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Garlic

can help fight lung infection!

According to a new study, seasoning your food with garlic can help fight lung infections. Garlic may be a secret weapon for people with cystic fibrosis who are fighting severe lung infections. A chemical found in garlic can kill bacteria that cause life-threatening lung infections in people with cystic fibrosis, a genetic disorder that mostly affects the lungs, the study noted. This study is the first to show the use of allicin to prevent and treat lung infections caused by a bacterium known as *Burkholderia cepacia* complex (BCC). This type of bacteria results in severe and contagious lung infections in people with cystic fibrosis. The researchers found that allicin destroys Bcc bacteria by chemically altering chief enzymes. "At a time when novel antimicrobial agents are urgently required, chemical and microbiological research has the potential to unlock the rich reservoir of antimicrobial compounds present in plants such as garlic," said Professor John Govan from the University of Edinburgh in Britain. Allicin is produced naturally by garlic bulbs to ward off a closely-related group of plant pathogens found in soil and water habitats. The researchers found that allicin - which can be extracted by crushing raw garlic - inhibits the growth of bacteria. Allicin kills Bcc bacteria by chemically modifying key enzymes, the researchers noted. The researchers hope that allicin-containing medicines and available antibiotics could be used together to treat BCC infections.

Alzheimer's at a young age

For the first time, researchers have detected possible signs of Alzheimer's disease in the brains of adults who were as young as 20 years old, overturning the notion of the disease as an elderly affliction. Scientists have long known that clumps of a protein known as amyloid build up in the brains of older Alzheimer's patients but researchers have now spotted groups of these proteins in the brains of young adults who were otherwise healthy and fully expected to live many more years with normal cognition. "Discovering that amyloid begins to accumulate so early in life is unprecedented," said the study's lead author Changiz Geula, a research professor from the Cognitive Neurology and Alzheimer's Disease Center at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, in a press release. "This is very significant. We know that amyloid, when present for long periods of time, is bad for you." For those who find the news disconcerting, there are several steps that experts say may reduce the likelihood that adults of any age will develop Alzheimer's disease. The Alzheimer's Association recommends adopting a Mediterranean diet and taking college or online courses throughout all stages of life to stay mentally sharp. The U.K.'s National Health Service suggests not smoking and drinking alcohol in moderation -- both are steps that lower a person's likelihood of developing cardiovascular disease which has been linked to dementia. The Mayo Clinic adds that exercising for 30 to 60 minutes a day several times a week may delay the disease's onset.



MSG isn't all that bad

Monosodium glutamate, widely known to us as MSG, has a bad rap. The food additive, which has been used for decades in Chinese food, canned vegetables, and processed meat, has been associated with several medical symptoms including headache, sweating, and numbness in some people, according to the US Food and Drug Administration. As a result, many believe that MSG should be avoided at all costs. With a growing number of people trying to avoid the additive, some restaurants have decided to go MSG-free and even use MSG-free labels in their advertising. But is MSG really even all that bad for you? A new video from the American Chemical Society's Reactions YouTube page explains that not only is MSG perfectly safe for the vast majority of people but shows how MSG, or, more accurately glutamate, is found in tons of natural, protein-rich foods. Plus, glutamate occurs naturally within our own bodies as we process and metabolize food. The whole monosodium part of MSG is so we can easily sprinkle it in our foods.



Longer sleep, higher stroke risk

A new study suggests people who sleep longer face a greater risk of having a stroke. Researchers followed patients for 10 years and found that someone 63 or older who sleeps more than eight hours a day is 46 percent likelier to suffer a stroke in the next decade than adults who sleep for 6-8 hours. "We've actually characterized pretty well the effect of sleep deprivation," says Dr. Caroline Barton, an assistant professor of neurology at LSU Health New Orleans School of Medicine. "But we've not really characterized very well what the effect of too much sleep is on people." Barton says you can't diagnose a stroke before it happens but studies like this help give doctors clues as to what might be causing them. She says stability of sleep as a trait is very important. "Because they noticed that the people who tended to have strokes because they slept longer, 10 years prior when they were first studied slept normally," said Barton. The findings were published in the journal *Neurology*. Barton says the study also noted that if someone had a significant change in their sleeping habits it was a bad sign. "They said long sleep could be a cause, consequence or an early marker of ill health that could eventually result in stroke," said Barton.

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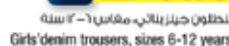
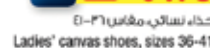
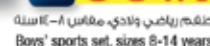
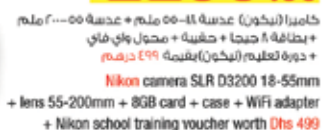
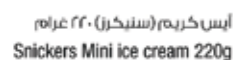
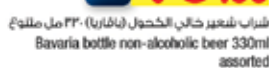
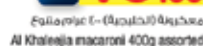
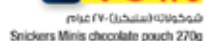
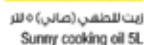
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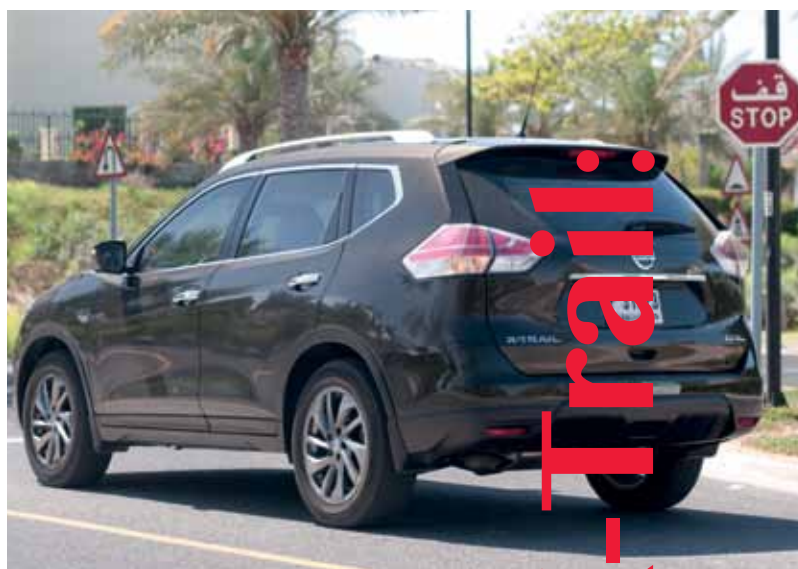
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Nissan X-Trail!

A leap in quality



After spending three days behind the wheel of the Nissan X-Trail, I think it's fair to say that this car does not only comprise a stylish design, but also makes every day driving a joy. Not to mention that the weather was quite windy and sandy, which put this compact SUV up to a real test. This car is no doubt in competition with the Toyota Rav4, Honda CR-V and the Mazda CX-5. And don't worry, if you're someone with a large family, you're going to love the seven-seat options with full comfort. The X-Trail has seen so many changes since the first and second generations of the vehicle.

It's a good thing that Nissan has the car marked the X-Trail badge, or else we wouldn't really know what car it

really is. Yes, that's how much it has changed. On the front lays Nissan's V-motion grille design and unique boomerang-shaped LED daytime running lights, as well as LED headlamps. Now on the side is what gives the car its distinguished look – roof rails and a spoiler to match. Not to forget the wing mirrors that also serve as extra signal lights. Another nice touch is to the design is the puddle lamps. This third generation model is genuinely good looking, with pentagonal tail lamps and a black diffuser adorning the rear end.

On the inside, it's a whole different story, where things get even better. There are standard and optional hi-tech extras galore, include lane-keeping and

blind-spot devices and a bird's-eye view monitor to help with parking, as well as an infotainment system with a seven-inch touchscreen. The modern dash layout offers great materials. The space in this car is pretty good all-round except for the very back third-row seat, which is slightly tight. You no longer have to worry about your coffee getting cold or your soda getting warm, because the generous cupholders have their own air supply for cooling or warming your drink. The navigation system deserves a praise, offering good resolution and easy-to-follow directional prompts.

Under the hood we find something a bit less impressive. The 170 hp 2.5-litre motor has barely been tweaked

over the old one, at least in terms of specs, but that doesn't mean the car doesn't offer its driver a great drive. On the contrary, the handling of this vehicle works in a way to ease your passage wherever you want to go, and it's quite easy to drive for such a bulky car. The top-spec model is powered by a larger capacity 2.5-litre mill, which is quite impressive for 170 horsepower and 233Nm. Now if I'm not mistaken, all this adds up to quite a car.

After countless leaks and rumours flooding the internet, Samsung has finally announced their Galaxy S6 and S6 Edge smartphones. It's been a year since the Galaxy S5, which wasn't exactly a high point in the company's design history, so what has Samsung hidden for us now? The Galaxy S6 and S6 Edge look almost identical in every way that matters. Both devices feature 5.1-inch Quad HD Super AMOLED screens. Both have Samsung's latest octa-core chipset thrumming away in them, chipsets that pair a quad-2.1GHz processor with a quad-1.5GHz one. And also, they both have 3GB of RAM, quite impressive for a smartphone. The two phones are set for a global launch on April 10th of this year. 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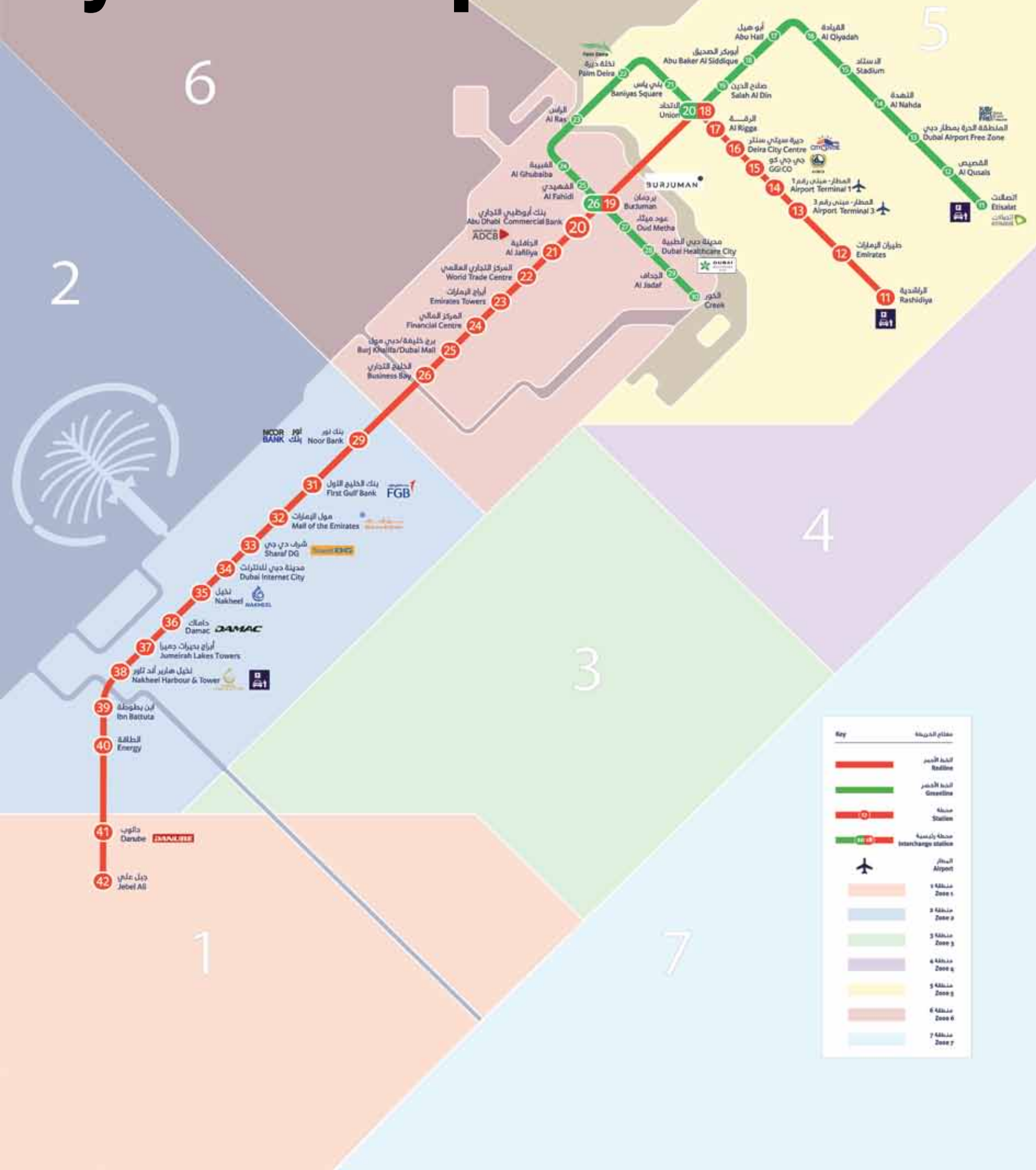

Dubai Metro system map



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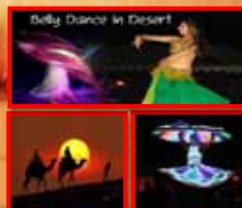
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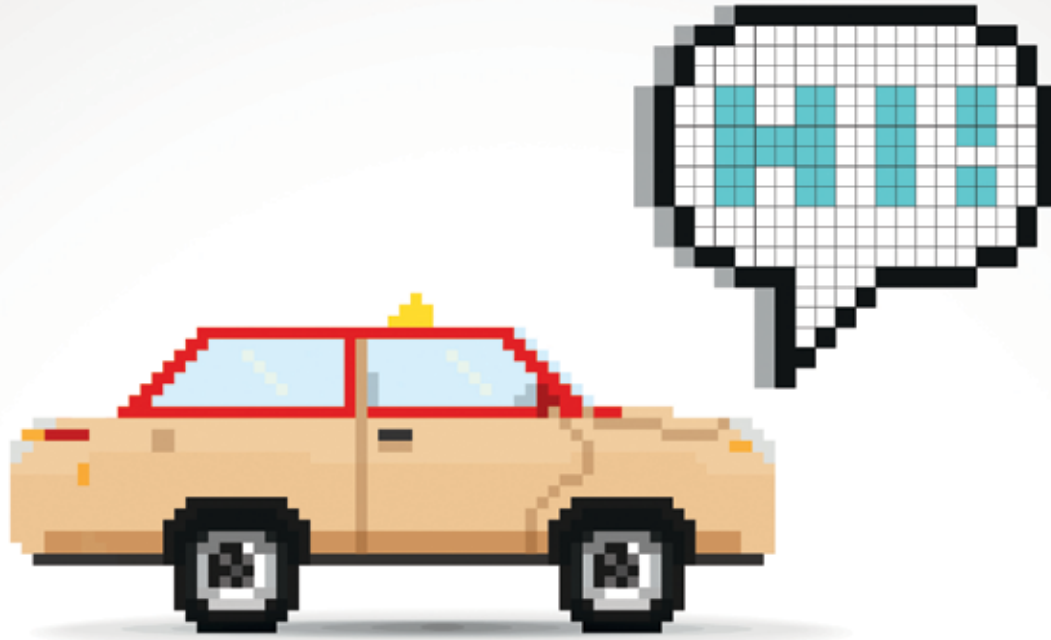
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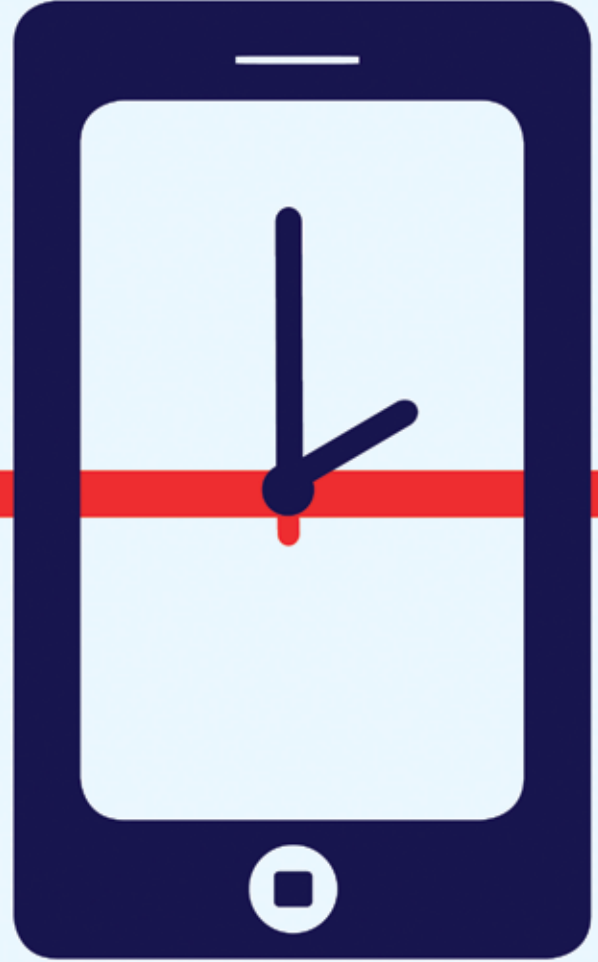
