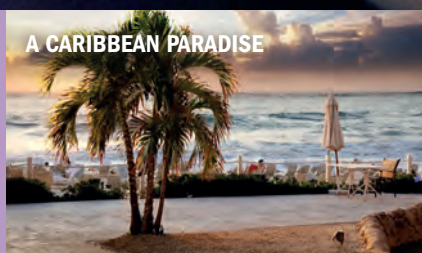

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5 ways to avoid a bad hire

Many employers make the mistake of choosing someone based on “gut feeling” or because that candidate reminds them of themselves, only to discover that the candidate was completely unfit for the position. Companies can't afford to make hiring mistakes. That's why they need to make sound and informed hiring decisions based on specific competencies, traits and skills for each position. Since the expenses associated with replacing hires are extremely high, you need to learn how you can avoid making bad hiring decisions. 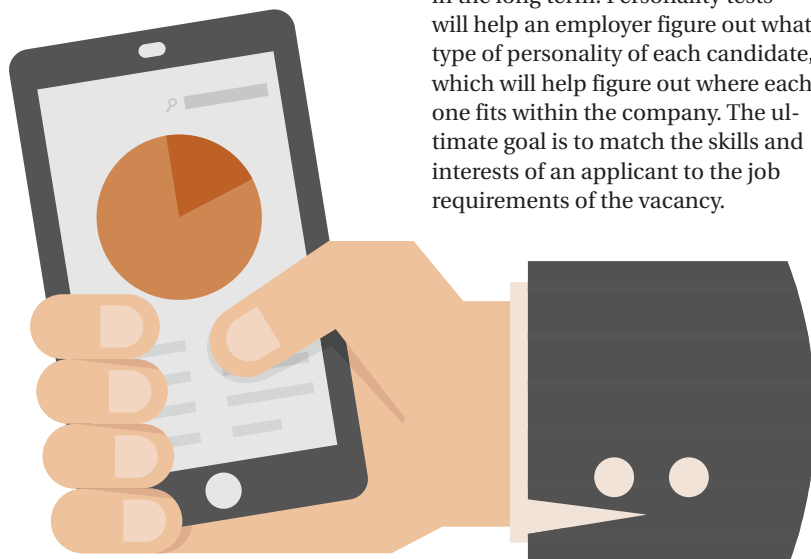


Not Hiring For Cultural Fit

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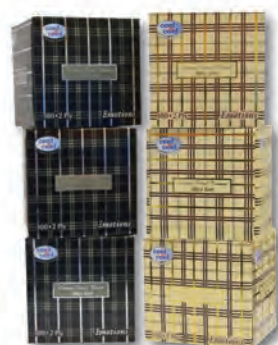
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A step to happiness

Homemade lemon curd

Preparation Time: 30 mins or less
Makes one 500g/1lb 2oz (large) jar

Ingredients

- 4 un-waxed lemons, zest and juice
- 200g/7oz unrefined caster sugar
- 100g/3½oz unsalted butter, cut into cubes
- 4 eggs

Preparation method

1. Put the lemon zest, juice, sugar and butter into a heatproof bowl. Sit the bowl over a pan of gently simmering water, making sure the water is not touching the bottom of the bowl. Stir the mixture every now and again until all of the butter has melted.

2. Lightly whisk the eggs and stir them into the lemon mixture. Whisk until all of the ingredients are well combined, then leave to cook for 10-13 minutes, stirring every now and again, until the mixture is creamy and thick enough to coat the back of a spoon.

3. Remove the lemon curd from the heat and set aside to cool, stirring occasionally as it cools. Once cooled, spoon the lemon curd into sterilised jars and seal. Keep in the fridge until ready to use.



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Medical miracle

Tips for a heart-healthy diet

Did you know that your belly button can also be infected? Your belly button should be cleaned just like all the other parts of the body; otherwise, the area can develop gnarly smells and infections, often paired with red, itchy, and scabby skin—especially if you have a navel piercing. The average navel is swarming with 67 different species of bacteria, according to research from North Carolina State University and according to Alexandria V. Booth, M.D., says that simply showering will remove some germs, lint, and whatnot, but if you have an 'innie', you should also dig in once a week with a cotton swab that has soap and water or rubbing alcohol on it. If you're regularly cleaning it and you notice that there is still a smell or some kind of infection in it then it's time to visit the doctor's office to finally get rid of it once and for all and to make sure you have a squeaky clean belly button.

More specifically, make healthy and smart choices as such:

- Eating more fruits and vegetables as they are rich in fibres and antioxidants that help fight illnesses
- Increasing the total intake of fibres to 25 grams per day (on average for an adult)
- Choosing whole-grain products as they are essential source of fibres, such as whole-grain bread, brown rice, oatmeal, quinoa, popcorn, rye bread etc.
- Choosing low-fat or fat-free dairy products (cheese, milk and yogurt)
- Including proteins such as poultry, fish, beans, eggs, tofu and opting for lean sources of meat, without skin
- Limiting red meat to once a week only
- Including more of the heart-healthy omega-3 fatty acids that is found in salmon, trout, herring and tuna - consume fish at least twice a week
- Reducing the consumption of saturated fats (solid at room temperature) and use more unsaturated fats and oils such as sunflower oil, canola oil and olive oil – use in moderation
- Including raw and unsalted nuts (walnuts, and almonds) as part of a healthy diet and a healthy snack. Remember portion control is the key!
- Cutting back on the use of the salt shaker and foods rich in sodium (e.g. processed foods, frozen foods, canned, soy sauce, pickles and olives) – use more herbs and spices to flavour your dishes
- Limiting beverages and food items rich in sugars and added sugars
- Practicing portion control to avoid ingesting unnecessary calories
- Using healthy cooking methods such as roasting, grilling, baking and steaming instead of frying, deep frying and pan frying
- Limiting the amount of times you eat out as you will have more control over the ingredients you are using while cooking

To keep your heart healthy and young, follow these recommendations:



1. Lose weight if you are overweight or obese, with the help of your healthcare provider and/or your dietician
2. Eat a healthy and varied diet that includes items from all the food groups (grains, fruits, vegetables, protein and dairy)
3. Limit processed foods and foods that are high in simple sugars
4. Control your blood pressure and total blood cholesterol
5. Aim to be physically active at least 30 minutes every day or for a total of 150 minutes weekly – always consult with your physician prior to starting any exercise routine

6 ways to relieve headaches with pressure points

We've all experienced the pain of having a headache, whether it be during our travel time, at work or at home, and most commonly we pop a pill to make it go away, and most often than not, it doesn't do the trick. What you can try is applying pressure to your 'pressure points', this is called acupressure. To keep it as basic as possible, the idea is this: You can affect the flow of energy and chemistry in your body by applying pressure at specific areas of your body. So here are 6 ways you can try anywhere to alleviate your headache.



1. The inside of your eyebrows, just above the bridge of your nose. Application of pressure to this point – directly over the facial sinuses – can lead to some relief with headaches. Ever notice how your hands naturally gravitate to this area when you have pain?
2. The temples – These areas seem to hold a lot of the muscle stress from the rest of the scalp. Just my personal observation. And gently massaging both temples with your thumbs or fingers can help relieve some of that built-up tension.
3. The base of the skull. Again, here we have some of the primary muscles for the head and neck. Tilt your head back and press upwards in a

circular motion.

4. Between the thumb and index finger. There is a pressure point located in this meaty part of the hand. Firmly pinch the area between the thumb and forefinger with the ... well, the other thumb and forefinger, and give it a good massage.
5. This last one might be a little harder to do at work. Start between your big toe and second toe. On the top of your foot come back about one inch and press down.
6. So, next time you feel that ache behind your eyes, or anywhere else, try and remember some of these methods and deal with your pain a natural way before it gets too bad. Hopefully they will work for you.

Quick Tips: How to look slimmer in photos

1. Cinch that waist. My body is on the athletic side, so if I gain weight, the first thing that goes are my curves. Adding a belt around my waist helps give the illusion of a smaller waist-line.

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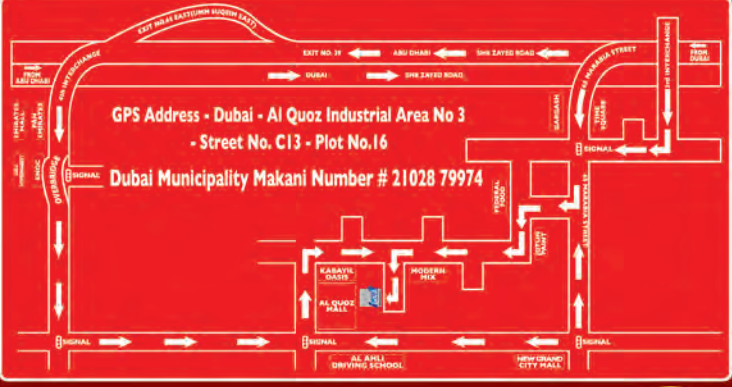
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A Caribbean paradise

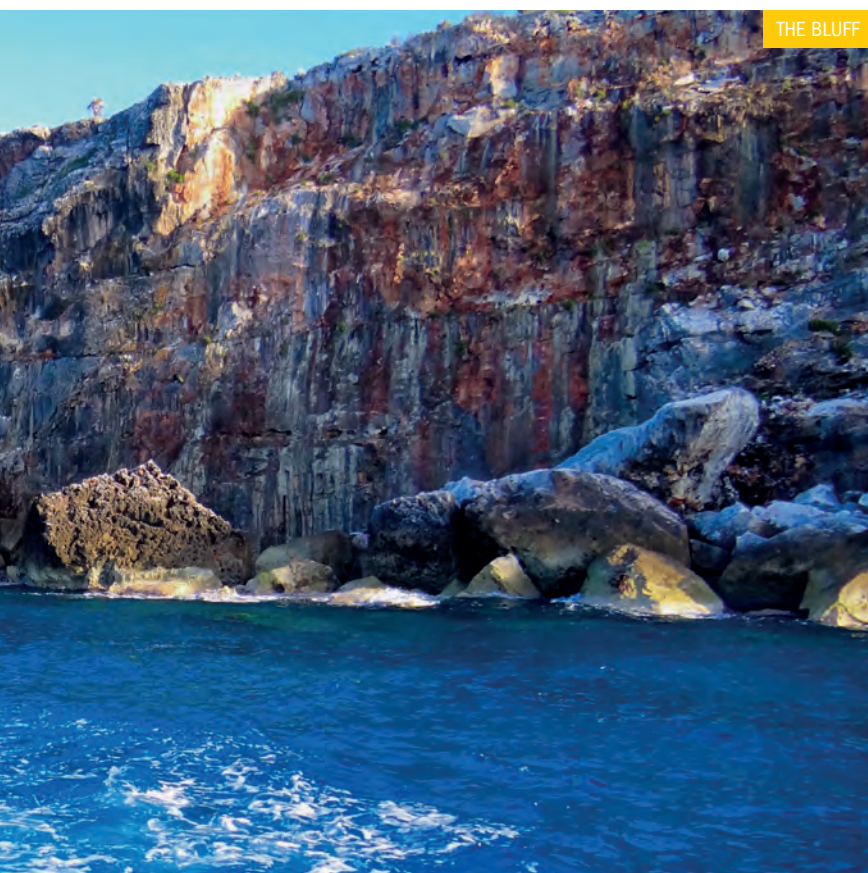

To further discuss this unique Film Fair event, we contacted Hermoine Macura herself to ask a few questions.

What message are you trying to convey with 'WOW', considering the fact that the Middle East are most often stereotyped by others as oppressive to women.

I decided to launch the World of Women Film Fair to support women

in the arts and help to promote dialogue and understanding on issues that are important to women not only in the Arab world but beyond as well. Ever since I launched my company, this has been a main goal for us – to empower and enrich women in the community and especially in the Arab world.

Considering the fact that there are other Film Awards that also give chance and awards to women, creating this particular event based solely on film made for women by women, would you say you are feminist?

WOW also features films about women by men as well. This year's program features 2 films by men that focus on health. I am proud to be a feminist and a defender of women's rights. I'm not angry at men – I just believe women need to rise up and take their place in society across all platforms.

What have you observed in the film industry, as seeing it is mostly dominated by men? Would you say there is a lack of participation from the women, which is why this particular event was created?

Women are largely misrepresented not only on screen but behind the camera as well. This is clearly seen



and vocalised in Hollywood as well. The WOW Film Fair aims to focus on this niche market and offer women a platform to creatively promote their work as well as address issues that are relevant to our community locally and globally. Like most women, I am disgusted by the over sexualisation of women in film and on TV. This needs to change among other things if women are truly to be equal and respected across all industries in society globally.

Since this is made for the independent film makers, are there any plans on doing something in the future for the mainstream?

Like all Film Fairs and Festivals, our main focus is to give up and coming Film makers a chance to show their work and shine. Our plans are to take our program regionally across the Arab world, possibly Lebanon, Egypt and Jordan next year.

What should we expect for the 2nd edition of 'WOW'?

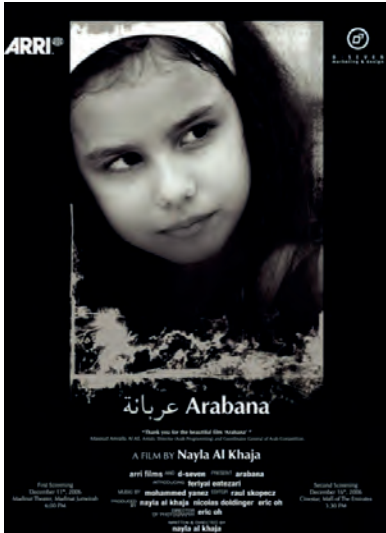

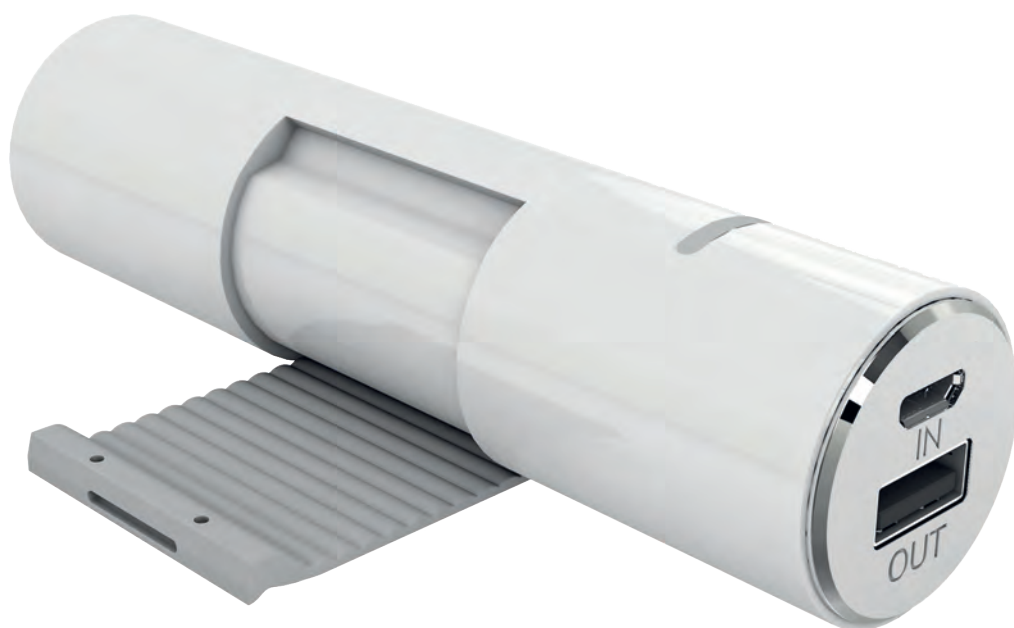

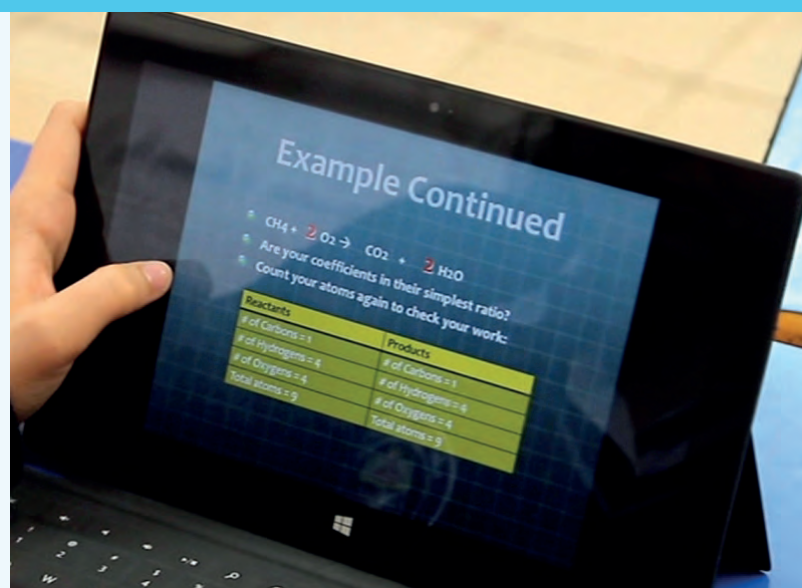

Full of dark comedy and thriller elements, Focus is fraught with surprises and plot twists that are sure to blow your mind. The movie, directed by Glenn Ficarra and John Requa, stars Will Smith in the title role of a professional conman along with his romantic interest played by relatively new Australian actress Margot Robbie. The plot of the film follows the relationship between the two throughout the film as Smith's character attempts to pull off elaborate small-scale cons in the United States and an eventual large-scale scam involv-

ing Formula 1 racing moguls in Buenos Aires, Argentina. The cast also features actor Gerald McRaney, known for his role in the Netflix series House of Cards, and Brazilian actor Rodrigo Santoro. What is particularly enjoyable throughout the film is that it maintains a perfect albeit delicate balance between humor, drama, and thrill. The cinematography is also impressive, with that demonstrated quite beautifully in the scenes that take place in New Orleans and Buenos Aires. In addition, the filming locations fit in perfectly with the action scenes

and complemented the witty, dark atmosphere of the movie. The music also flowed well with the scenes and the transitions between one place and another. The mood of the film was somber yet had lighthearted undertones as it dabbled with comedic elements. However, we would love to have seen more character development. This does not nullify the fact that the characters are powerful immersive elements in this film. Overall, Focus has a good share of laughs as well as plot revelations that will leave you scratching your head for quite a while.



Driving beyond boundaries

Lexus pioneered its first luxury crossover SUV back when it introduced the RX 300 in the 1990s. Now, 15 years later, the new 2015 Lexus NX has finally arrived – a model smaller than the RX and impossible to ignore. This vehicle is designed to elicit strong emotional reaction through its futuristic looks. The NX however shares a platform with the Toyota RAV4, but so much has been upgraded, strengthened, or modified that the two vehicles don't feel related. The 2015 Lexus NX 200t F Sport conjoins brash looks, compact crossover dimensions and the reputation for reliability Lexus has established for many years. Nobody will ever be able to call this crossover boring, that's for sure.

The interior is roomy but overwrought, particularly with the garish red F Sport leather seats. Let's not forget the heated F Sport steering wheel, a power sunroof, blind spot monitoring with rear cross-traffic alert, a Comfort Package, and a Navigation Package. Honestly, it does pack a lot of eye candy, mostly thanks to the stitched leather-like synthetic materials that cover portions of the dashboard, center console and doors. Also, the Japanese automaker decided to go with knobs and buttons instead of a touchscreen display – which deserves a thumbs up from my end.

On the outside, you have an exterior that tones up the look-at-



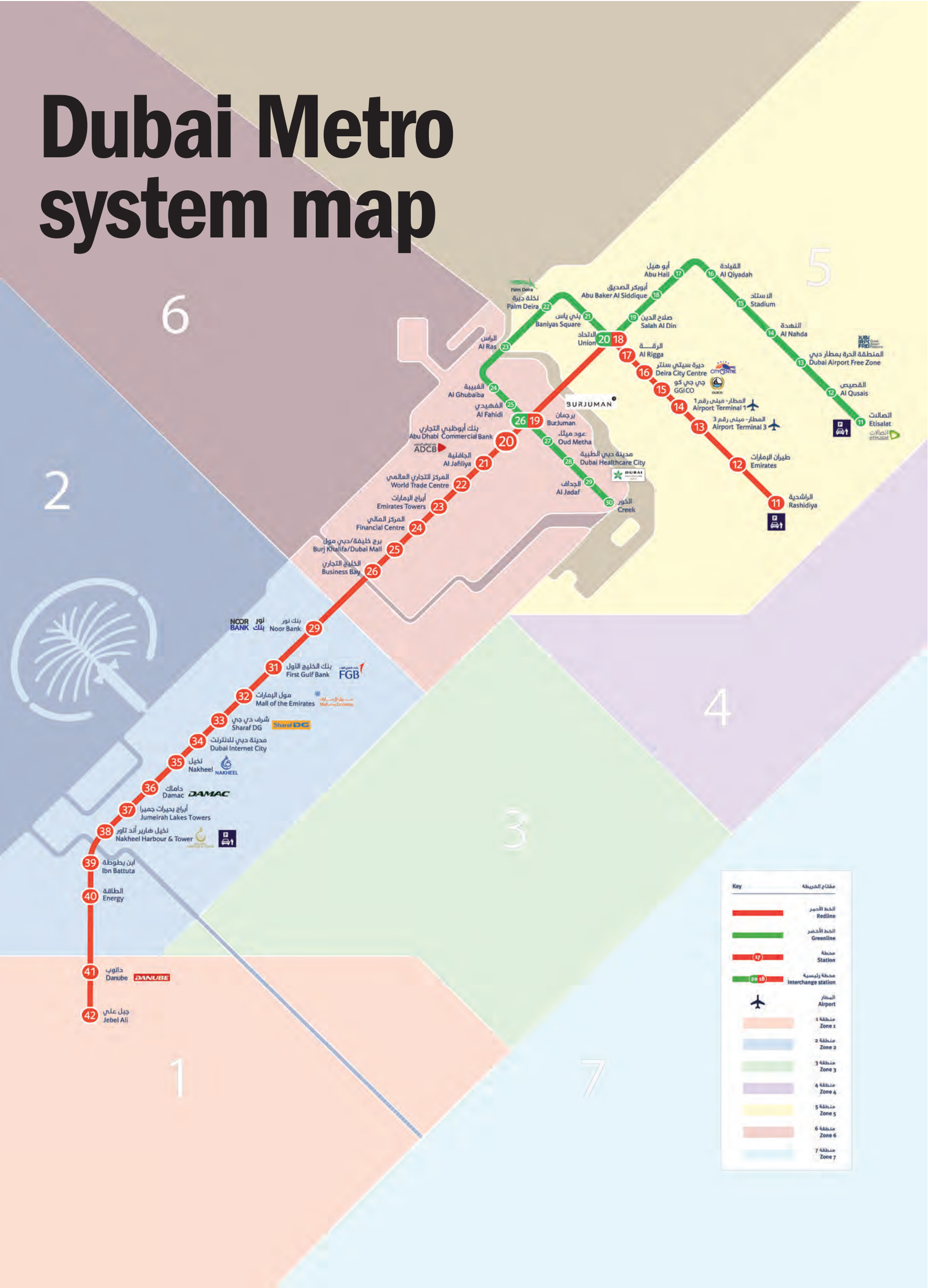
more eye-catching.

Under the hood we find an engine not so powerful, but then again quite impressive for a luxury SUV, boasting a 235-horsepower 2.0-liter turbocharged four-cylinder engine and six-speed automatic, generating 258 lb-ft of torque. That being said, the NX 200t F Sport hits 100km/h in 7 seconds flat. It's the first turbocharged engine ever installed in a Lexus and likely won't be the last. The handling and electric power steering are beyond perfect which gets incredibly fun once set into "Sport" mode. Scrolling the drive mode rotary dial from 'Eco' to 'Sport' sharpens the throttle response and wakes up the transmission, lightning things up as you are on the go.

me design, especially if you choose a ravishing colour. The NX looks different from every other luxury crossover, with a protuberant snout and radical lines that jut out from the body. Its beautiful design will make the vehicles of current Lexus RX owners seem outdated. The NX brings an edgy new styling theme to Lexus' utility vehicle lineup, and the focal point is definitely its face, where there's an oversized, especially bold version of Lexus' spindle grille, narrow headlights, truly aggressive lower air dam and fender sculpting, and separate LED running lights. Not to forget that the NX benefits from the front grill treatment the F-Sport adds, making it look sportier and

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School transport sector in Dubai records substantial growth

Number of students carried between 2011 to 2014 increases by 14 per cent while fatality rate hits zero in 2014.

STATISTICS

According to the Public Transport Agency at the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) school transport in Dubai recorded remarkable growth during the period 2011 to 2014 in terms of the number of students lifted, buses deployed and bus conductors appointed.

"The number of students lifted by school transport services increased by 14 per cent between 2011 and 2014," said Adel Mohammed Shakri, Director of Planning & Business Development at the Public Transport Agency.

Shakri attributed the substantial growth to the implementation of the School Transport Law issued by Dubai Executive Council. The law, he noted, had been initiated by the RTA which caters to overseeing its implementation at the highest international standards. In this regard, the RTA had entered into partnership agreements with several reputed and specialised international entities, such as the American NAPT with which the RTA had teamed up in holding an international congress about school transport in Dubai in 2013.

"The implementation of the School Transport Law has played a pivotal role in securing the safety of students of different ages served by school transport services. The sound implementation of the law has contributed to cutting the number of accidents recorded in this sector by 10 per cent, thanks to the cooperation between the RTA, school managements, school transport companies and parents. This cooperation is reflected in the compliance of school

managements and school transport companies with the provisions and stipulations of the School Transport Law and their positive response to the awareness campaigns launched by the RTA from time to time," added Shakri.

"At the top of achievements made by the school transport sector in Dubai is that the number of fatalities dropped to zero in 2014; which is good news indicative of the growing awareness of all stakeholders in the school transport sector in Dubai," he added.

The implementation of the School Transport Law has brought about a whole host of benefits and positive impacts that have several social, environment, economic and educational implications. The social dimension has resulted in stimulating various community segments to embrace the culture of using mass transport, higher confidence in the school transport system, and more attention to the disabled as reflected in designing and deploying 50 buses to assist the safe and smooth mobility of this community segment. The social impact has also resulted in the soaring numbers of school bus drivers by 36 per cent and the number of school bus female conductors by 99 per cent between 2011 and 2014, added Shakri.

The economic aspect is reflected in the time saved by parents in lifting their wards to and from schools which is estimated in the order of 24,689 hours, saving in fuel consumed by vehicles equivalent to 20,095 hours of travel, and lending support to the school transport industry nation-wide. The law has also had an environmental dimen-

sion in reducing the carbon footprint resulting from vehicles by as much as 22,000 kg in four years.

The educational aspect of the law is seen in raising public awareness by running awareness campaigns involving more than 850 field visits to public and private schools.

The RTA is mulling the introduction of new technologies in the field

of school transport such as placing sensors underneath bus seats to send cautionary signals in case a child is left behind on board. Such a measure would assist in boosting the protection of children and ensuring their security and safety in transit. Additionally, an online educative module is being developed and safety tips will be diffused by means of cartoons simulating issues related to child safety, stated Shakri.

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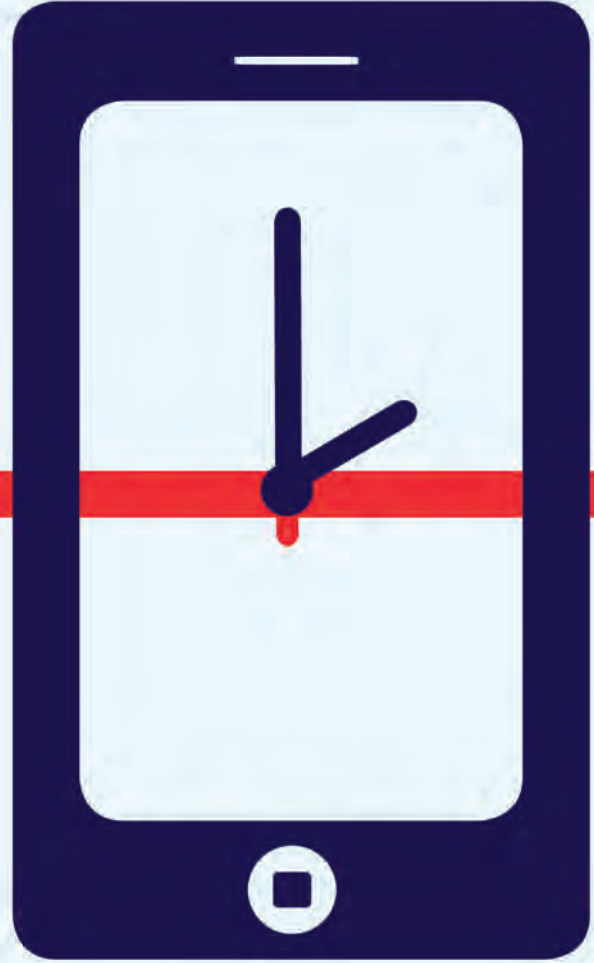

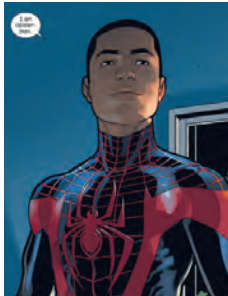

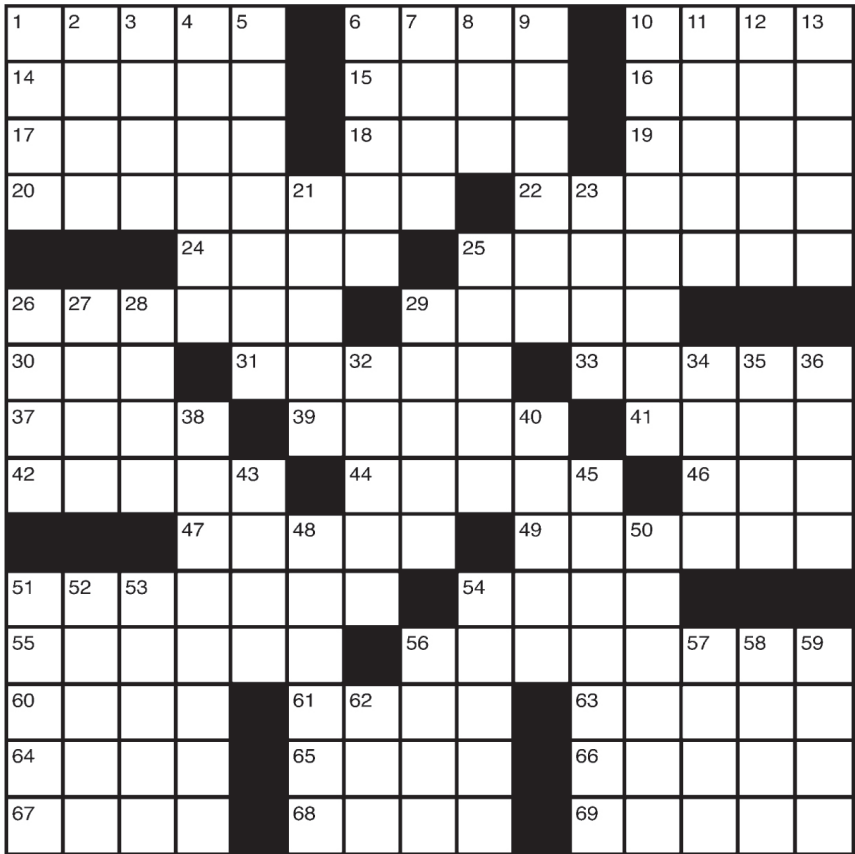
Sherlyn Chopra to play a double role

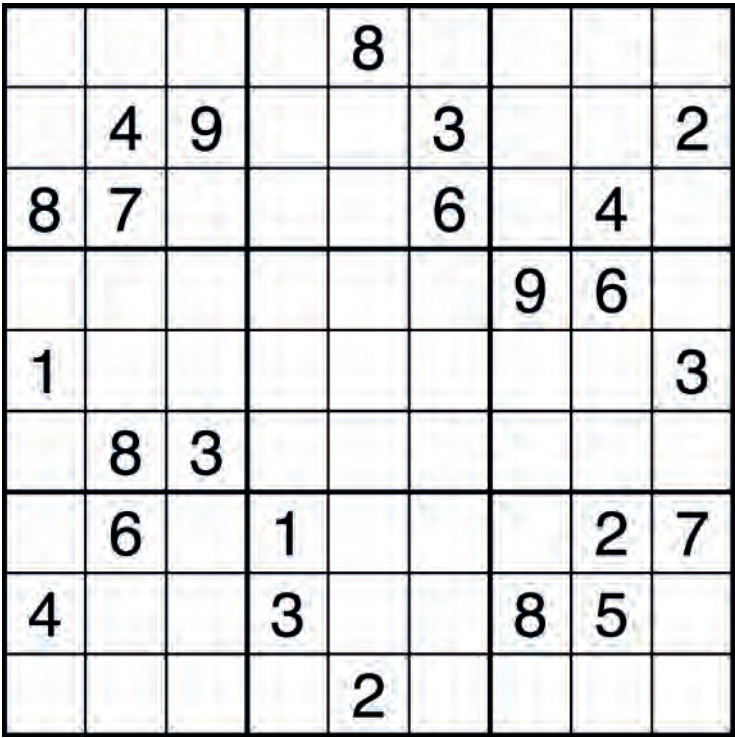
